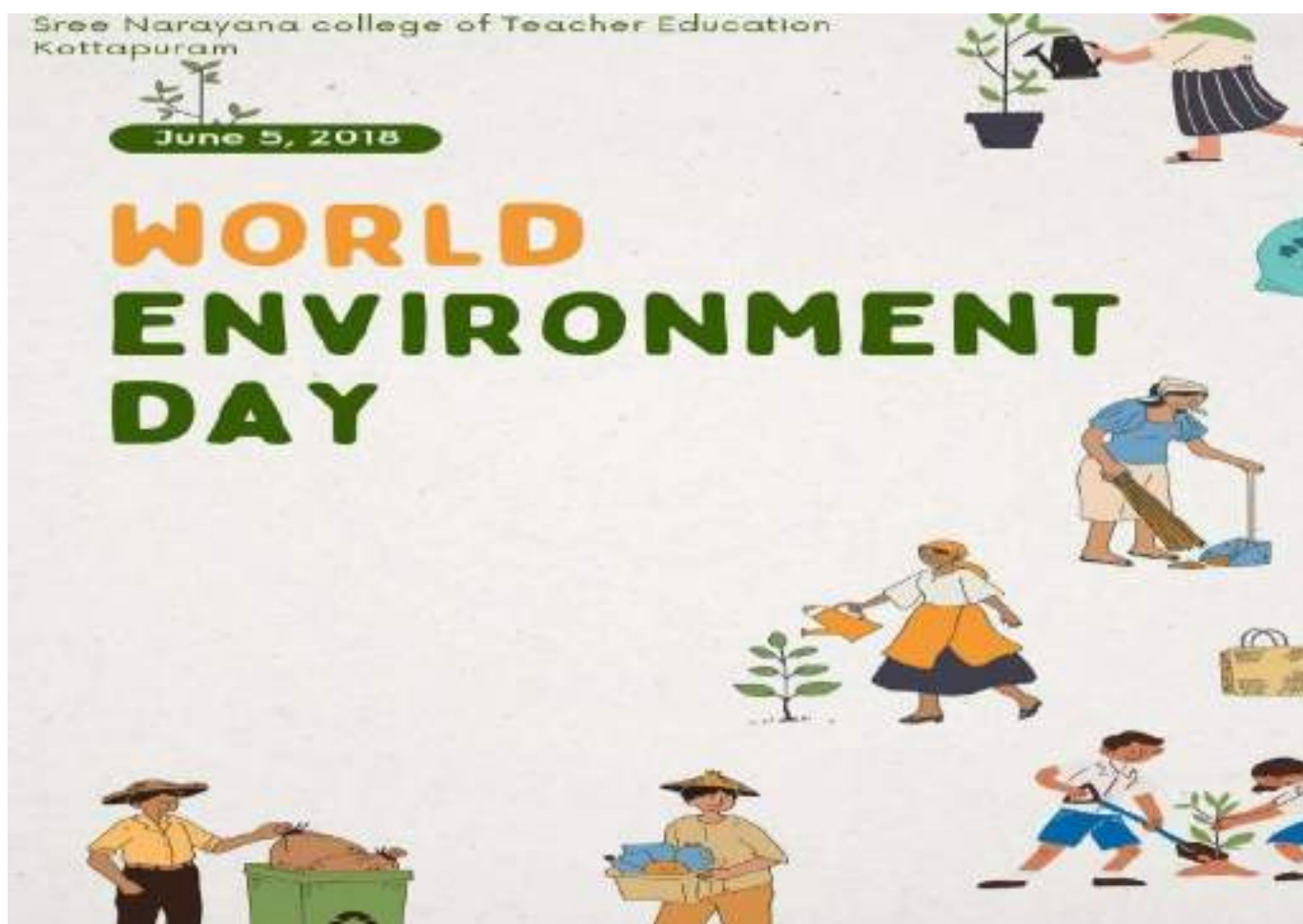


**REPORT OF THE PROGRAMME OF THE YEAR

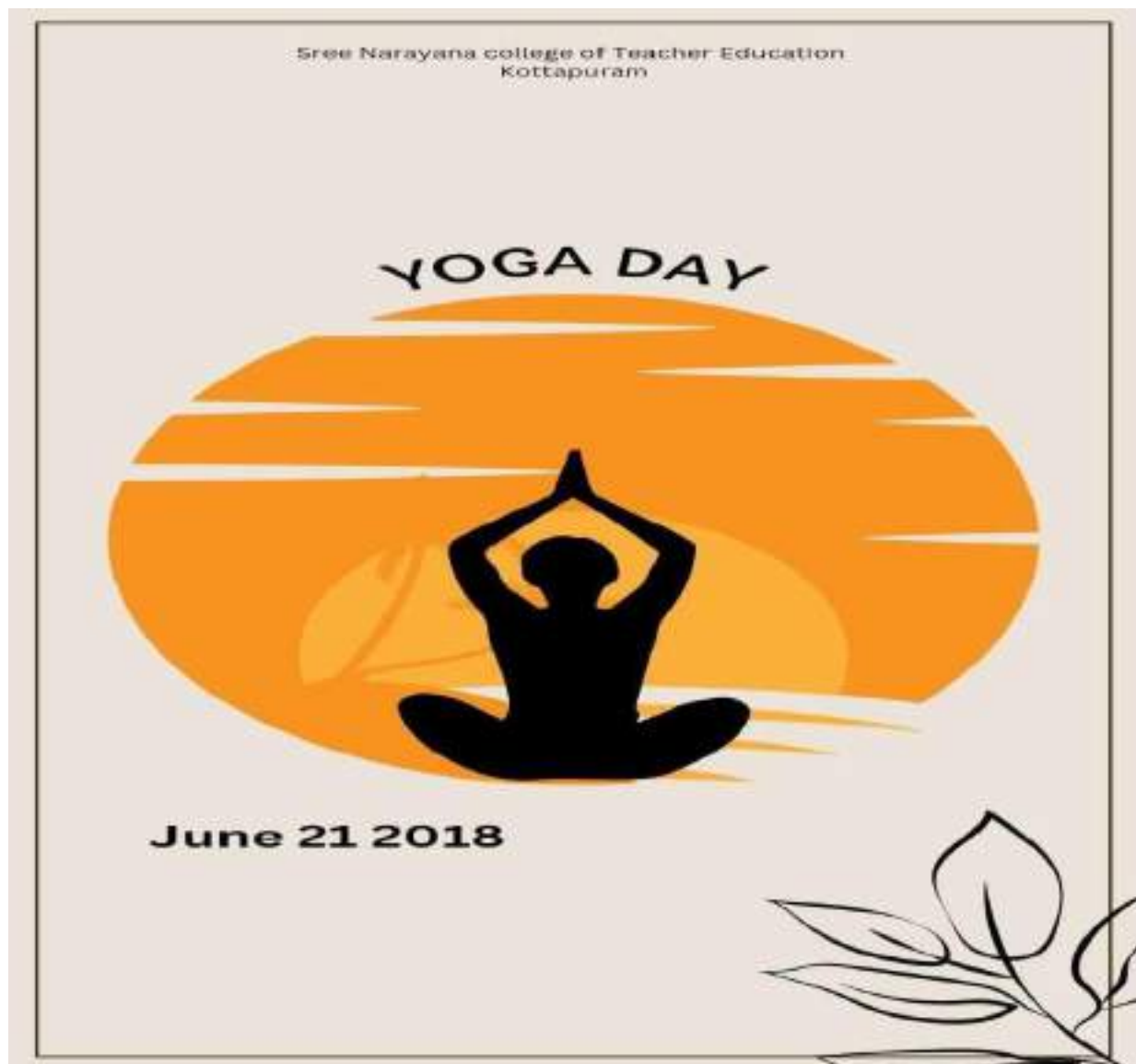
5. READING DAY

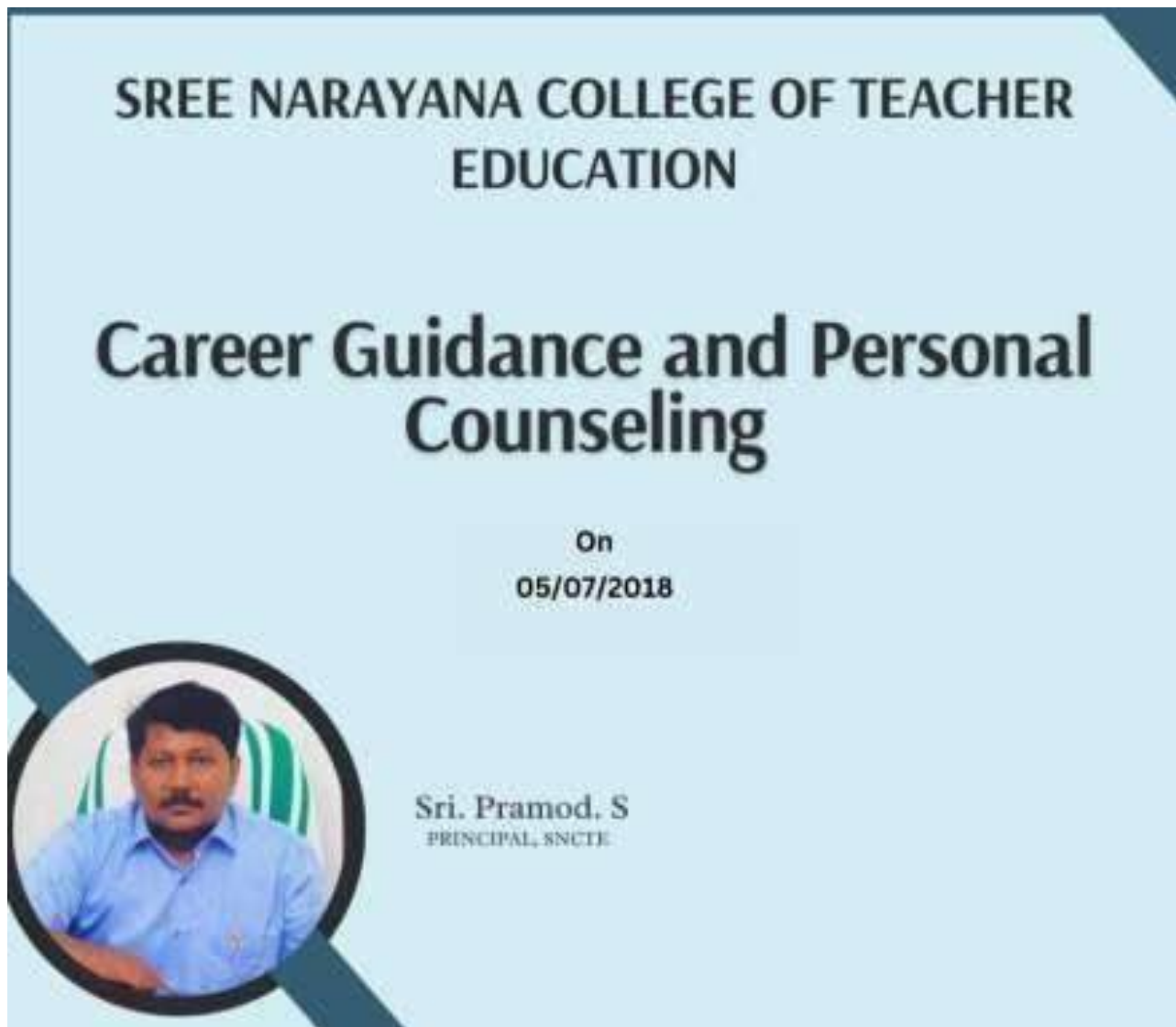
9. INTERNATIONAL PEACE AND LOVE DAY

11. SKIL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM – BOOK BINDING

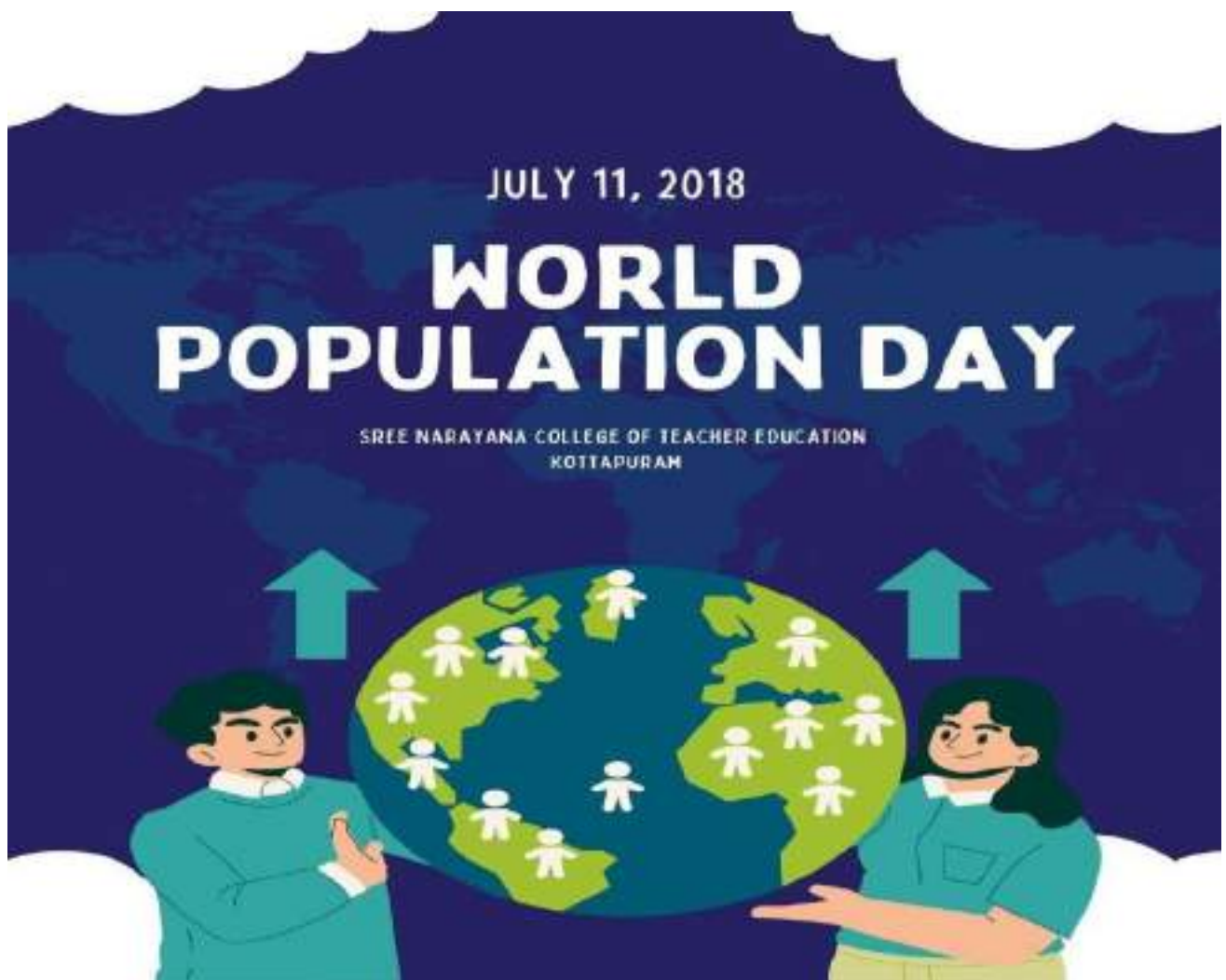

14. WORLD MALALA DAY

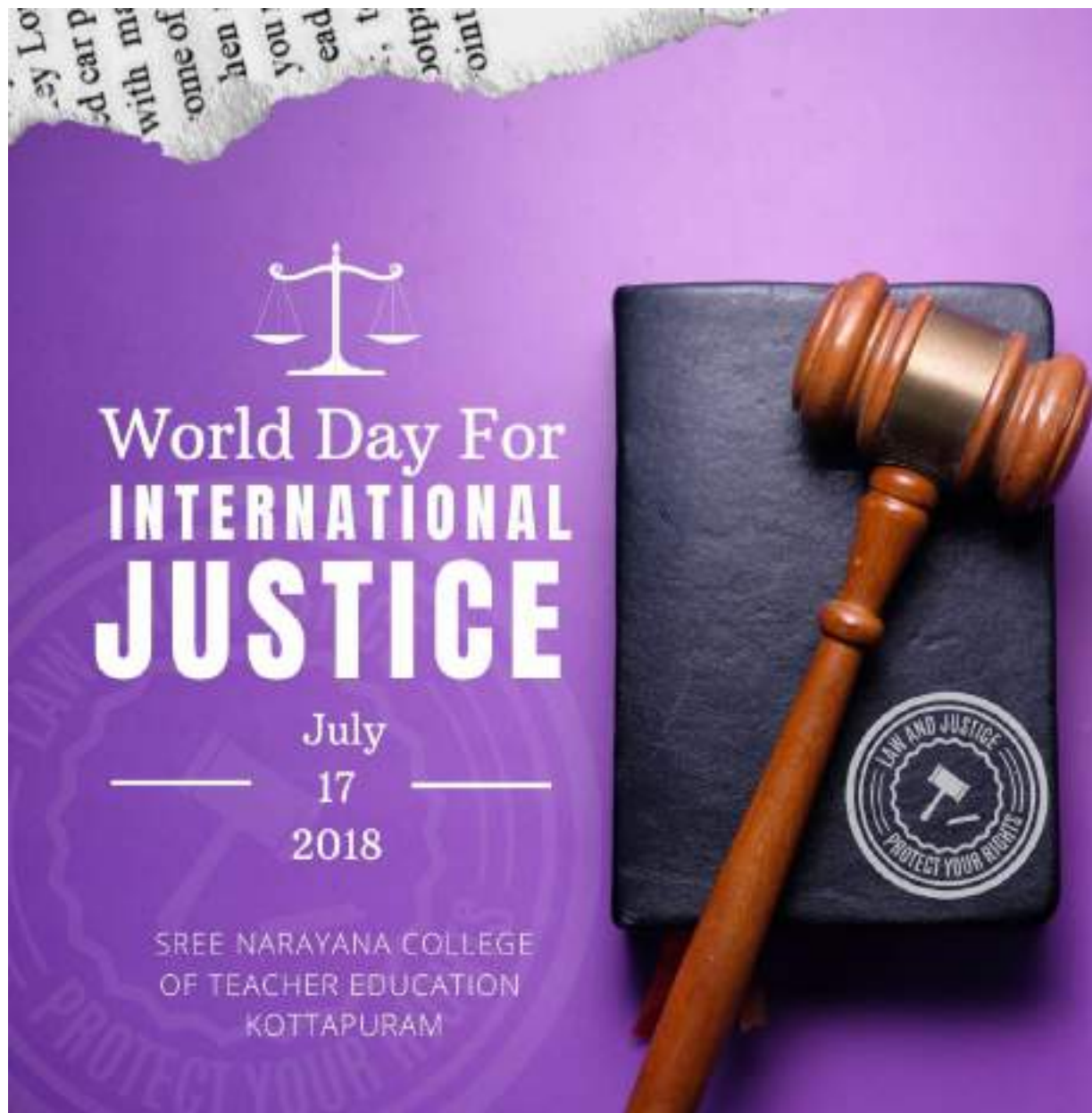

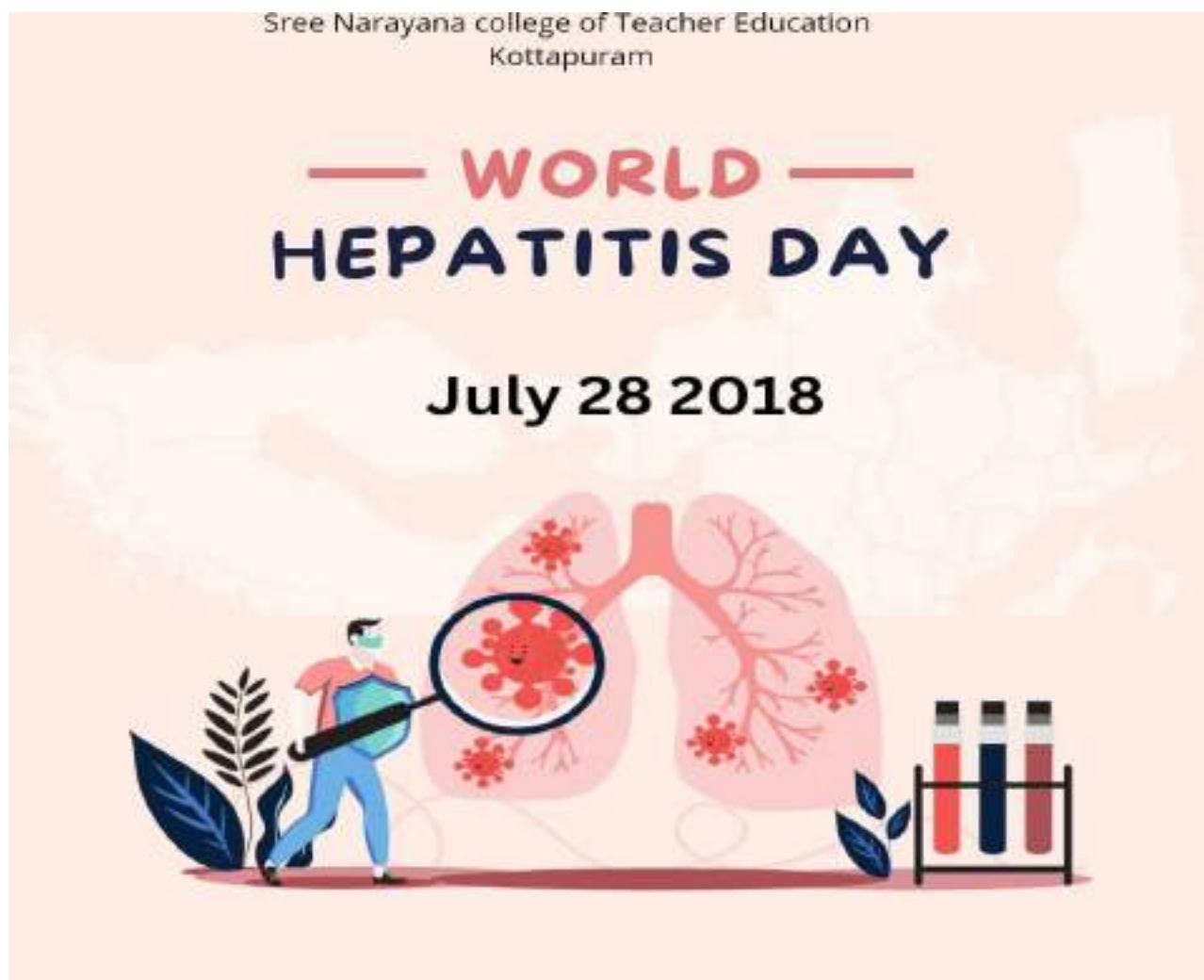
16. WORLD NATURE CONSERVATION DAY

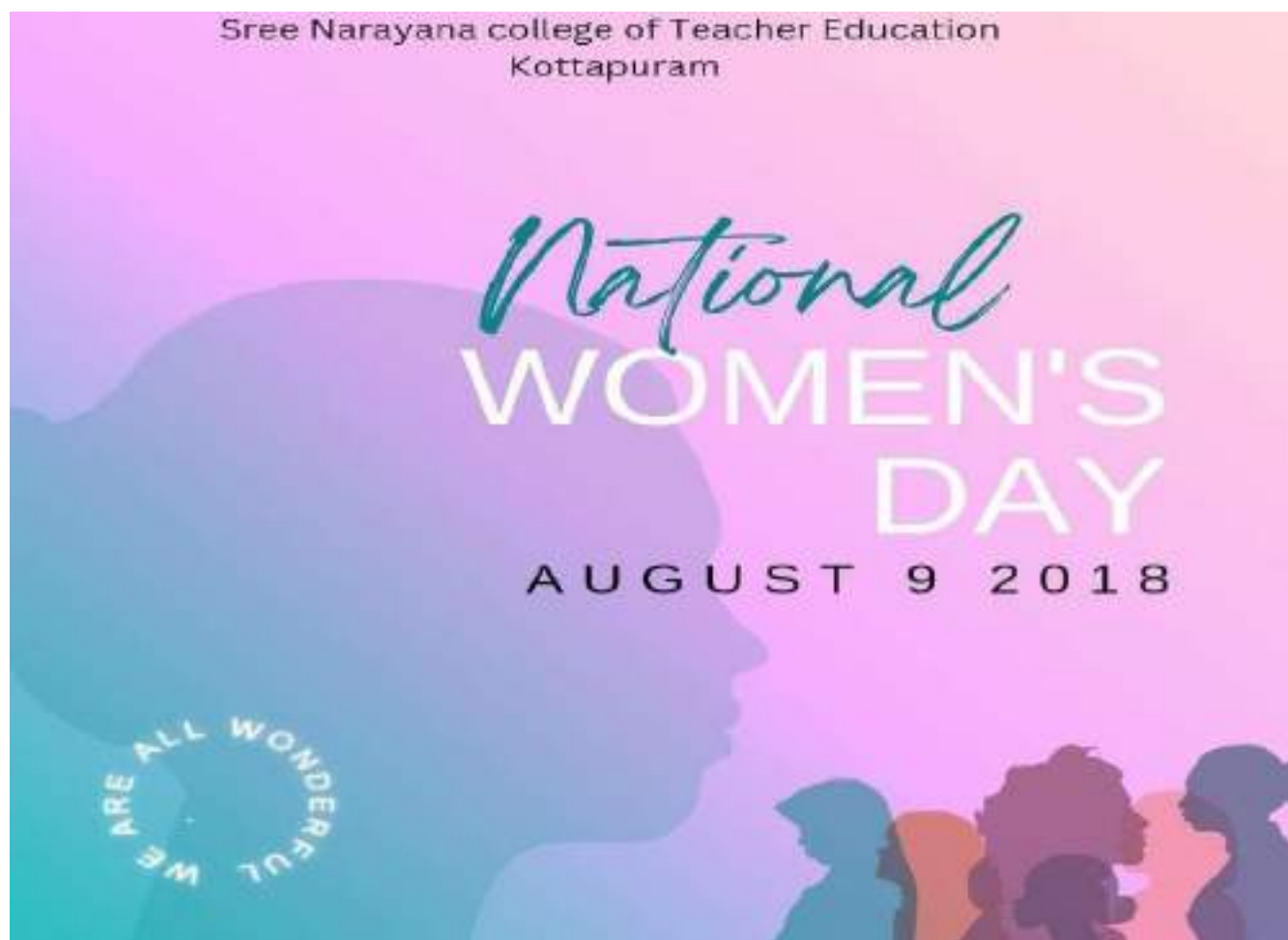
21. WORLD FIRST AID DAY

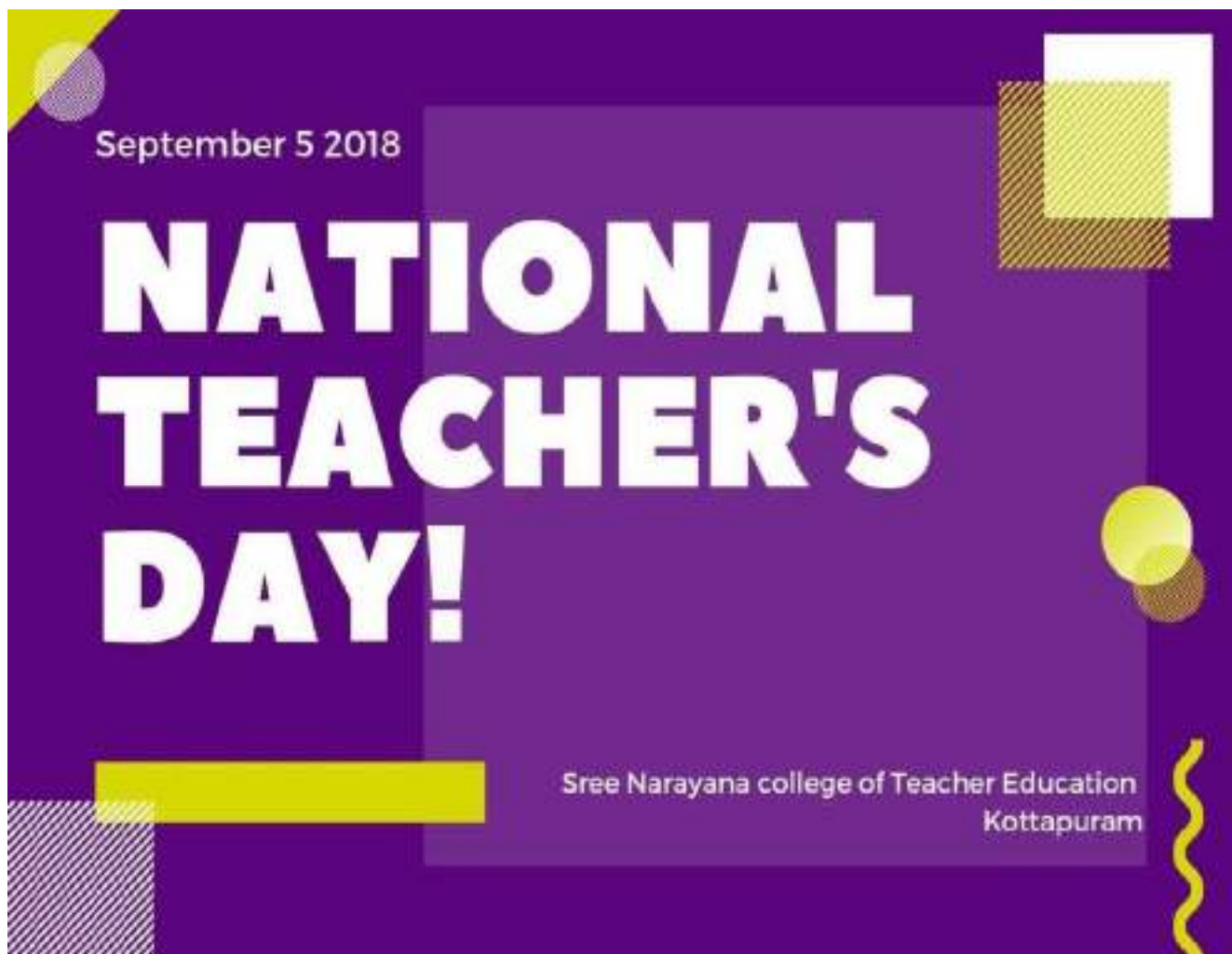
22. NATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

23. NATIONAL TEACHERS DAY

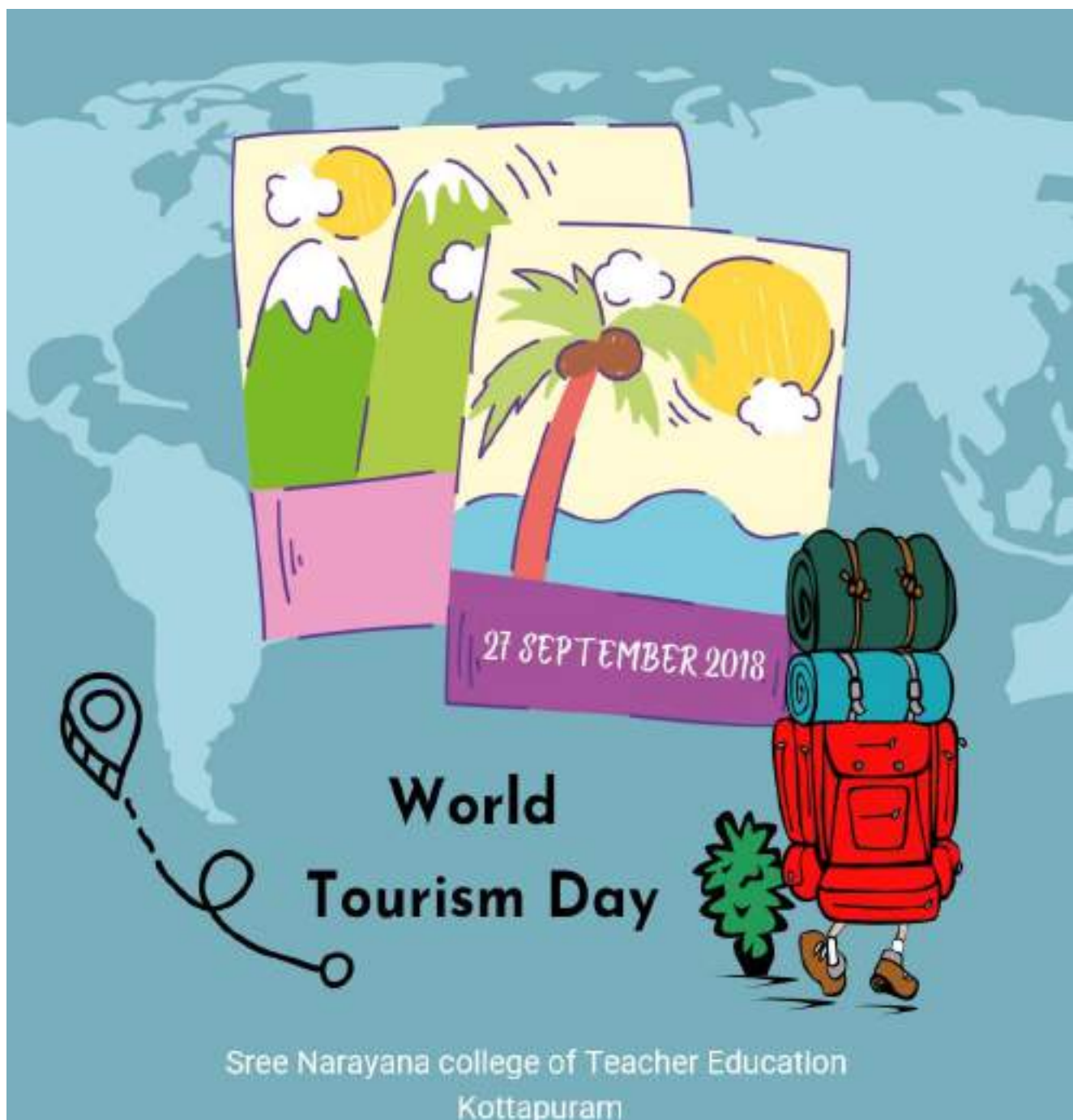

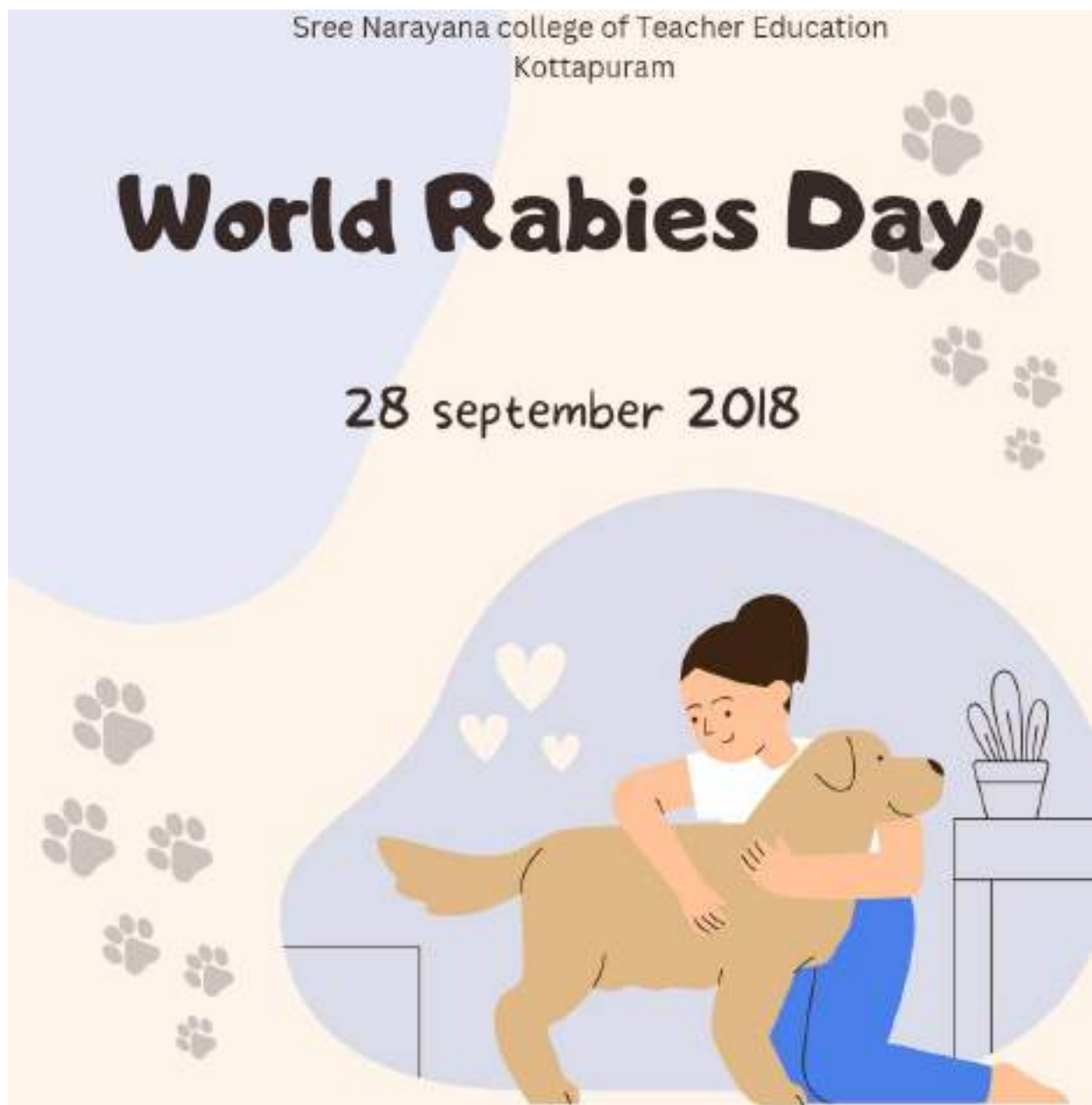
25. WORLD FIRST AID DAY

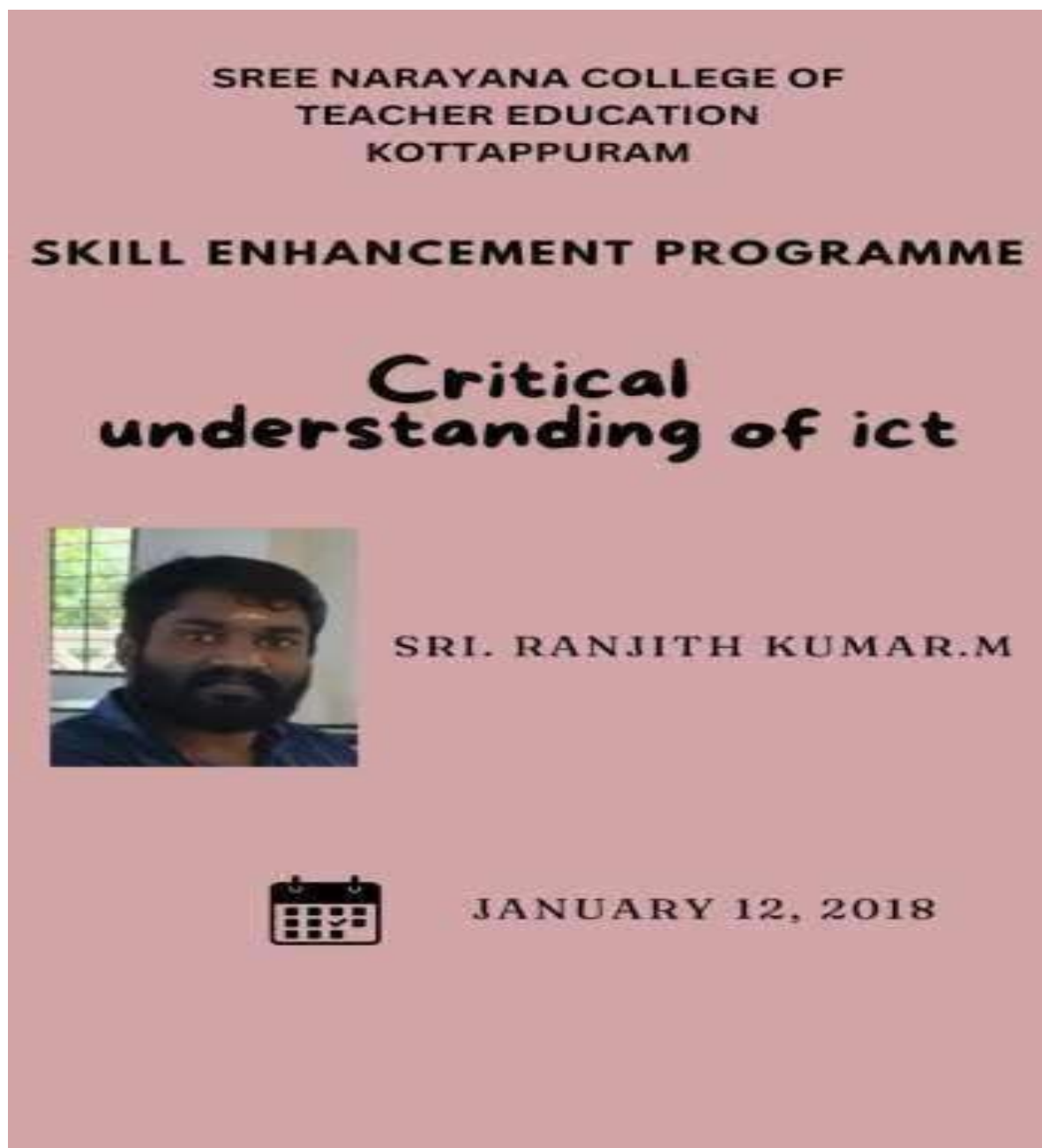

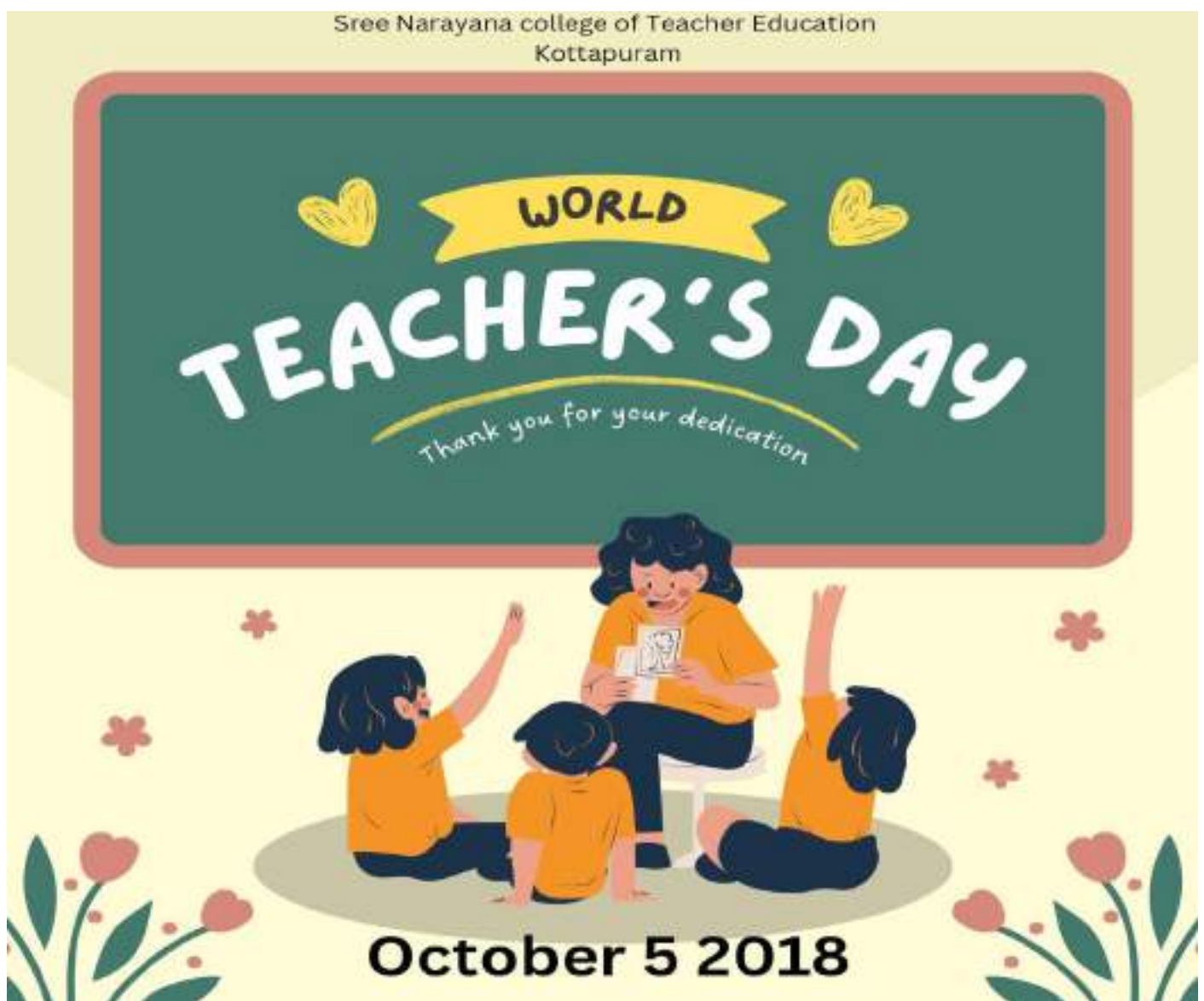
31. DAY OF OLDER PERSON

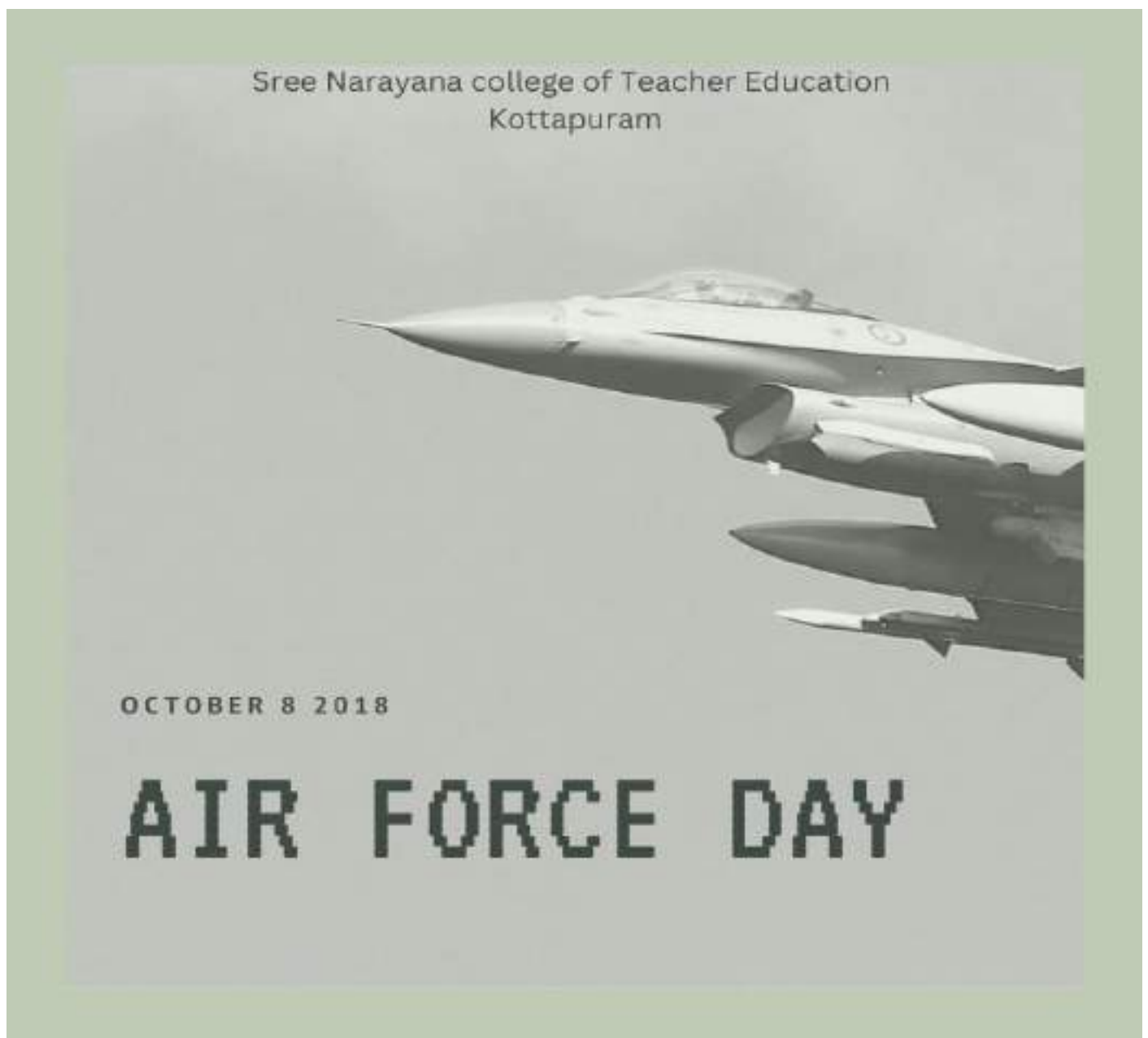
32. WORLD TEACHERS DAY

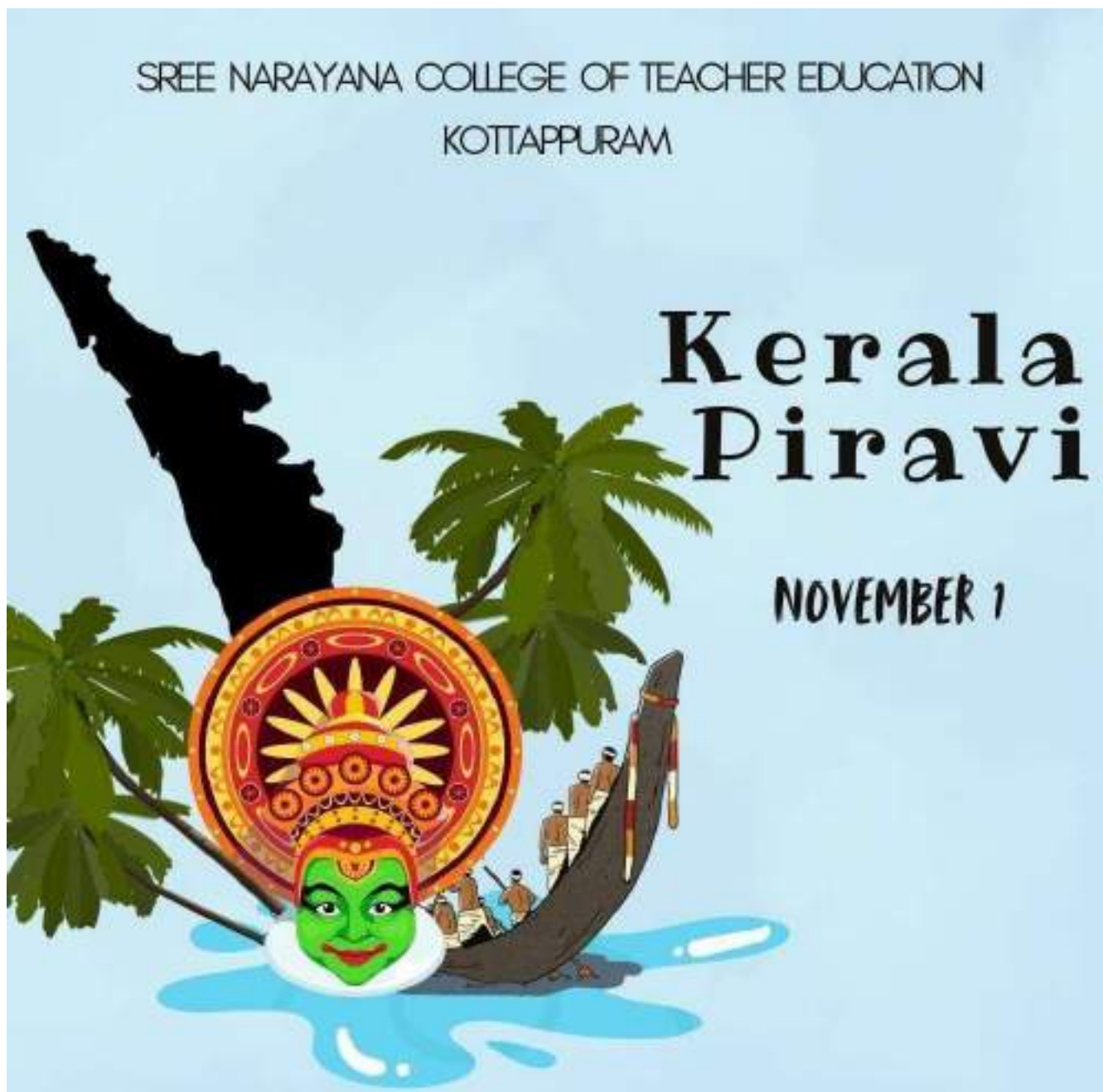
36. KTET ORIENTATION

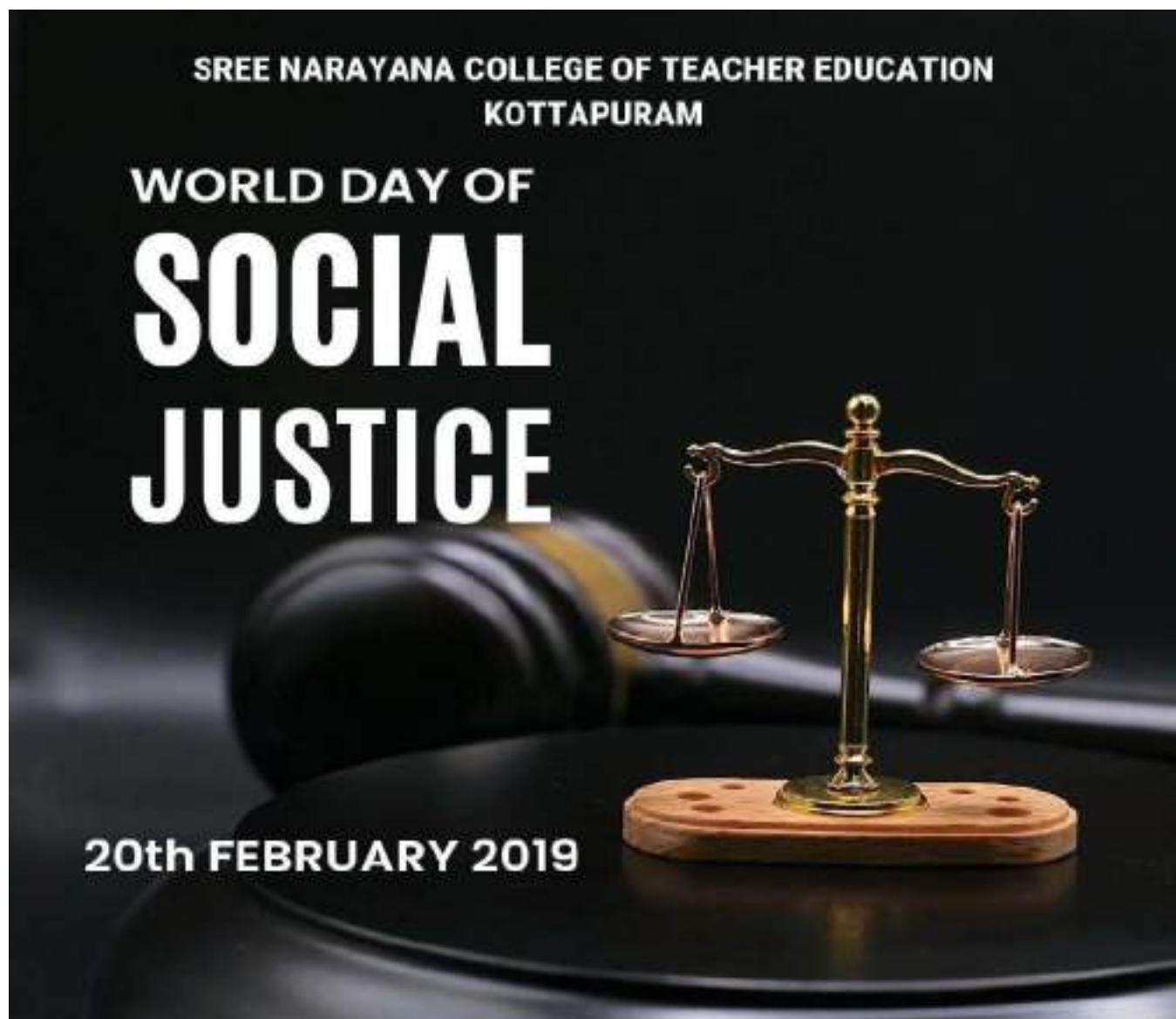
37. KERALA PIRAVI

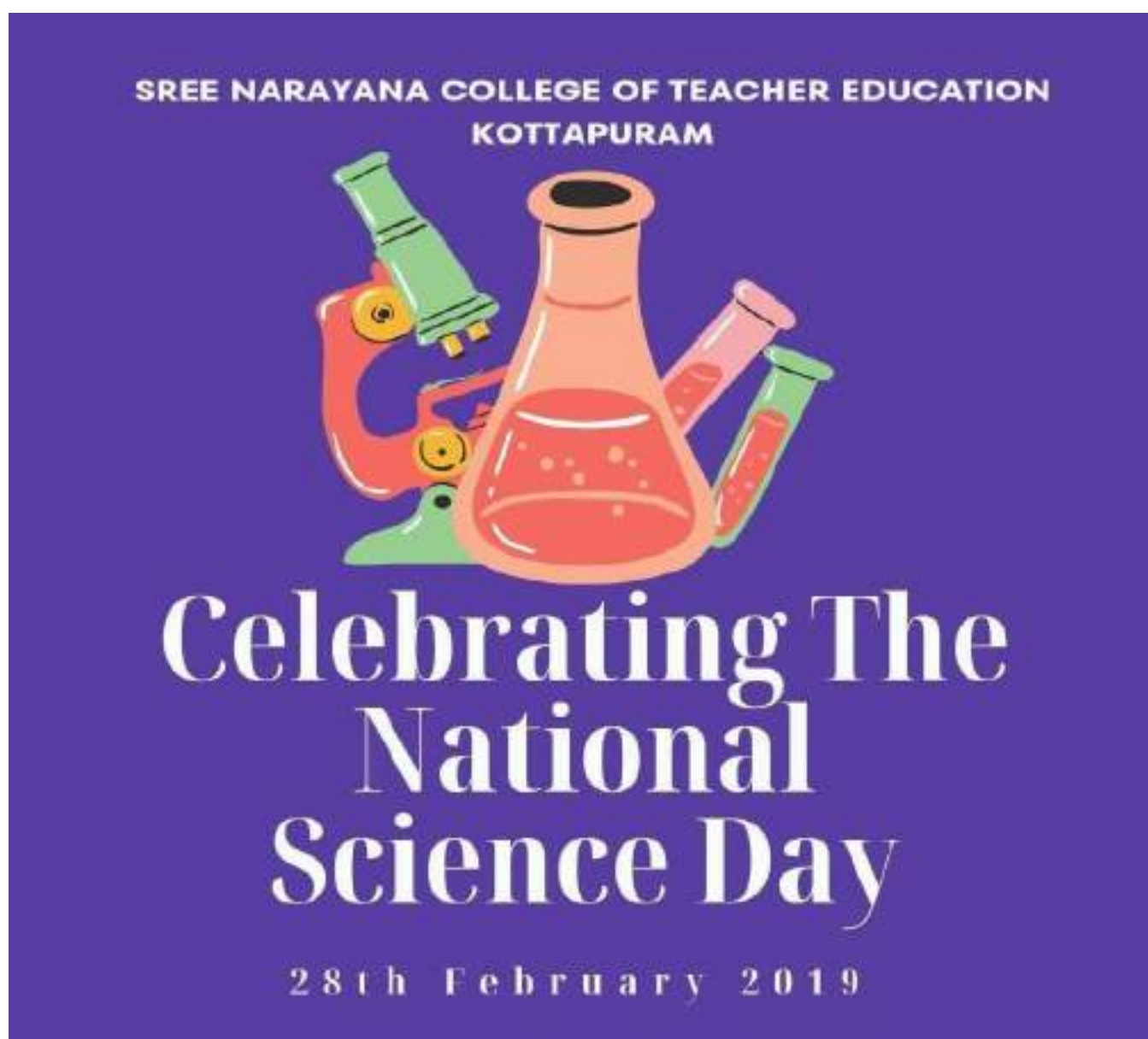
38. WORLD DAY OF SOCIAL JUSTICE

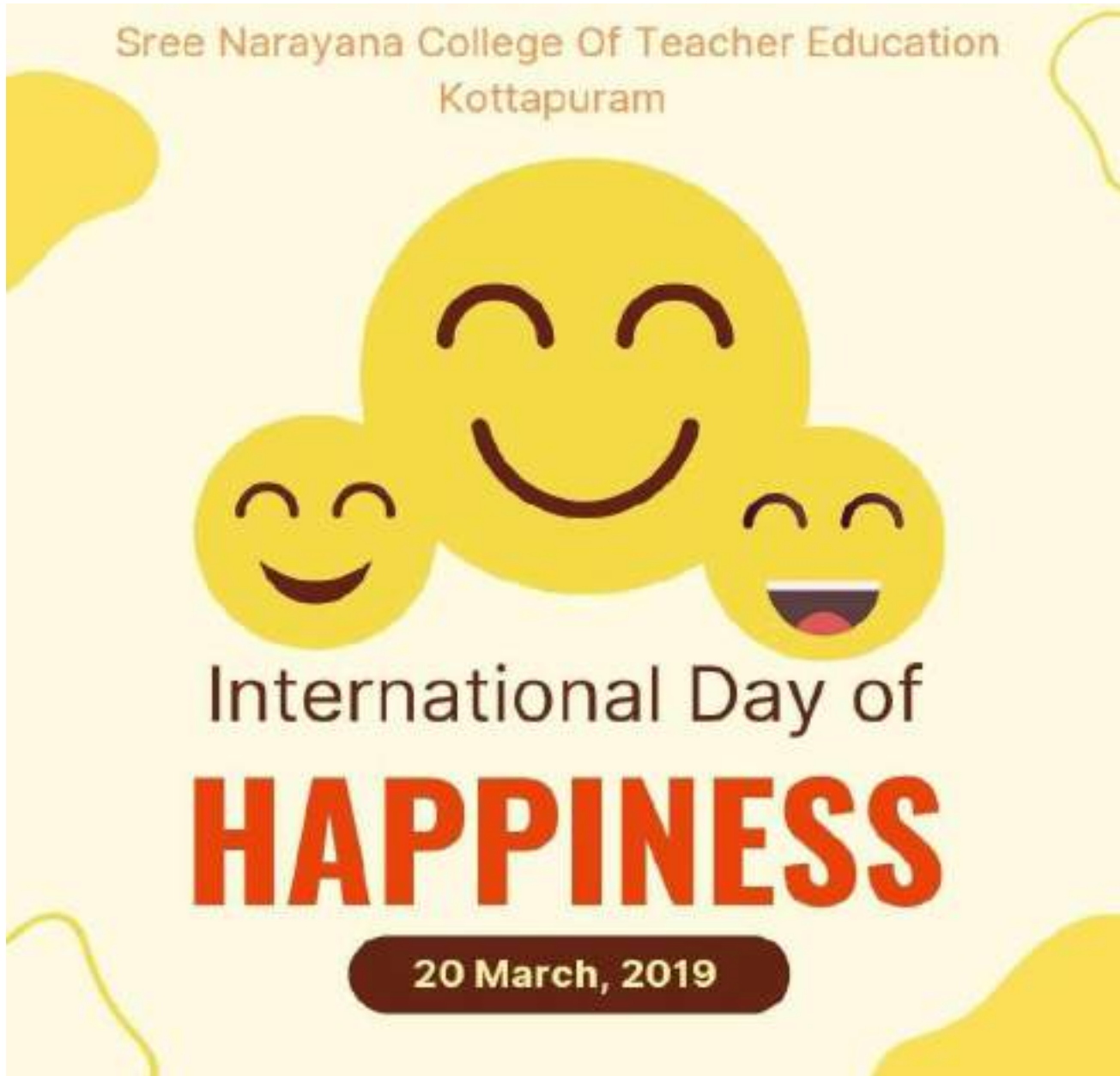
40. NO SMOKING DAY

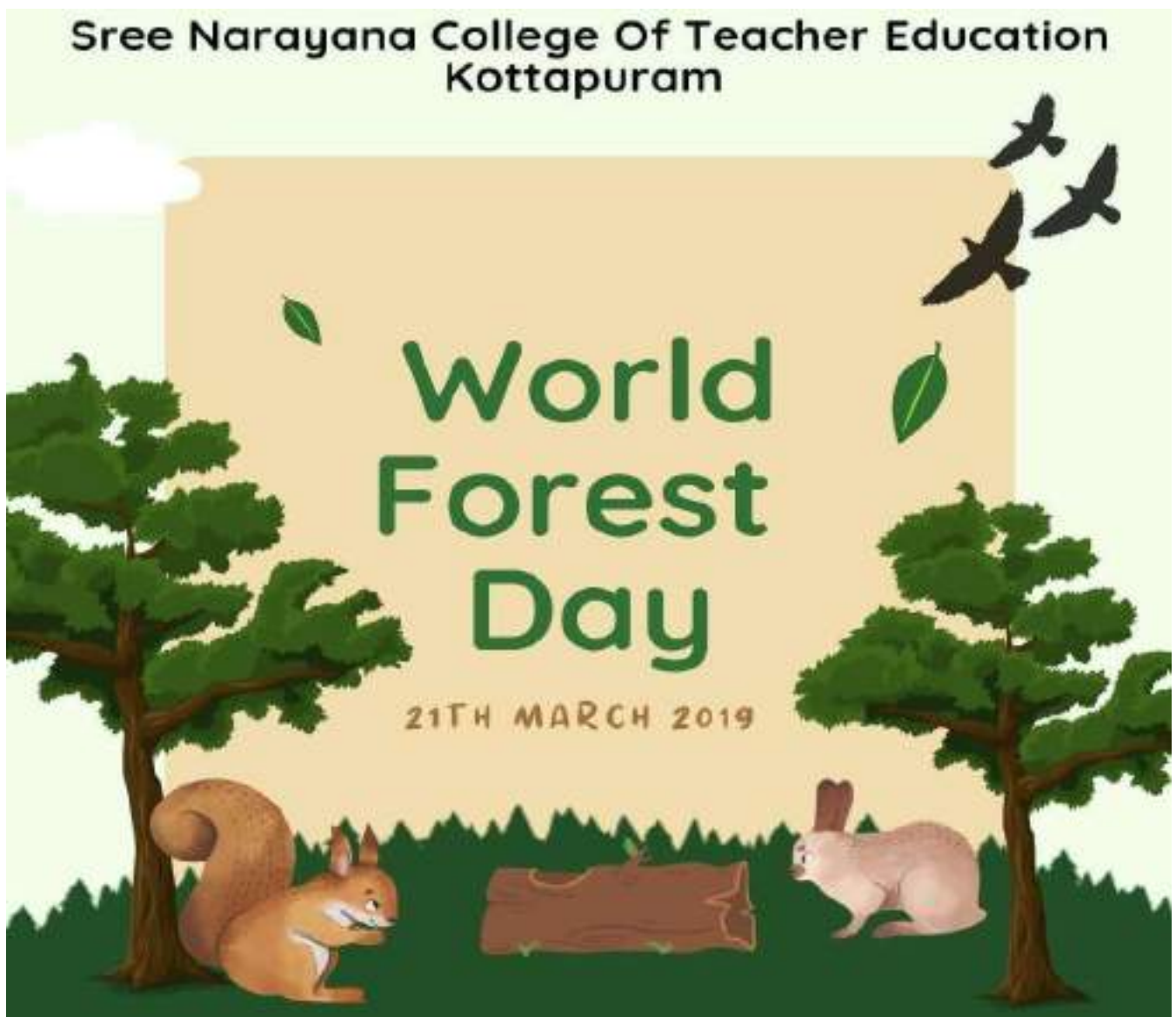
41. INTERNATIONAL DAY OF HAPPINESS

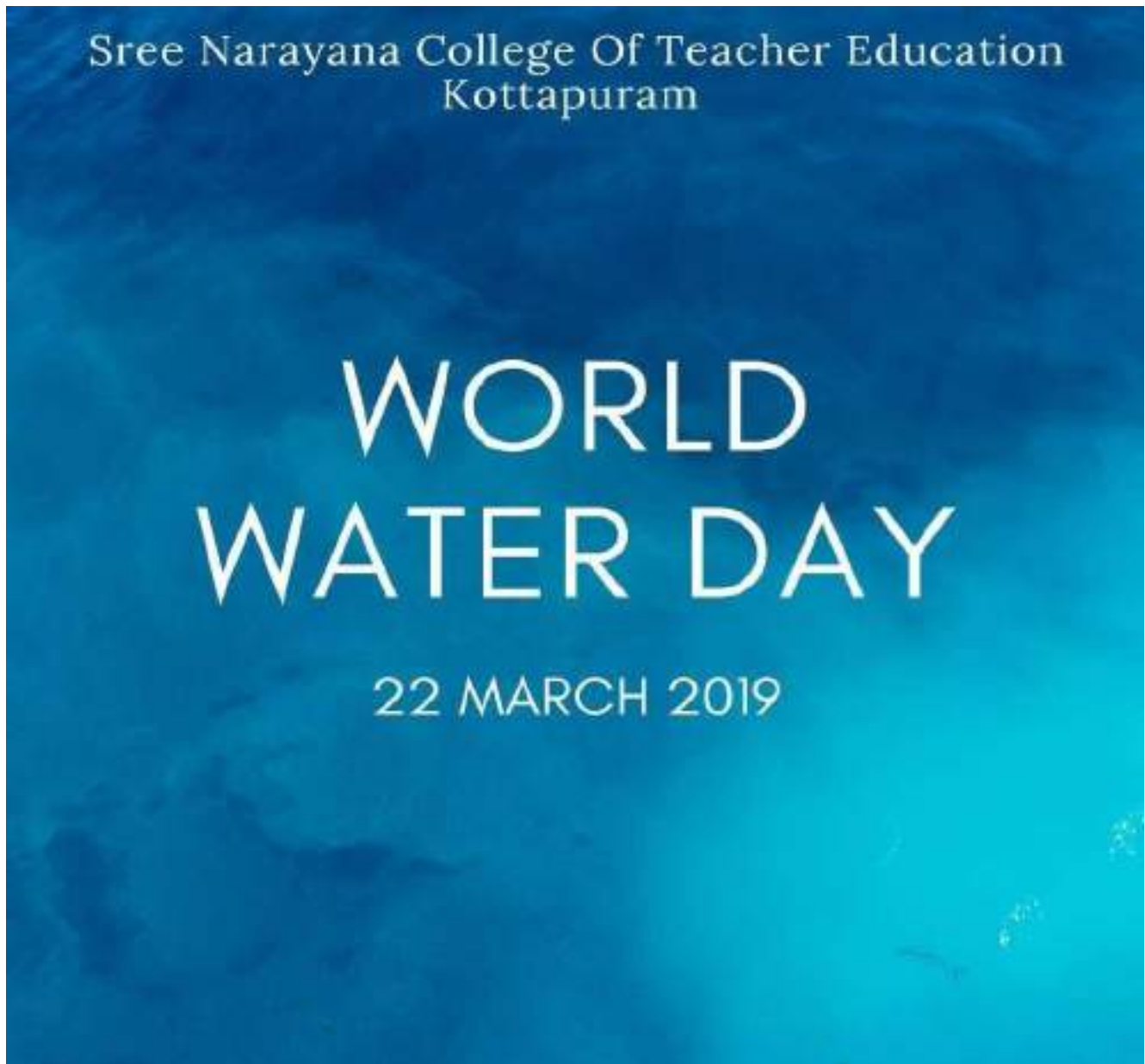
42. FOREST DAY

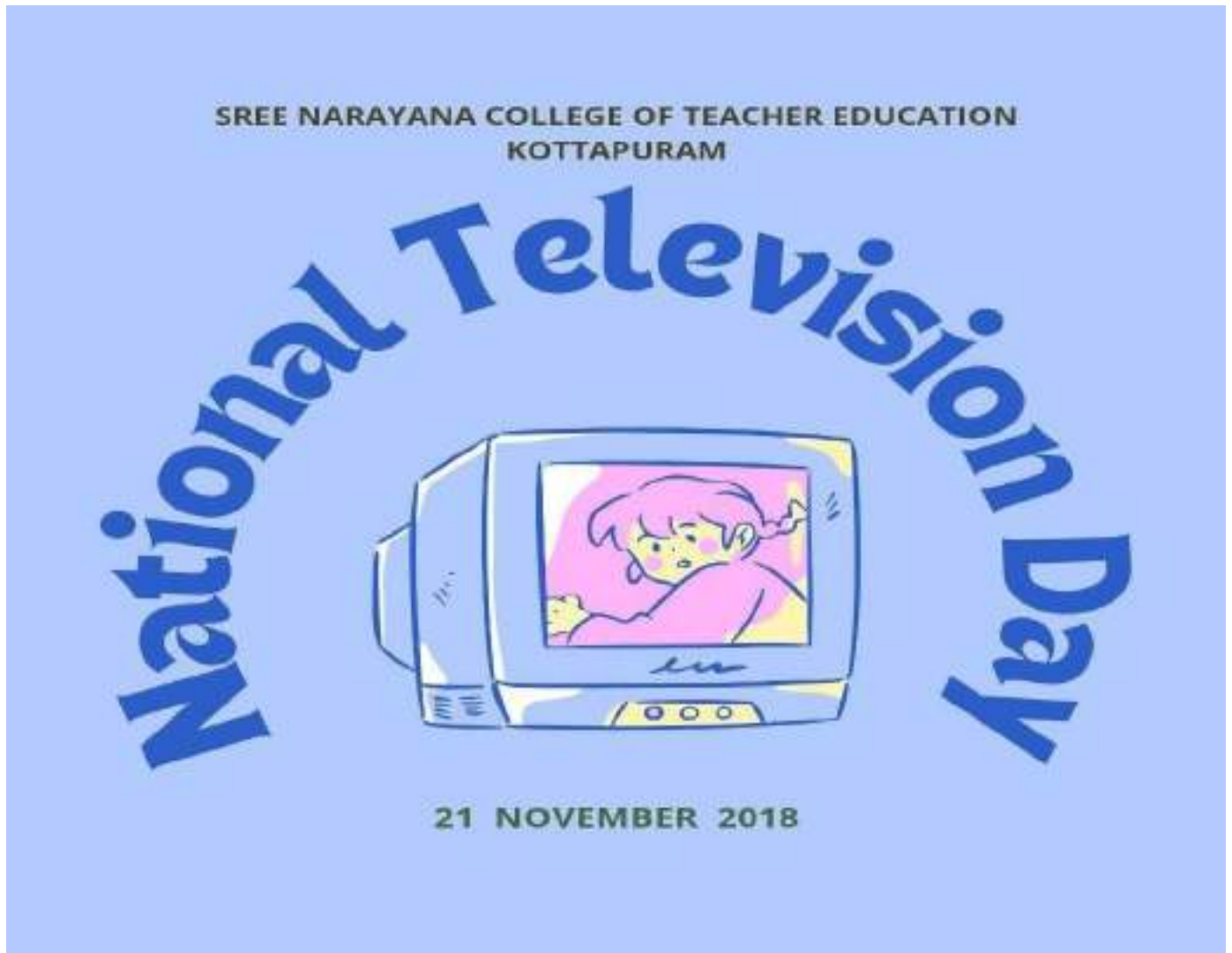
43. WATER DAY

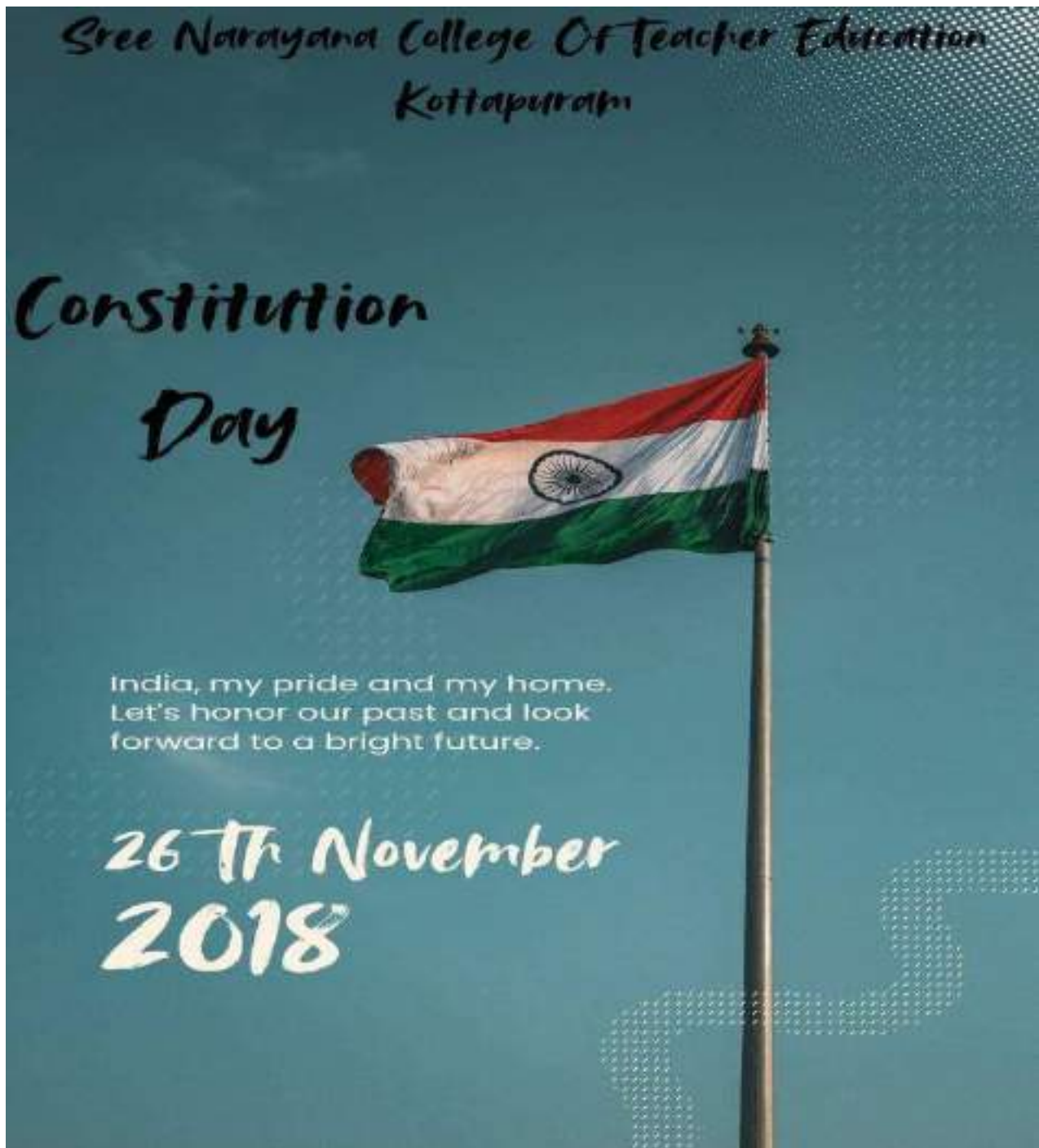
44. NATIONAL TELEVISION DAY

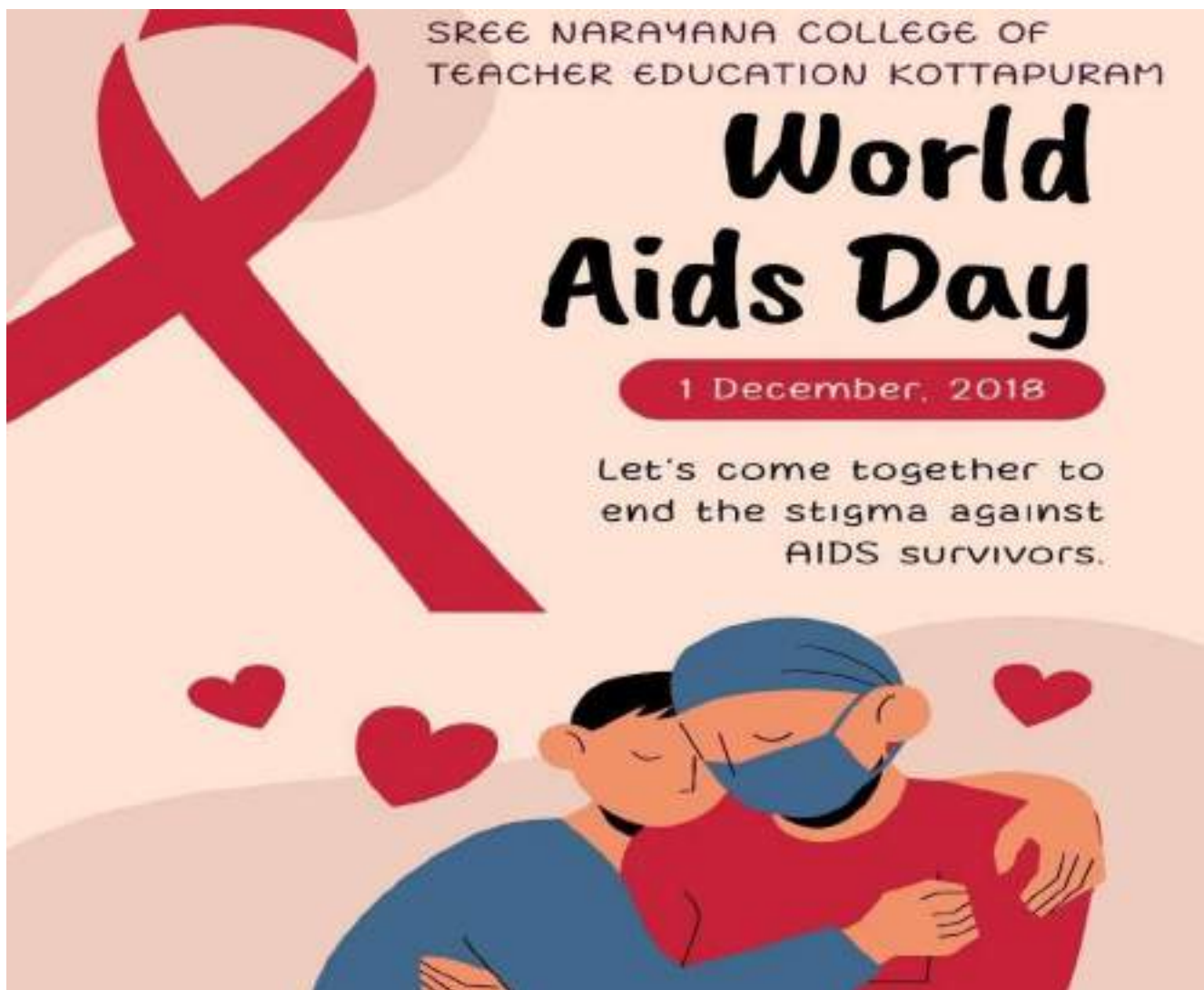
45. NATIONAL CONSTITUTION DAY

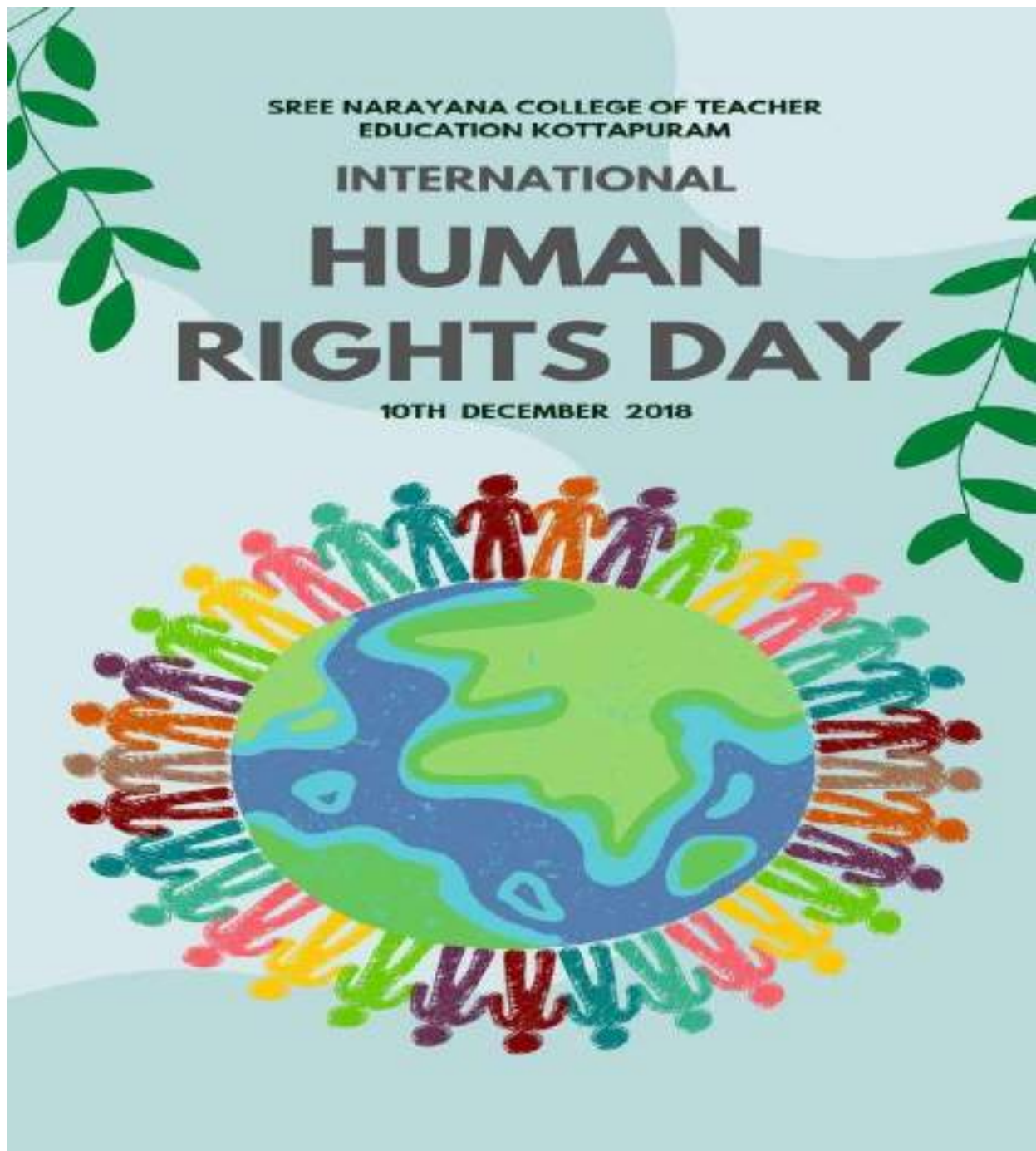
47. WORLD SOIL DAY

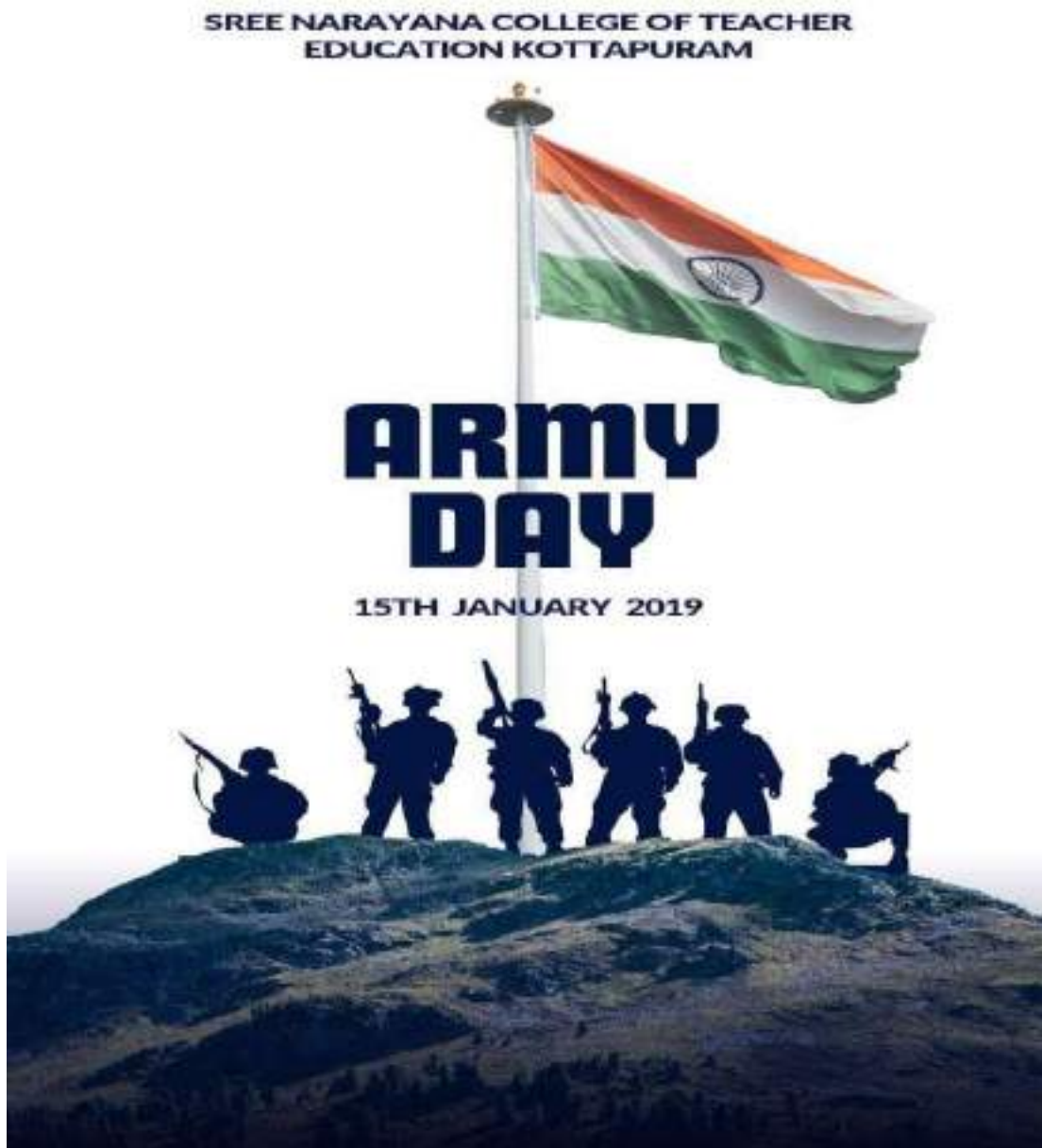
53. WORLD BRAILLIE DAY

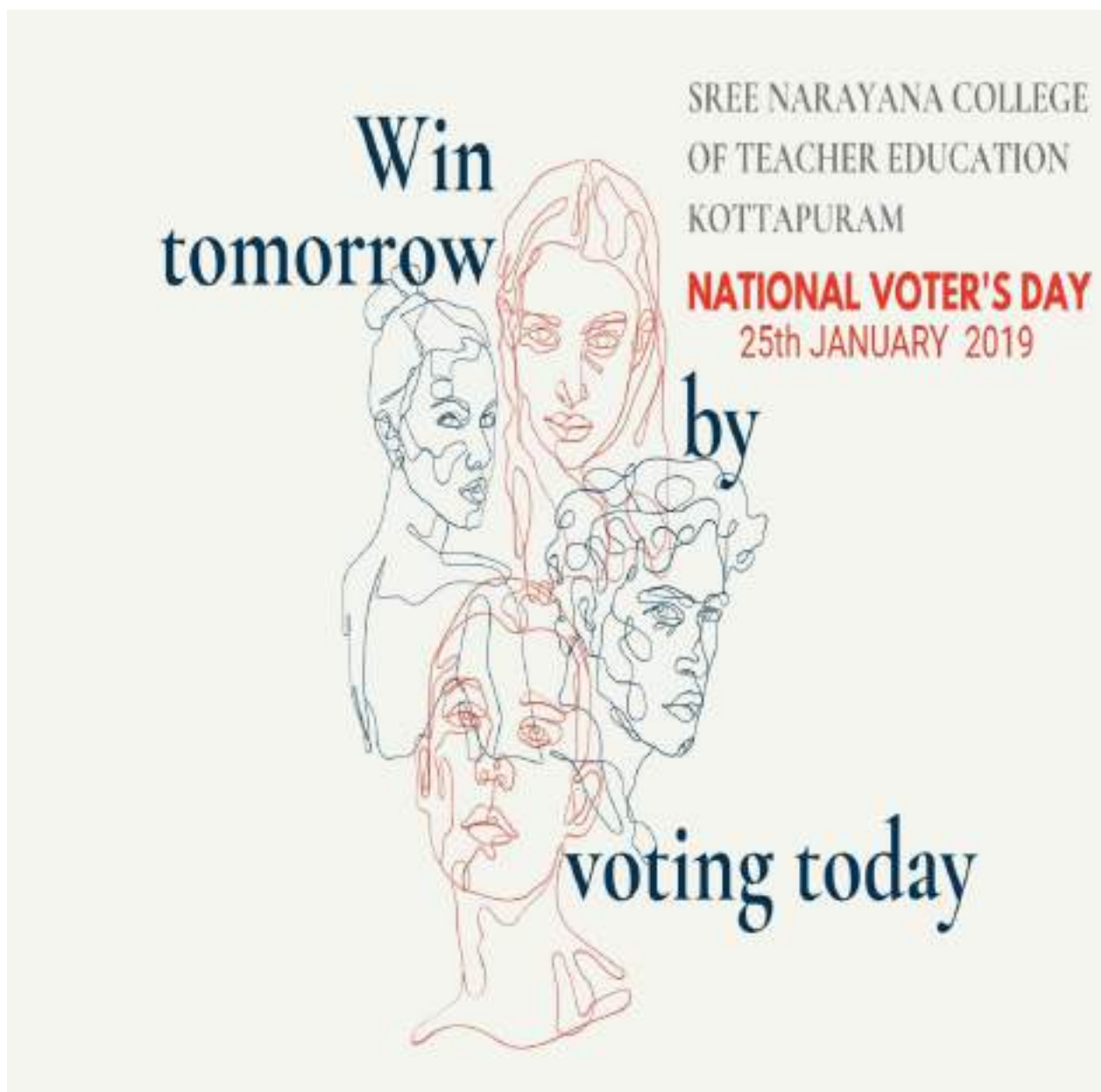
54. ARMY DAY

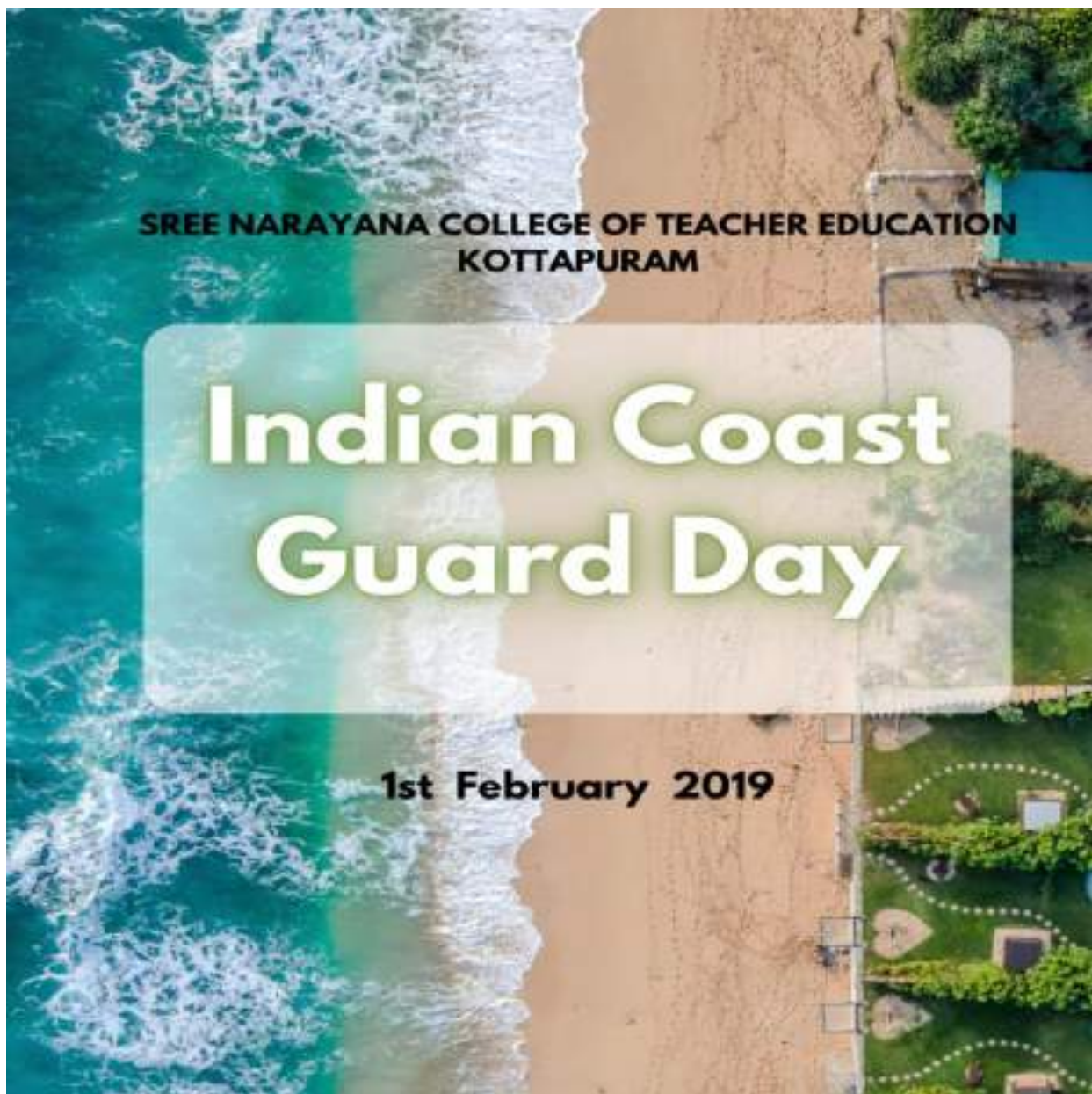
60.MARTYRES DAY

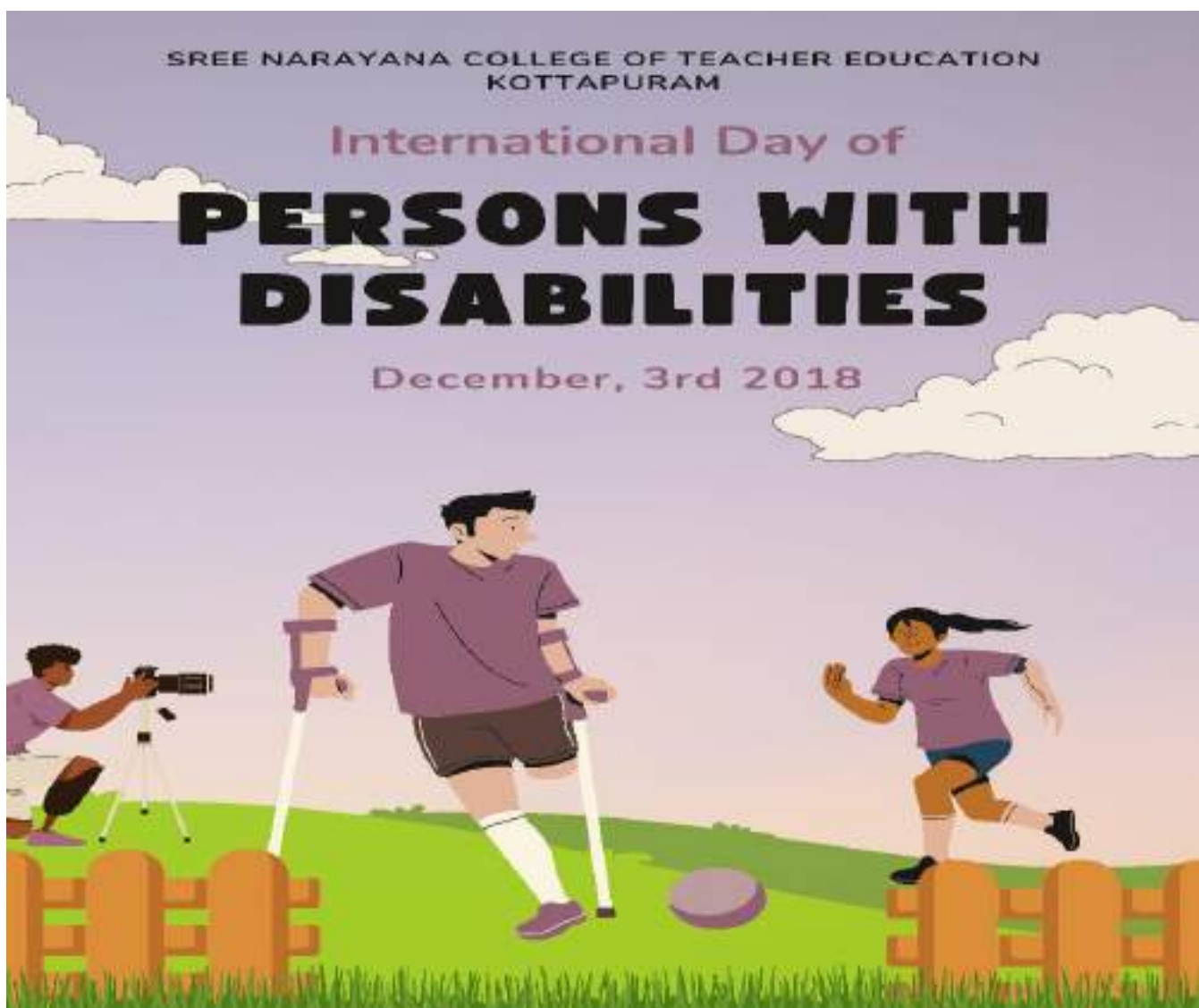

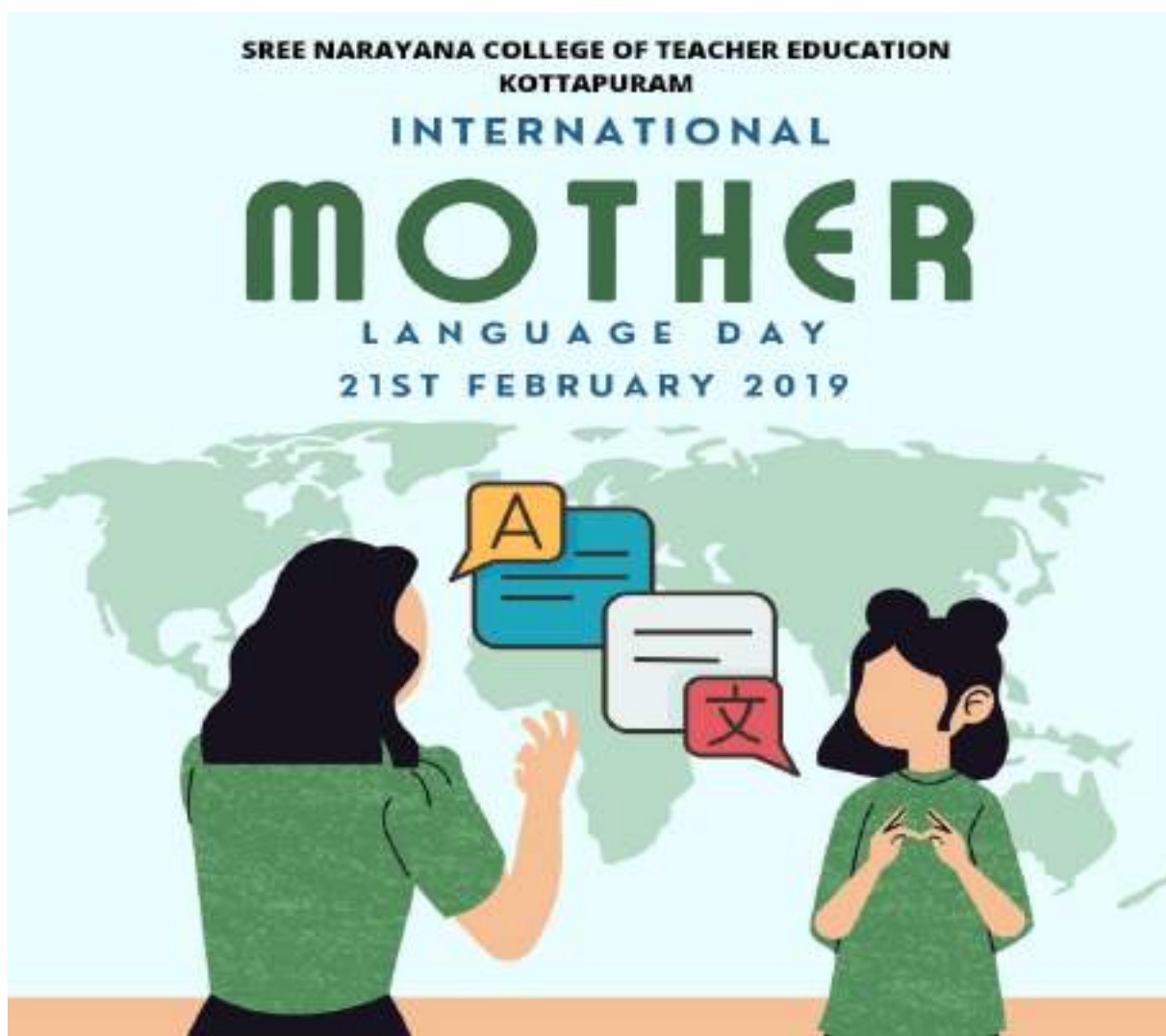
65.VALENTINE'S DAY
