

Institutional policy

The purpose of the document is to present a policy framework for the faculties for doing research, presenting papers in seminars and conferences.

Objectives of the policy

- To professional recognition, opportunities for publishing, and potential career advancement
- To foster a deeper understanding of educational theories and practices, contributing to personal and professional growth.
- To enhance student engagement, learning, and achievement, leading to better educational outcomes.
- To encourage faculties to attend, publish and present papers in educational conferences
- To contribute valuable insights and knowledge to the field of education, helping to shape future practices and policies.

Guidelines

- Faculties should get prior permission from the principal and authority to carry out research, participation and presentation of papers.
- Appropriate scrutiny and appraisal of the proposed activity Is done by the principal before granting permission.
- Financial assistance for regular research work is not provided by this institution.
- Provision for travel grants and money for other expenses incurred by the faculty for the institution assigned and approved seminars and workshop programs is granted.
- Leave is permitted for the faculty who participates in research and presentation of papers in conferences.
- There will be a special appreciation for faculties those who undertake special programs, seminars and conferences in and outside the campus.
- Faculties must submit the reports of the attended programs to the concerned authority to avail the benefits offered by the institution.
- Sample evidences are required to issue travel grants and money for other expenses incurred by the faculty.
