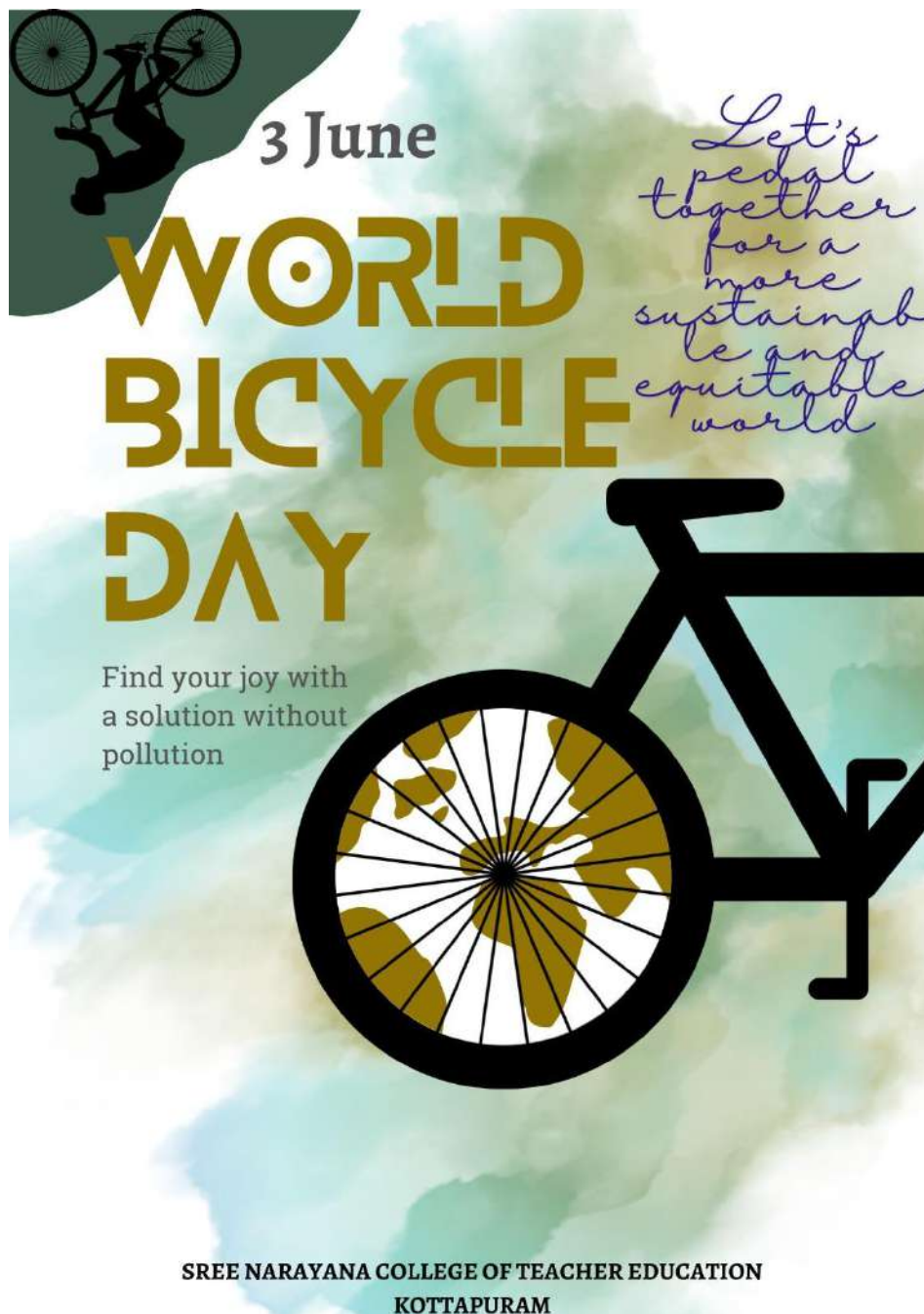

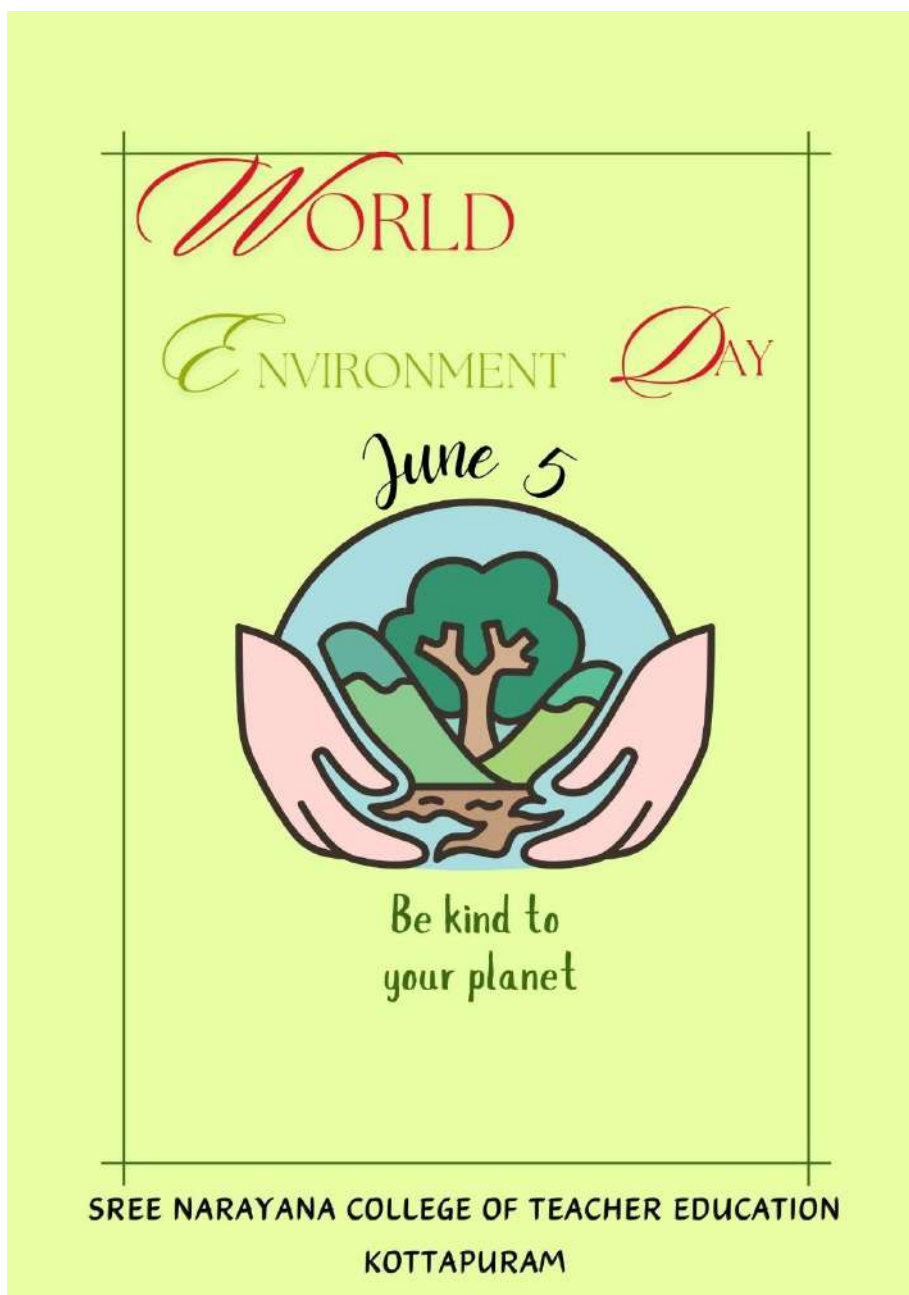
1. WORLD BICYCLE DAY

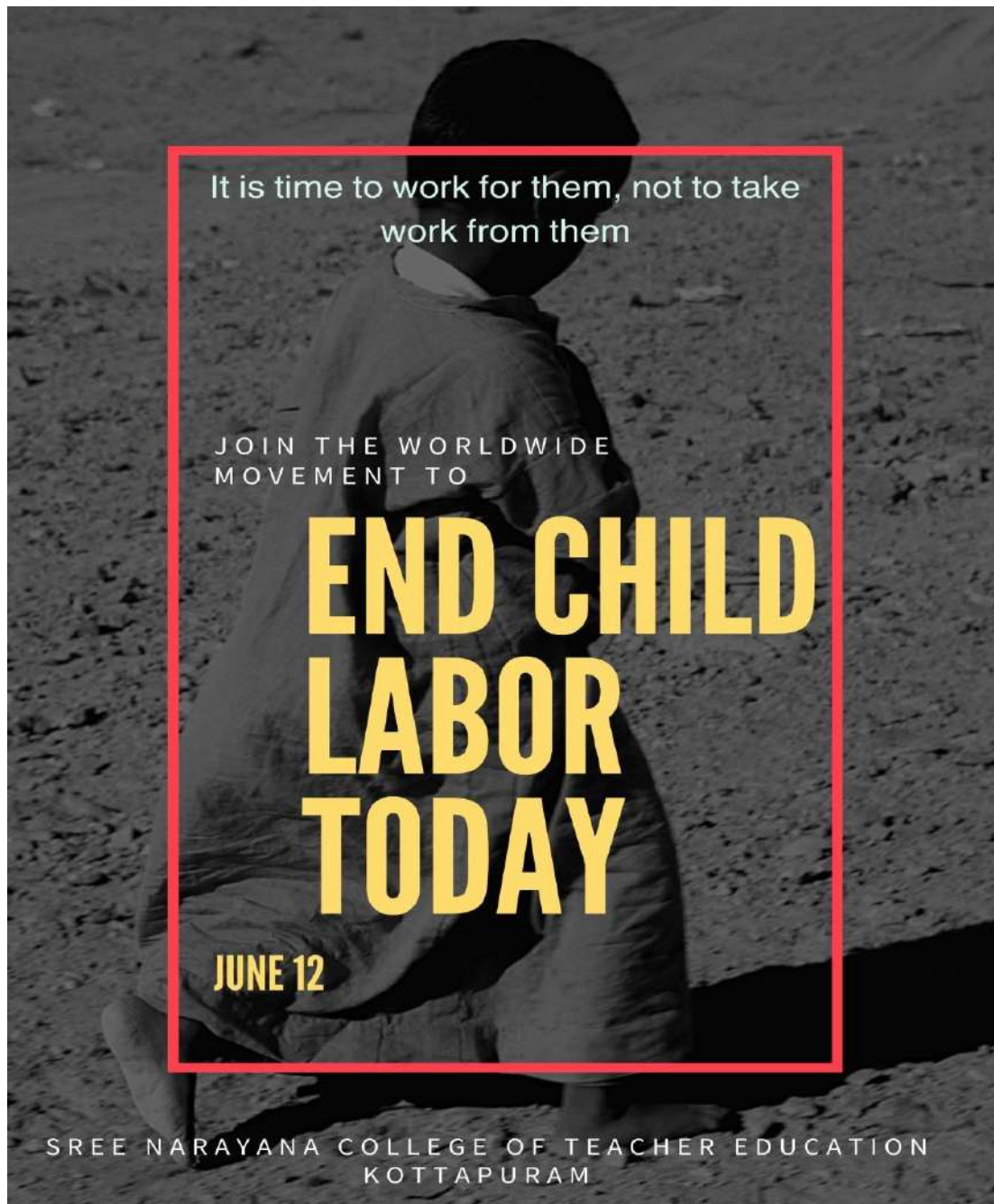
3. OCEAN DAY

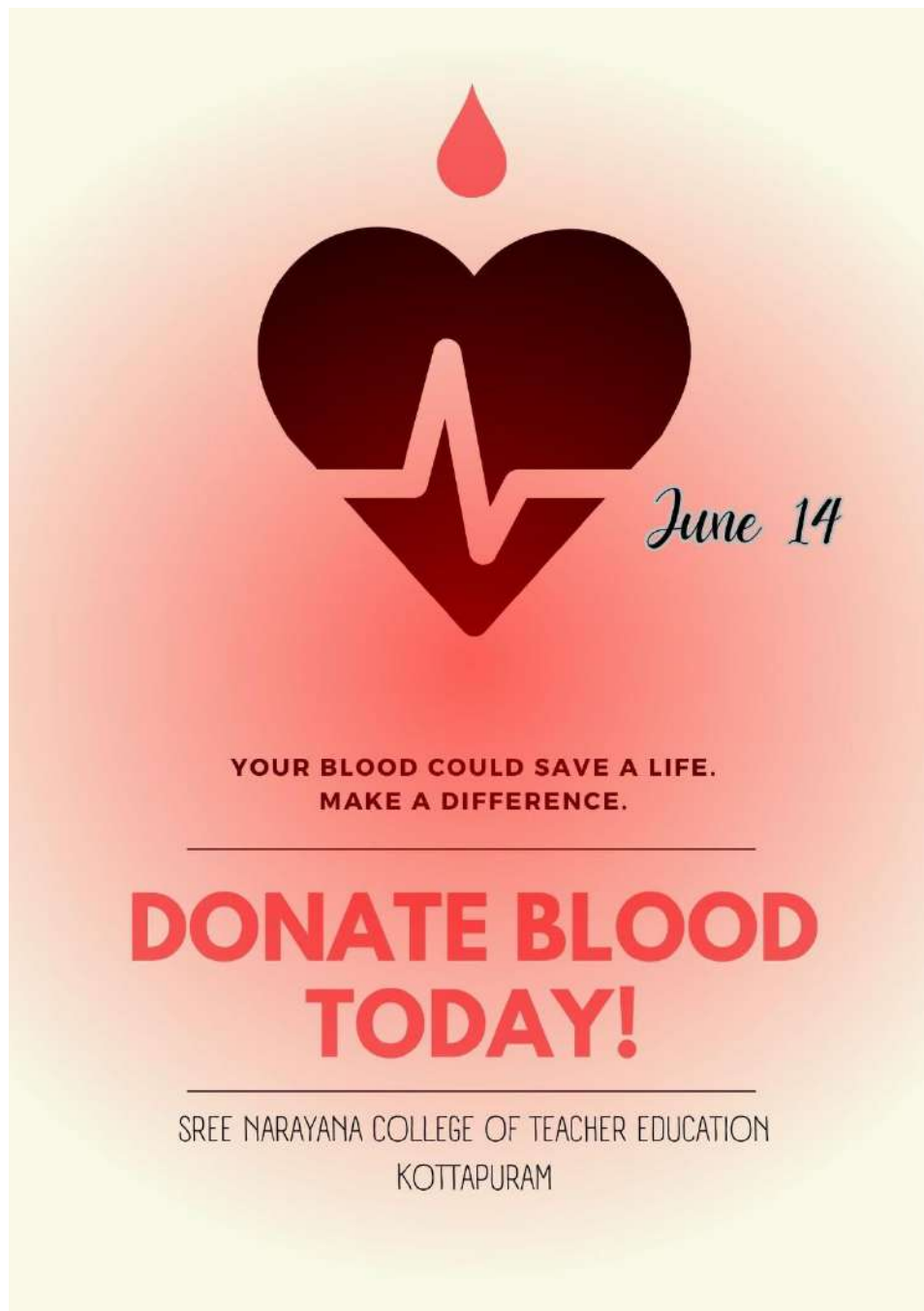
4. DAY AGAINST CHILD LABOUR

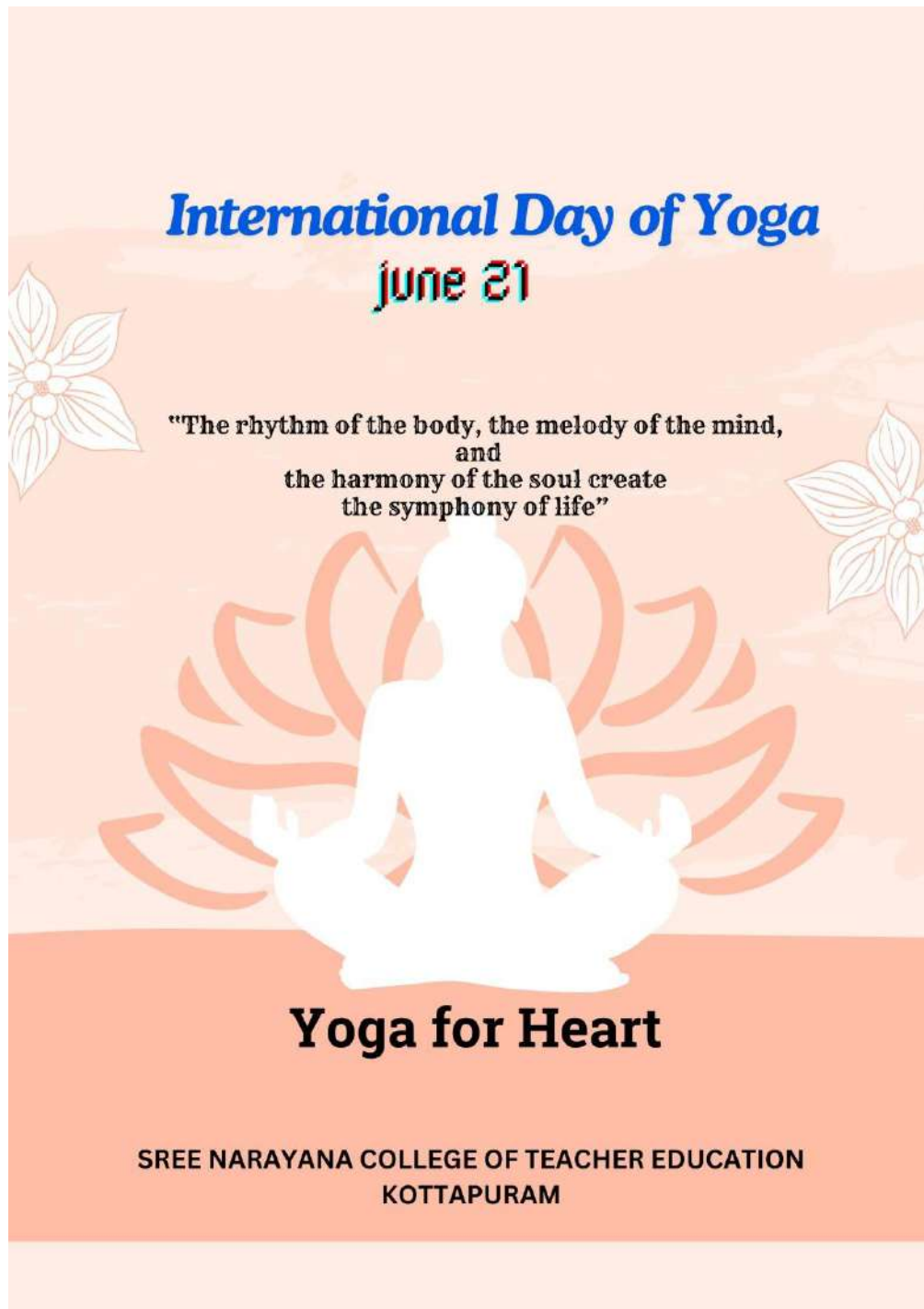
6. READING DAY

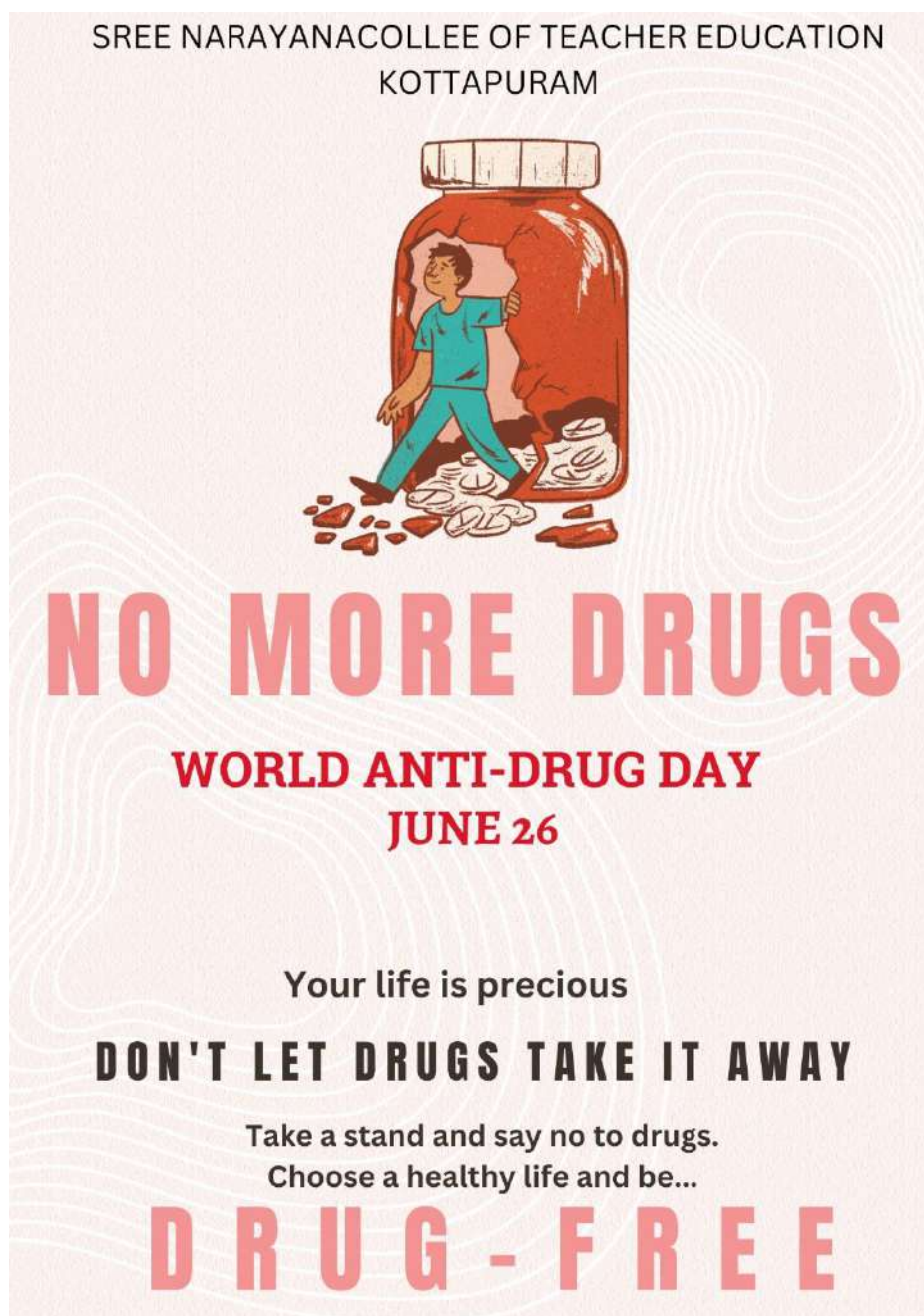
7. YOGA DAY

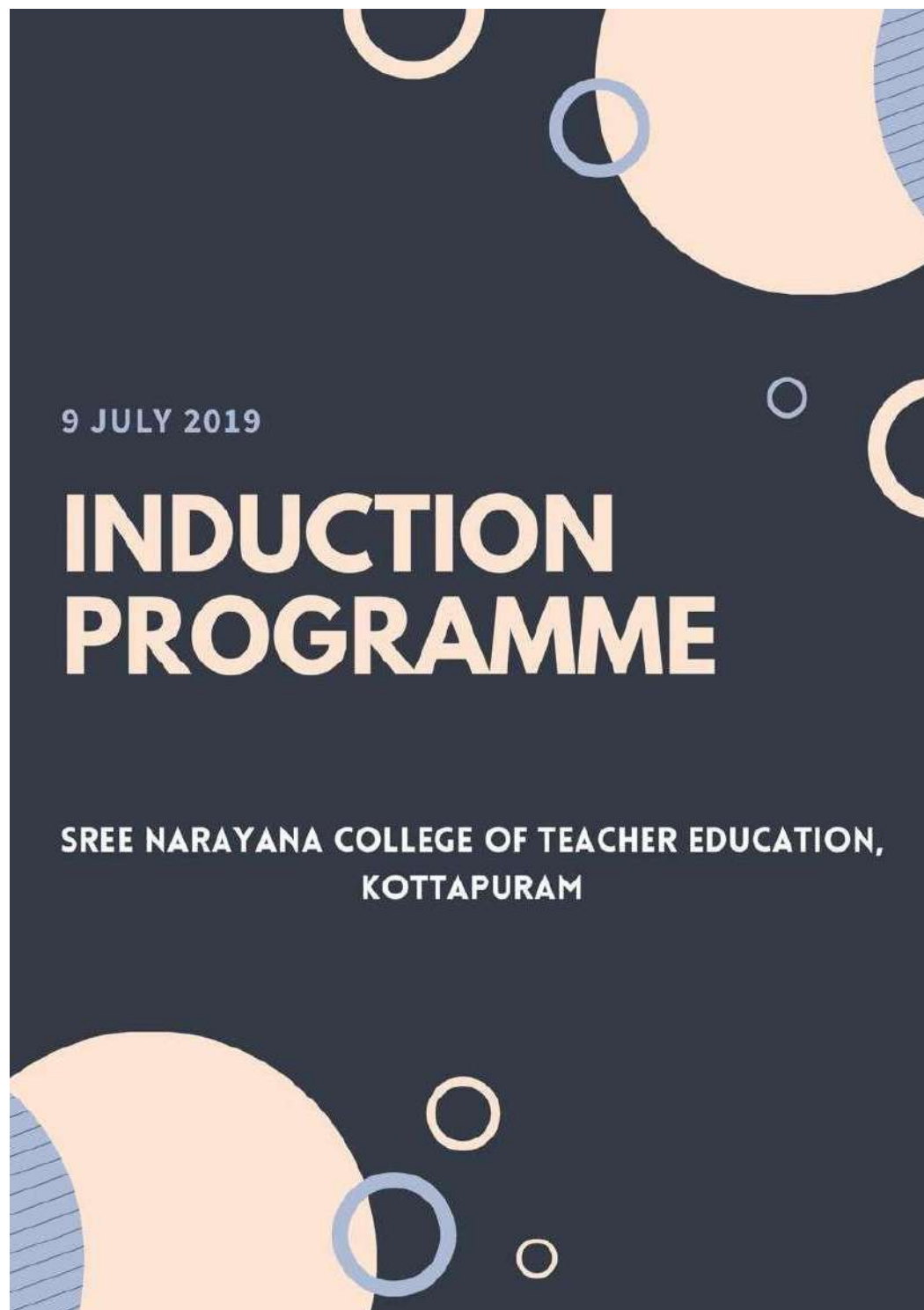

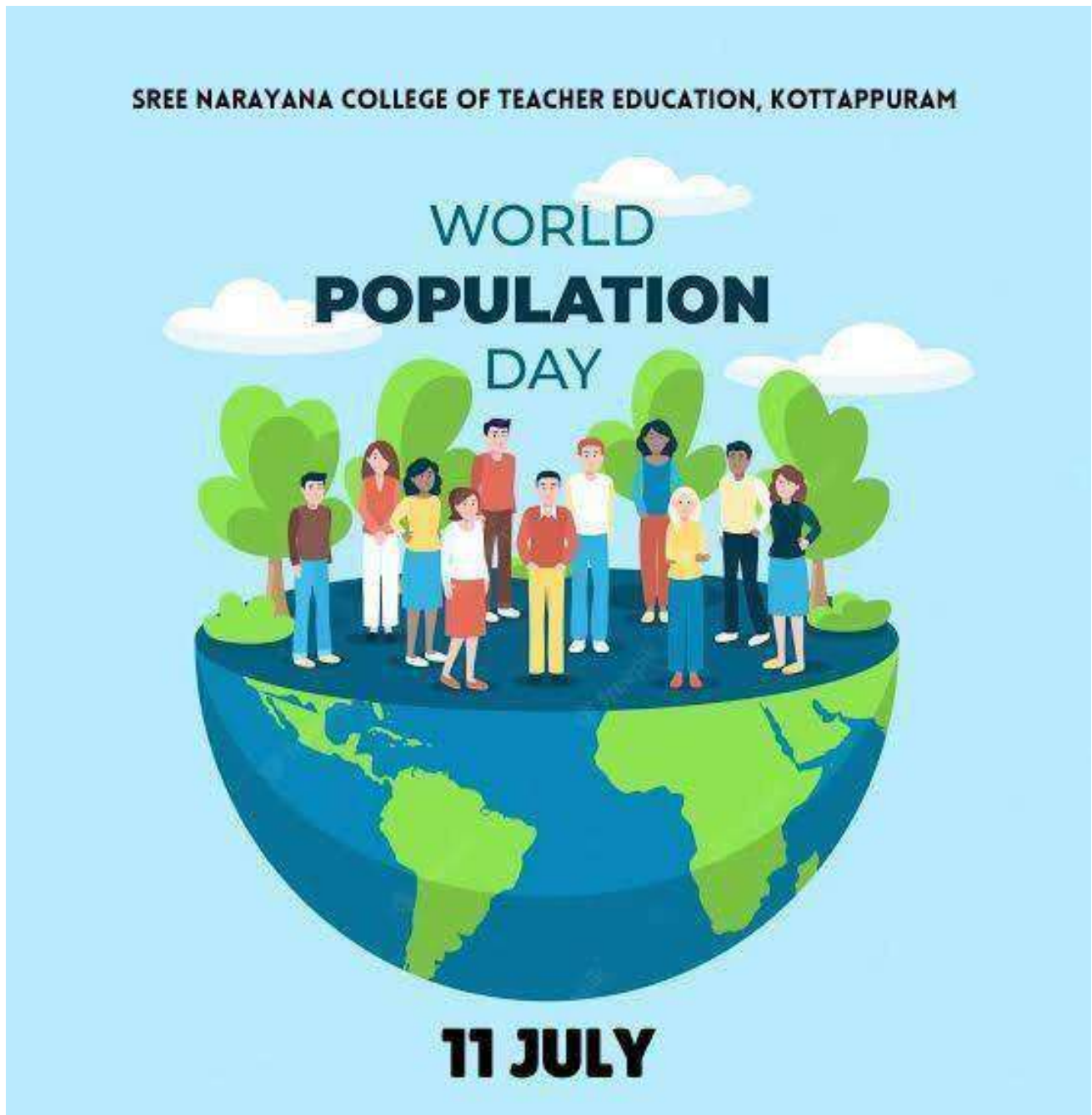
10. INDUCTION PROGRAMME

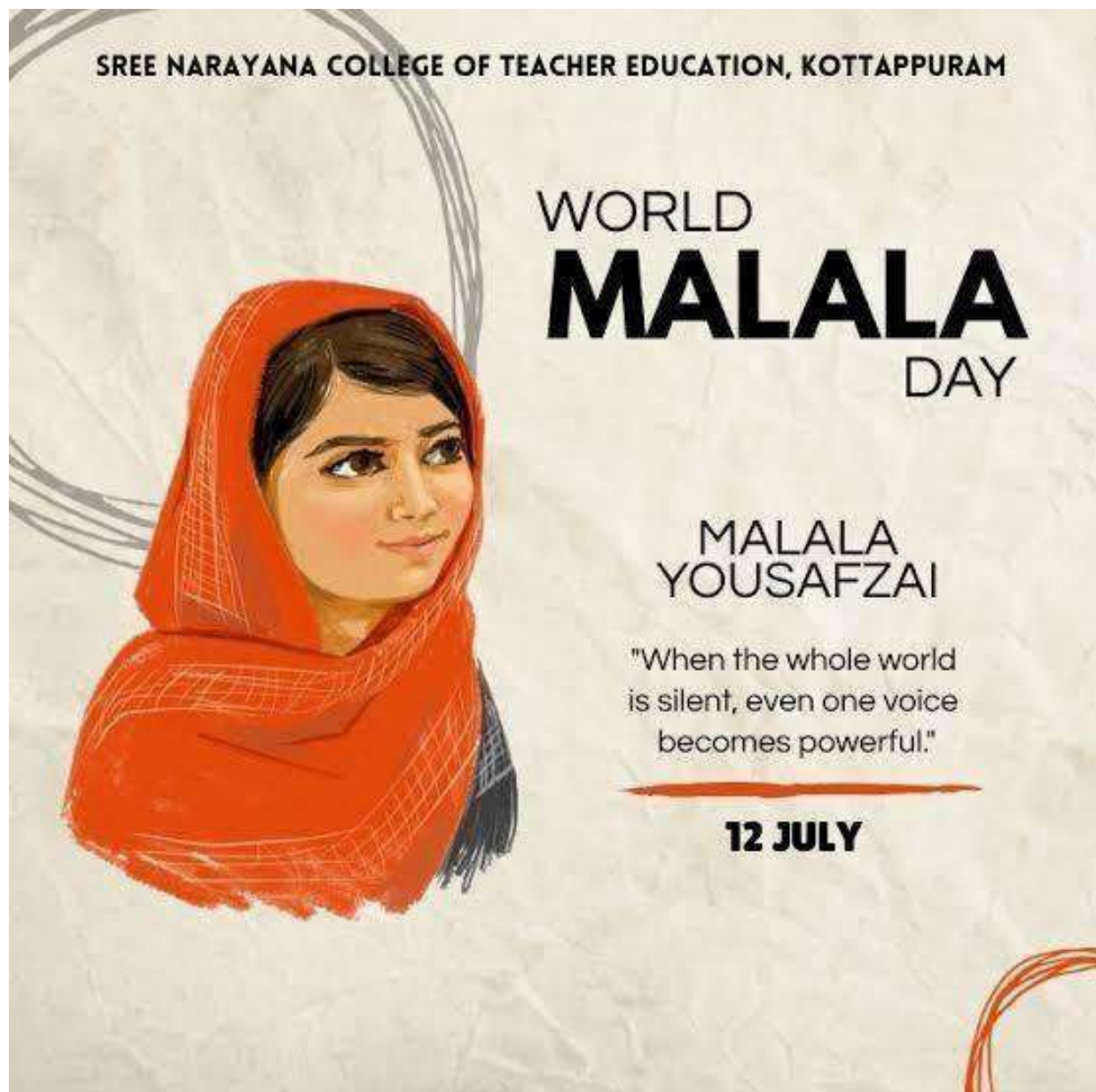
11.WORLD POPULATION DAY

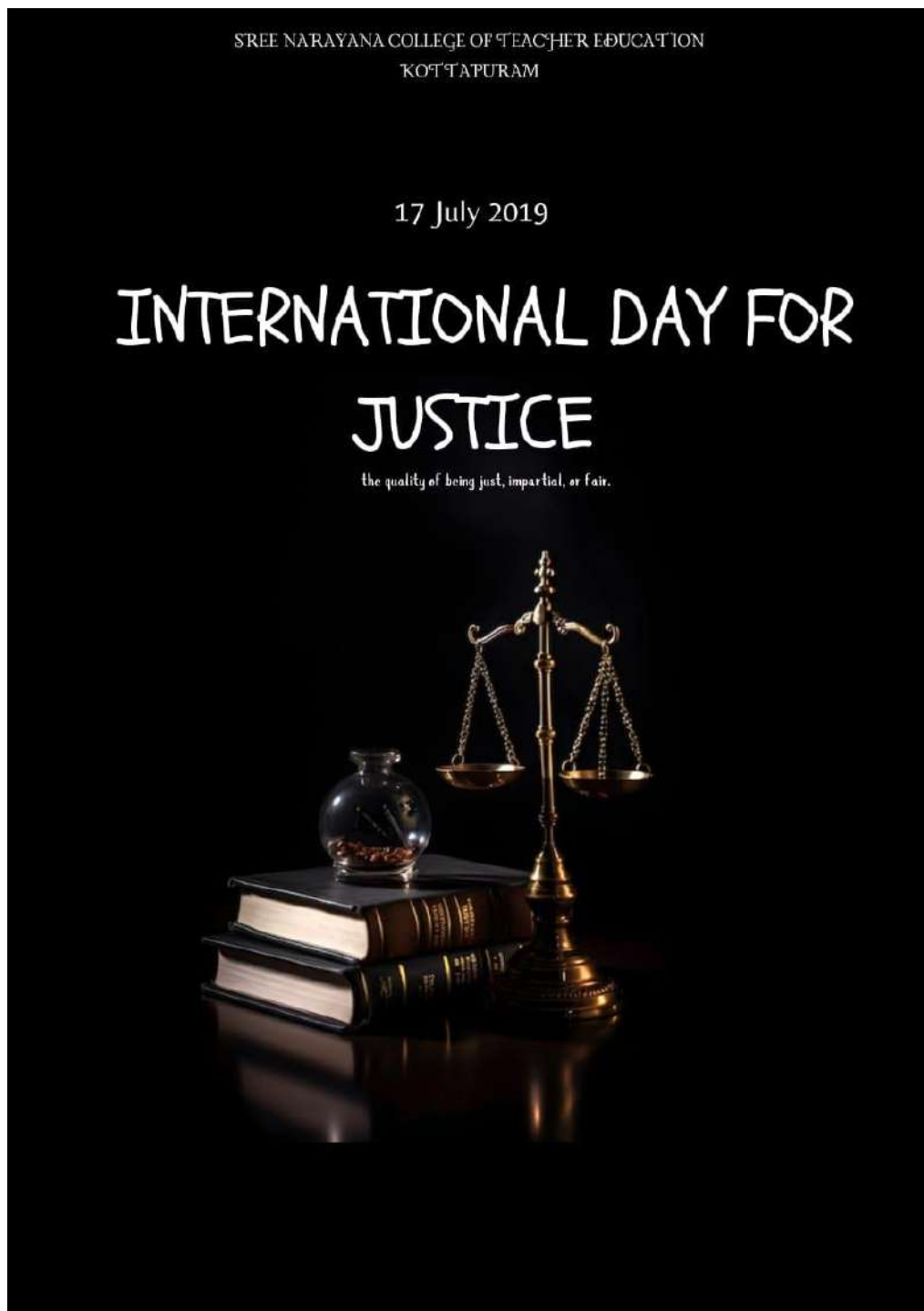
12. WORLD MALALA DAY

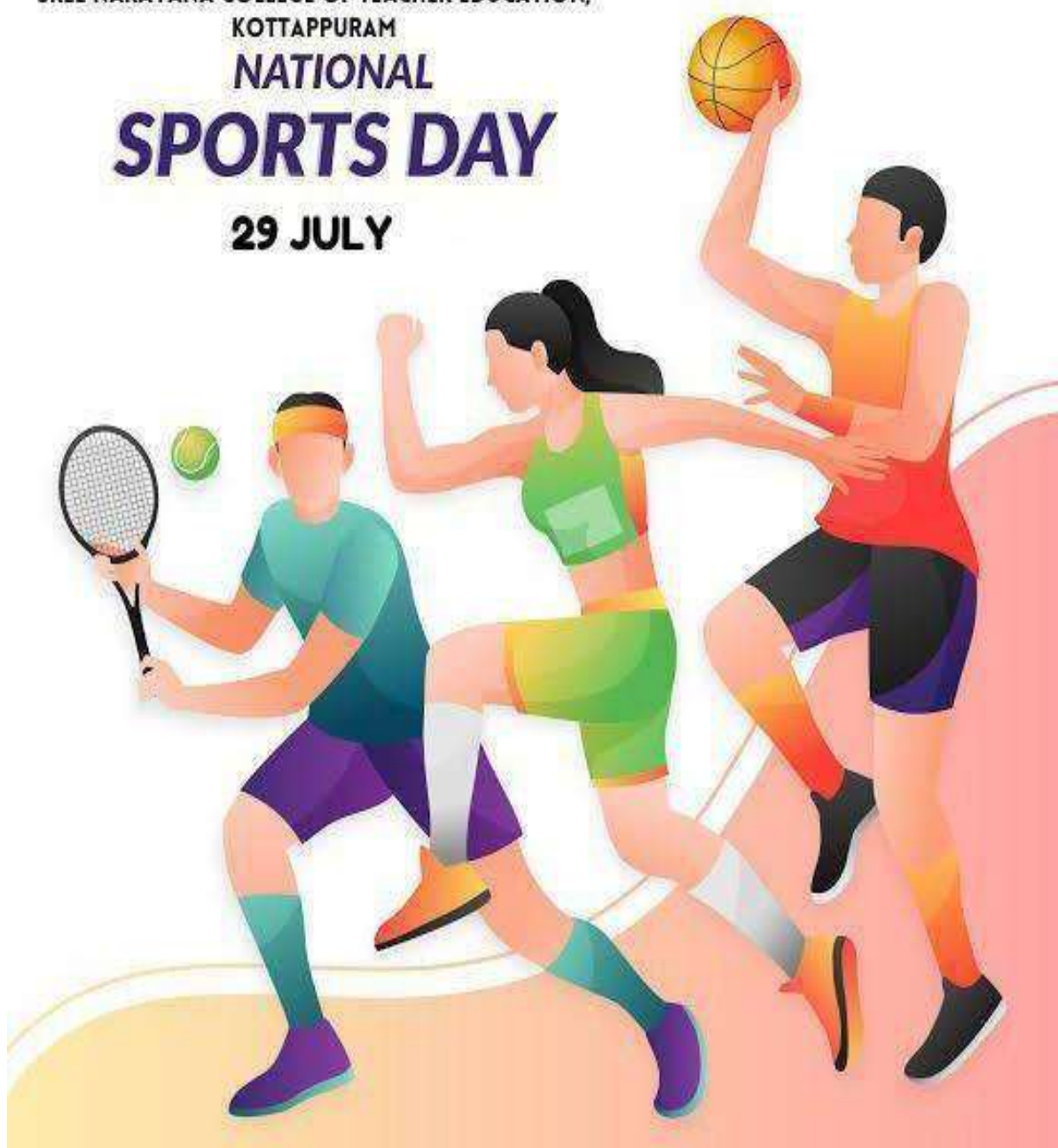
15. NATIONAL SPORTS DAY

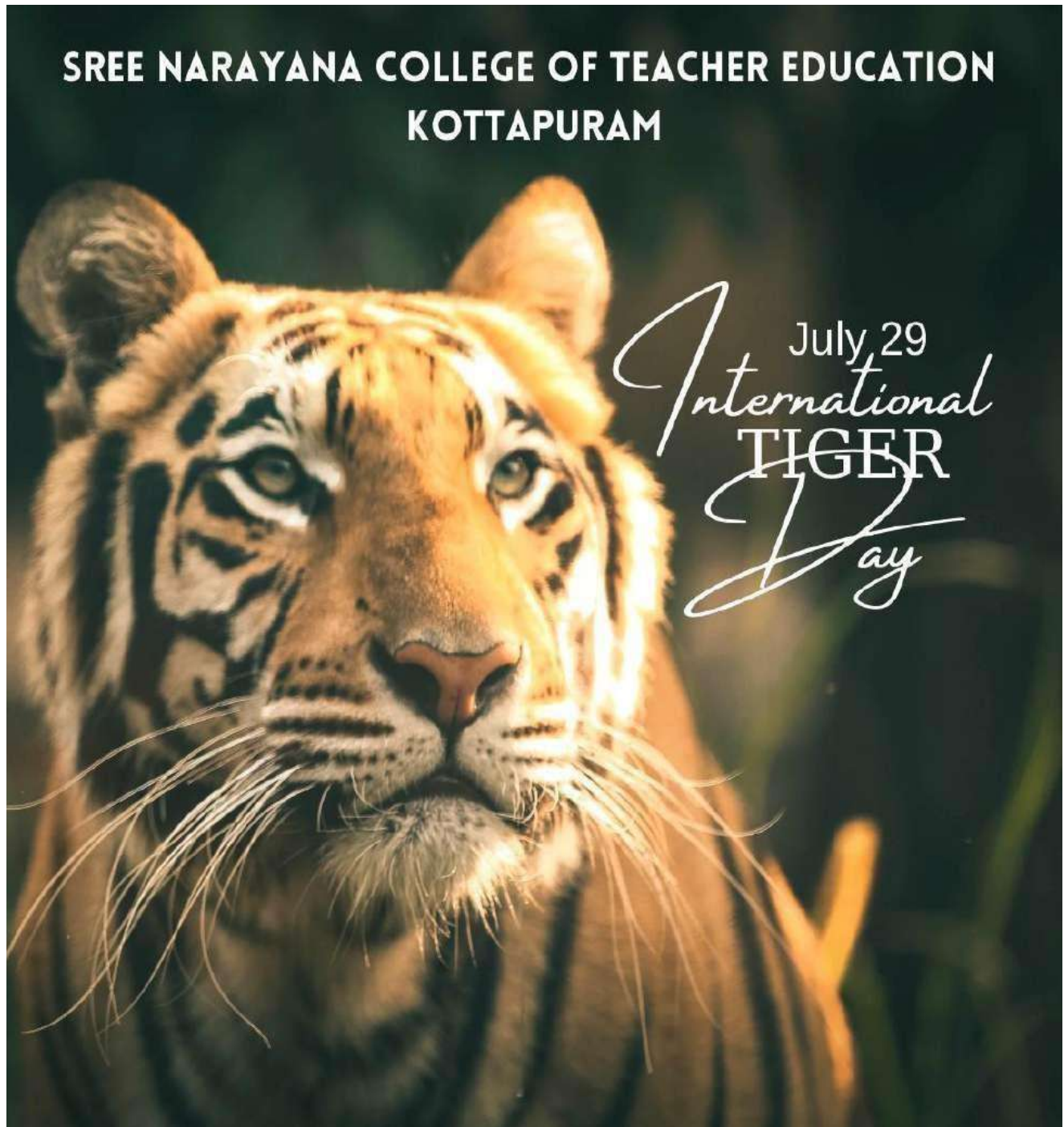

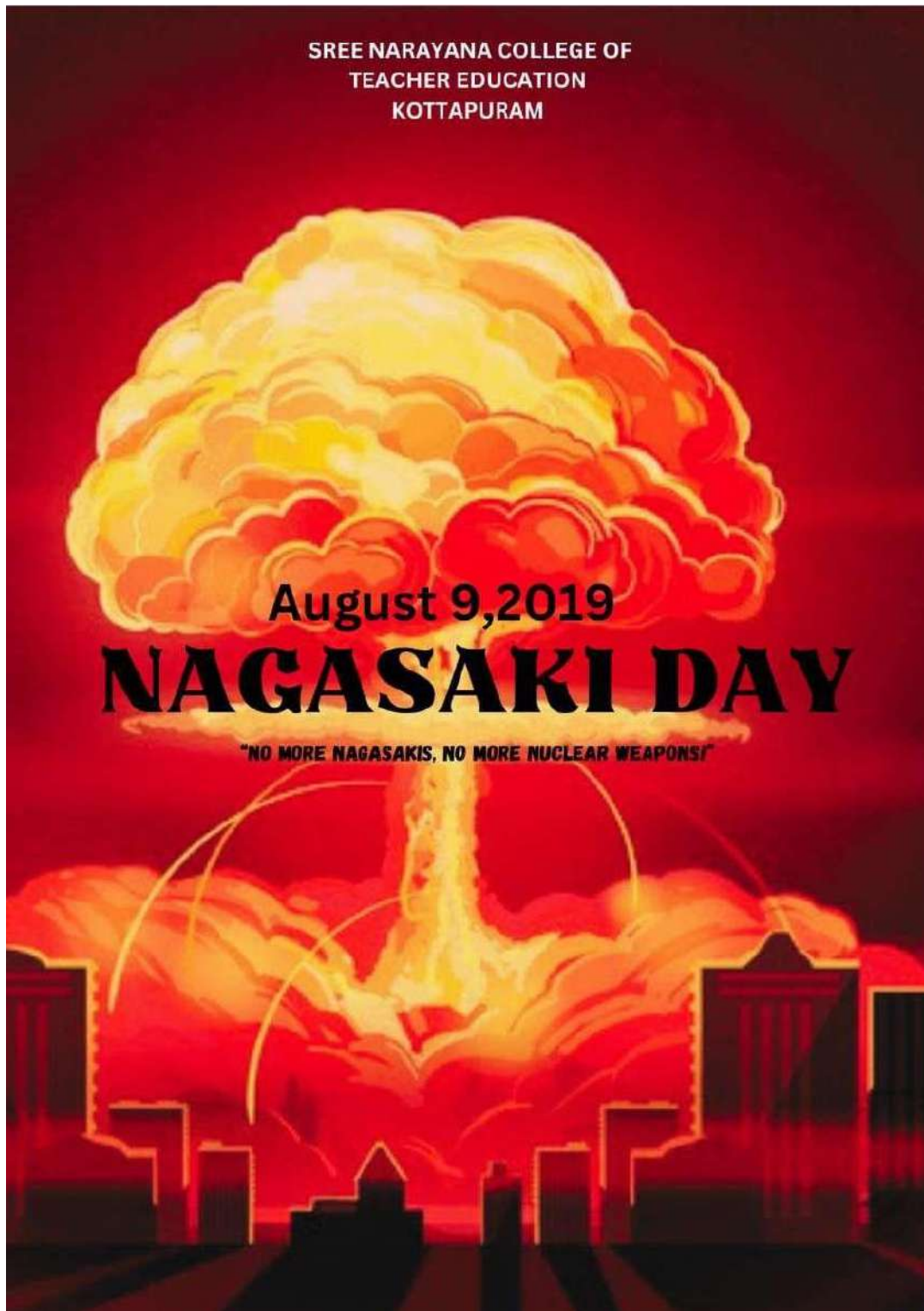

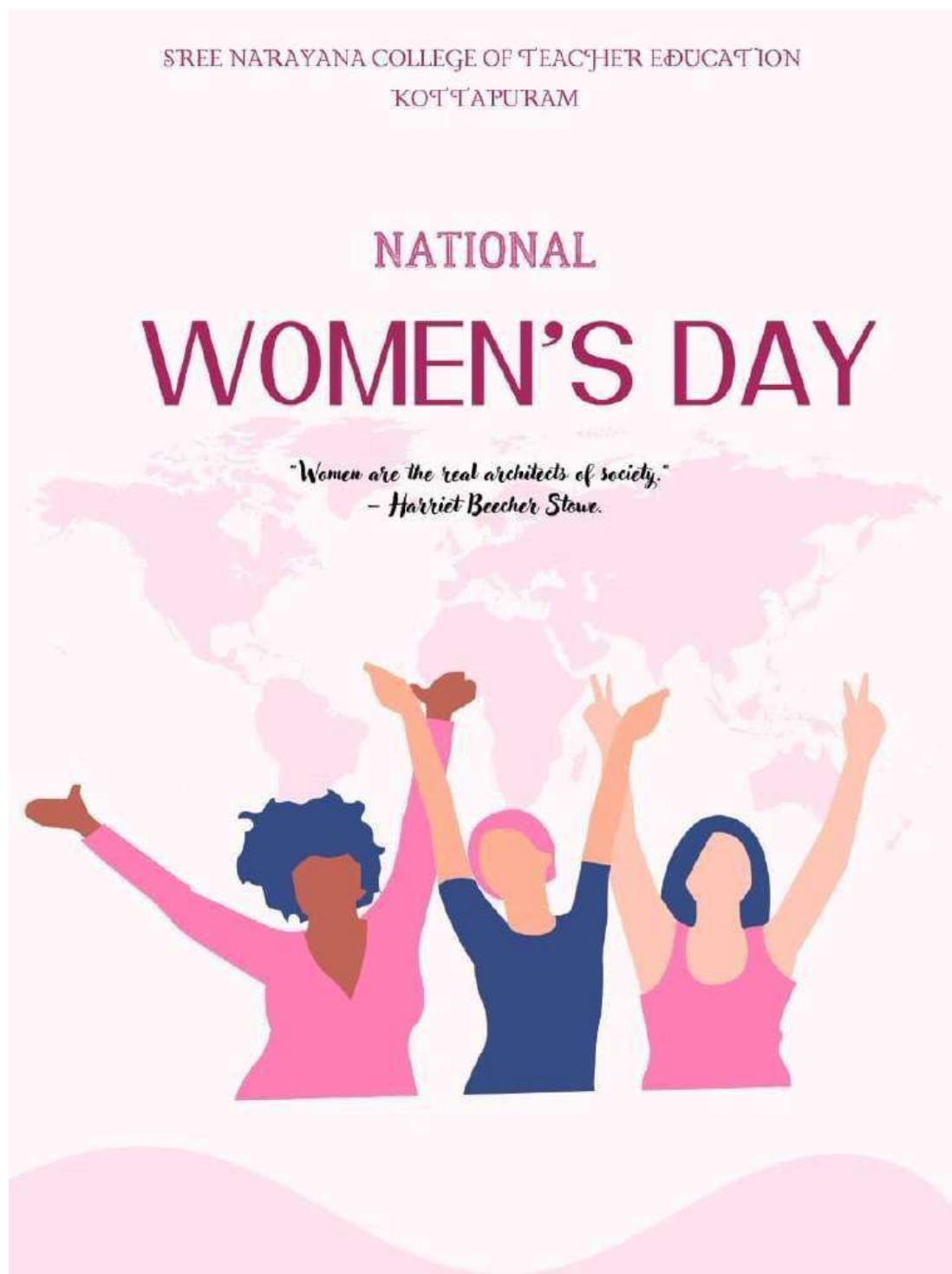
18. NAGASAKI DAY

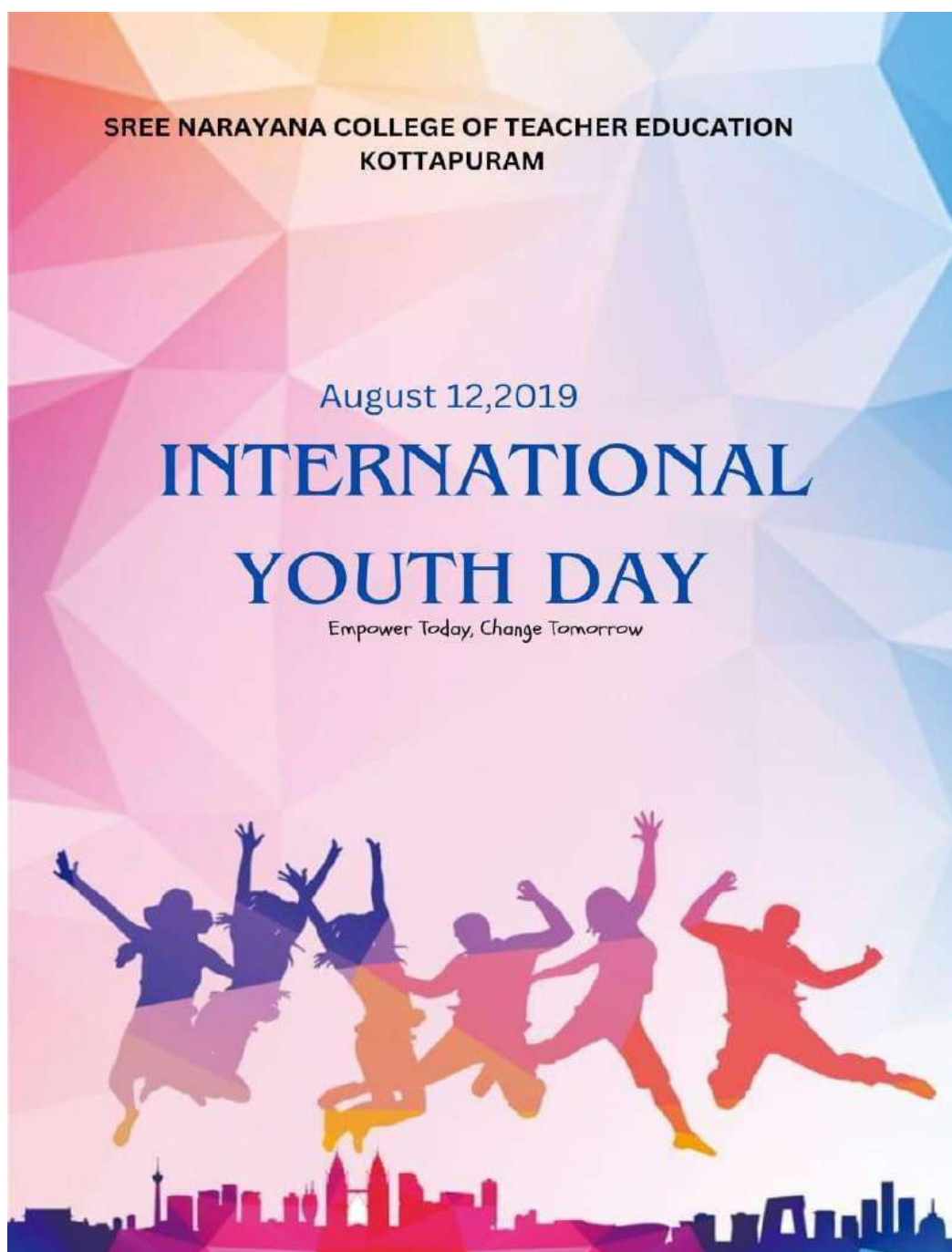
19. NATIONAL WOMENS DAY

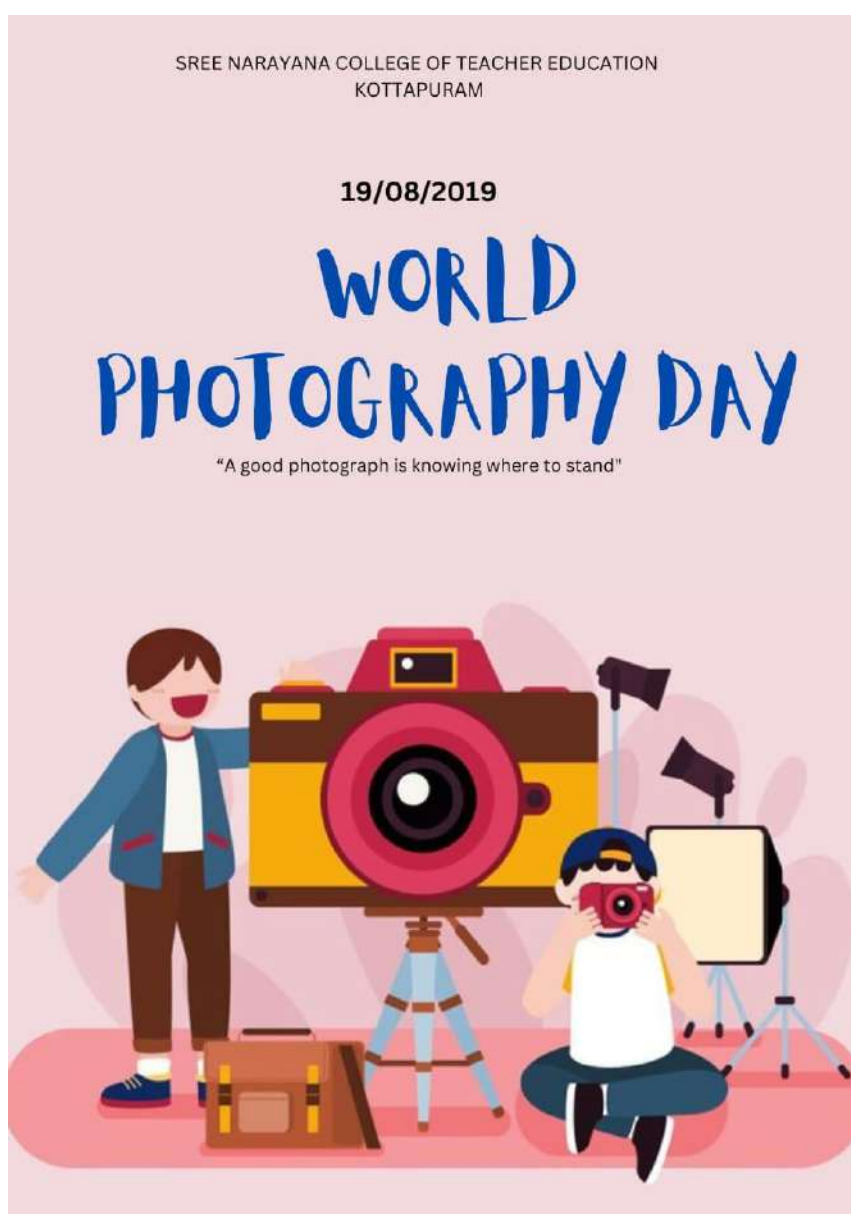

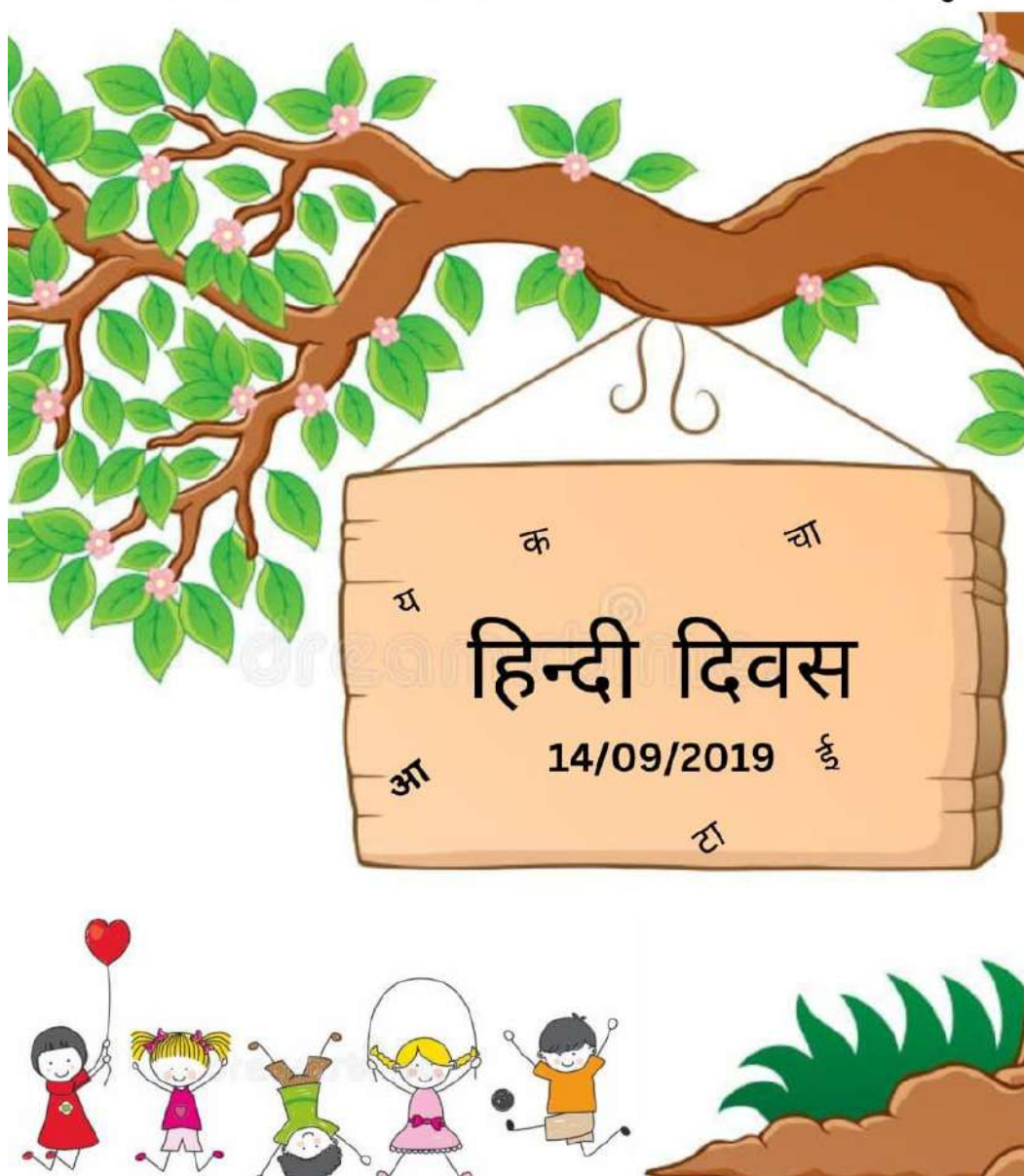


24. NATIONAL HINDI DAY

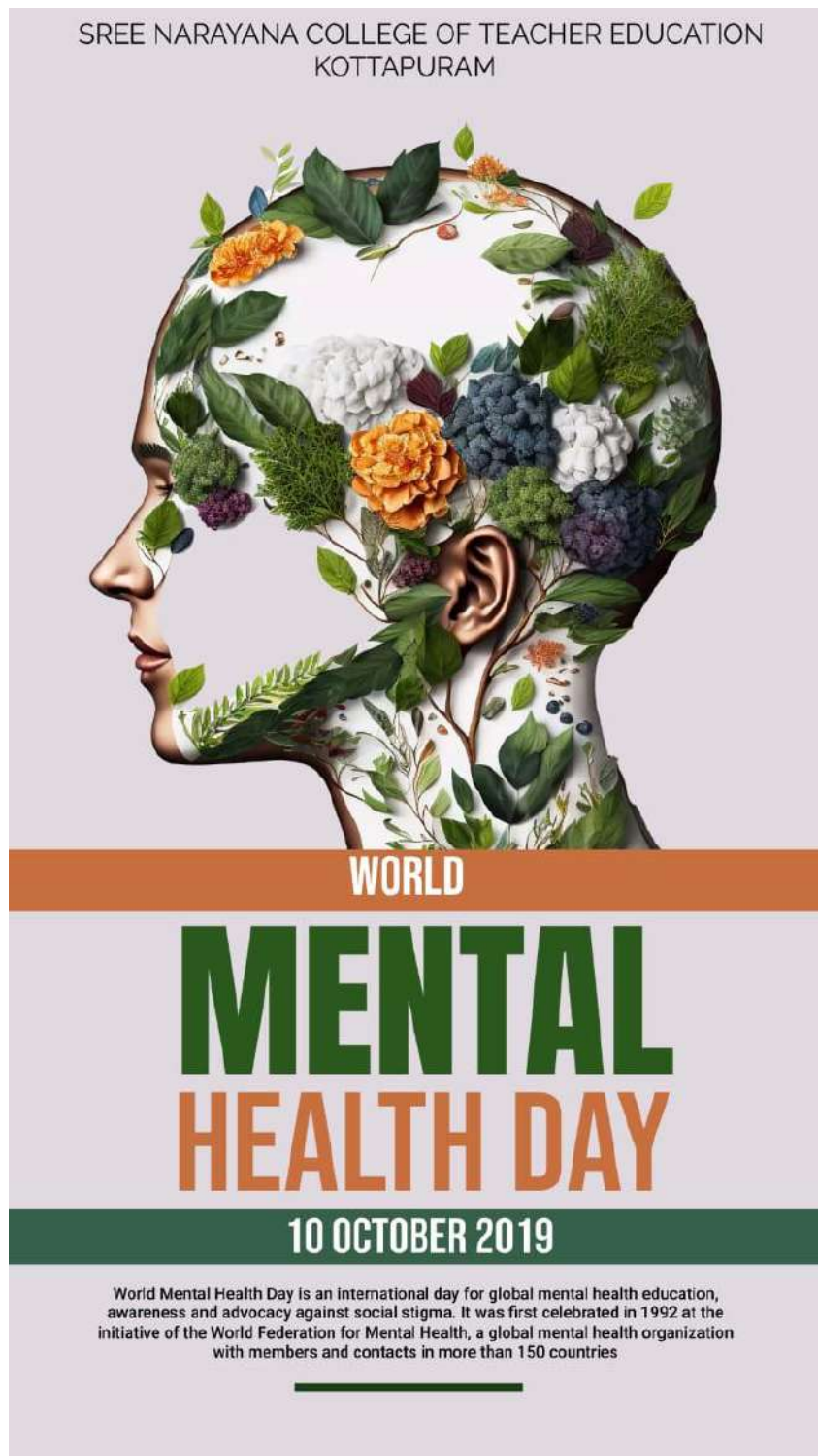
34. ART DAY

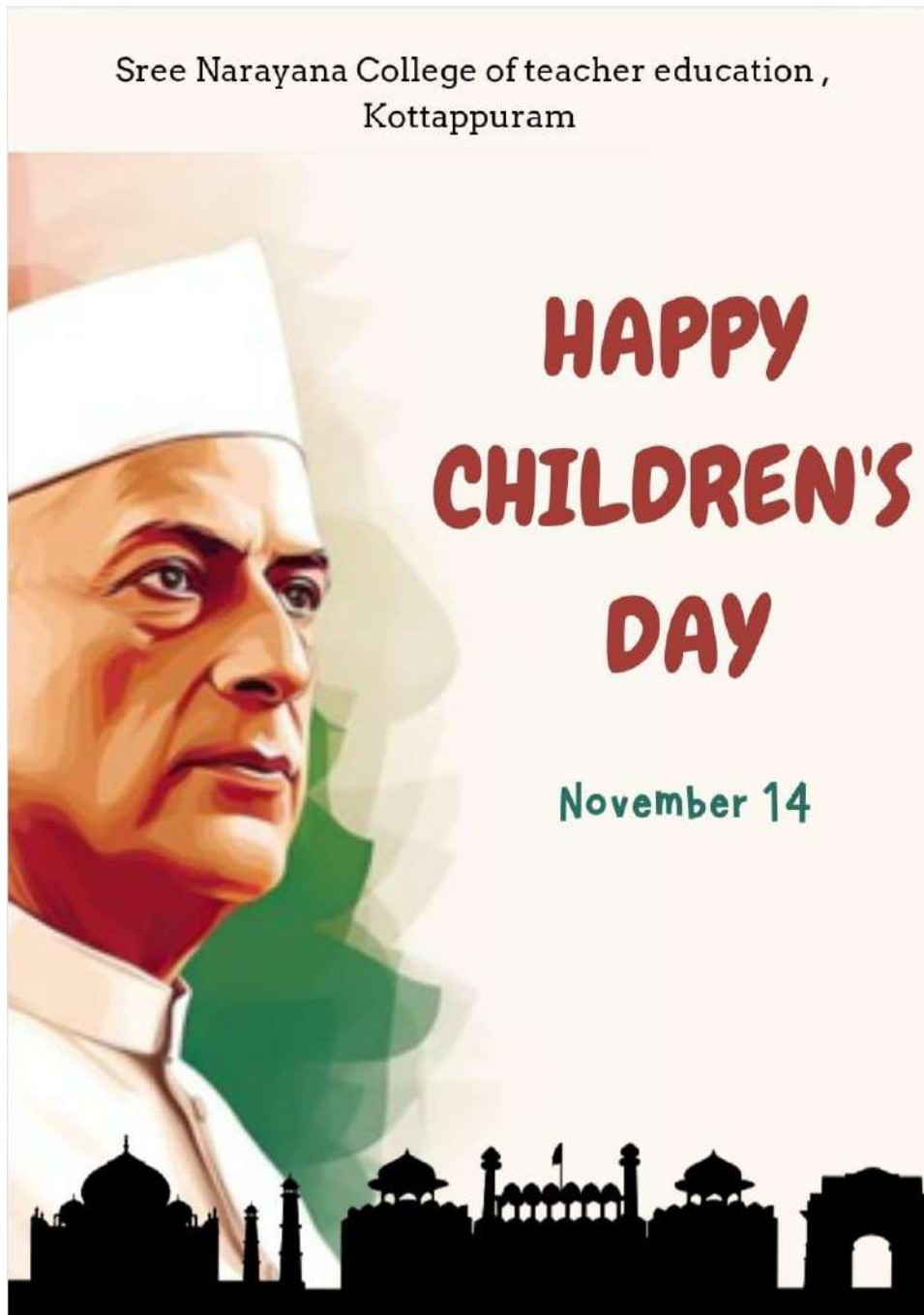

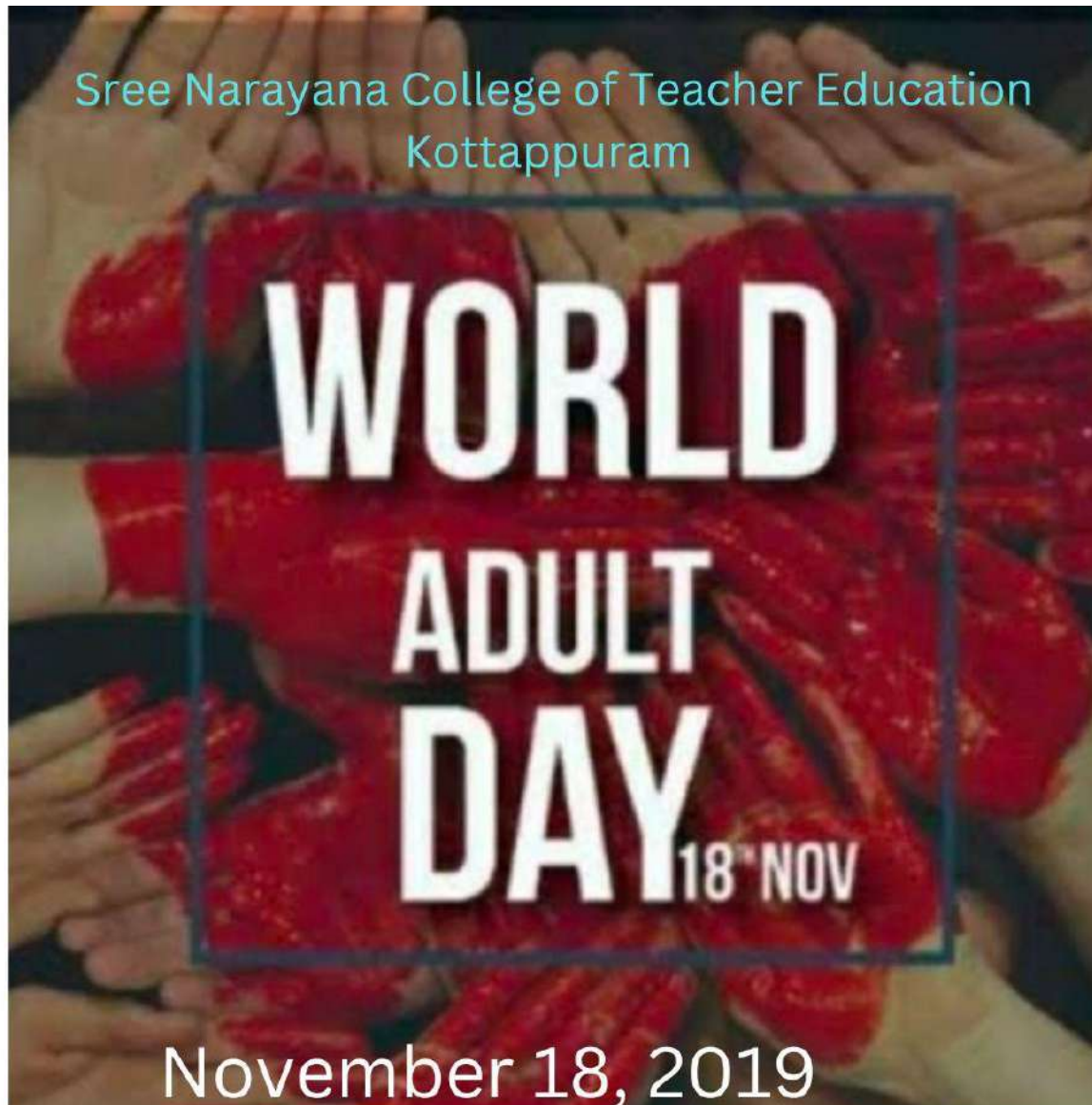
41. CHILDREN'S DAY

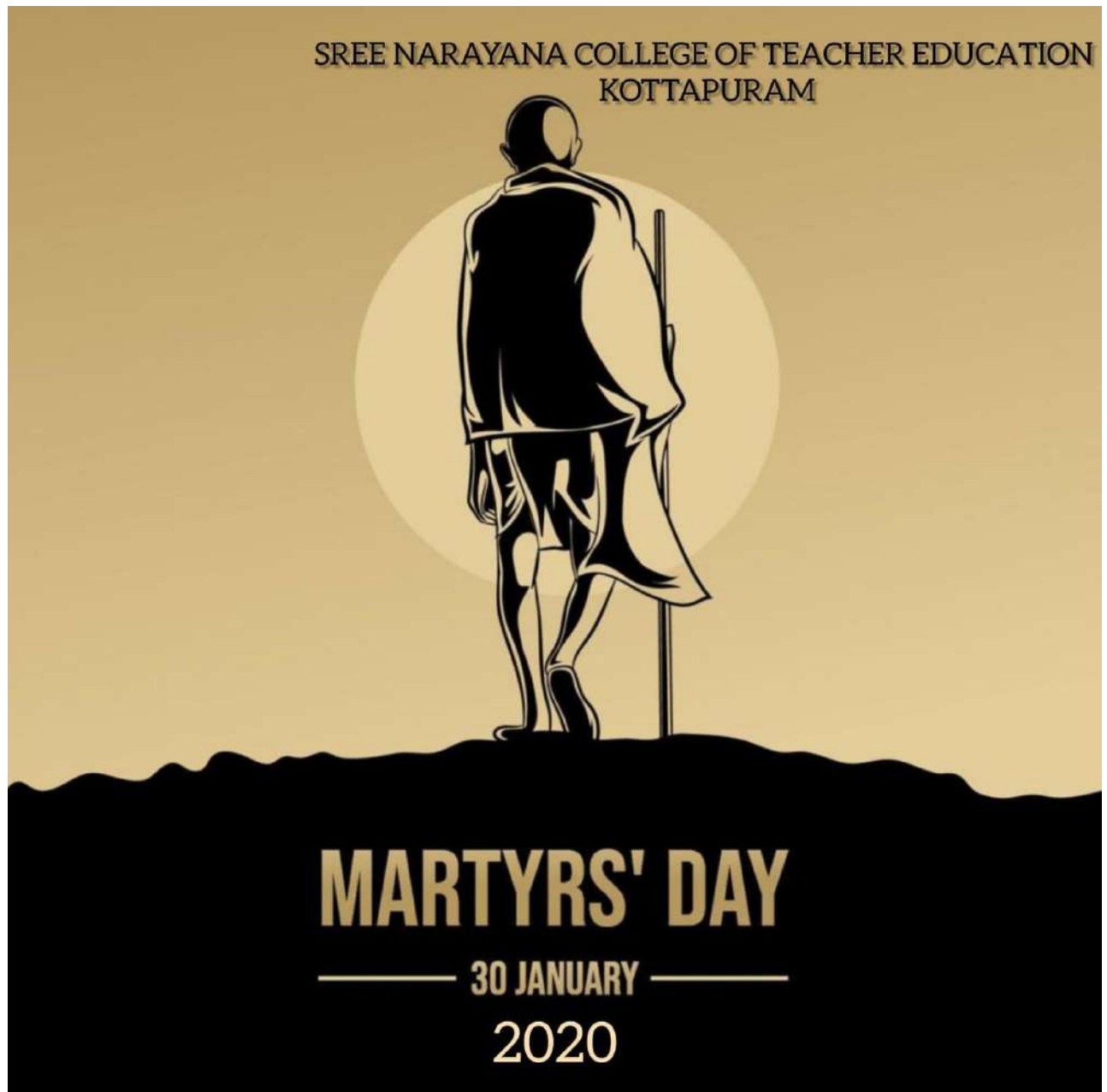

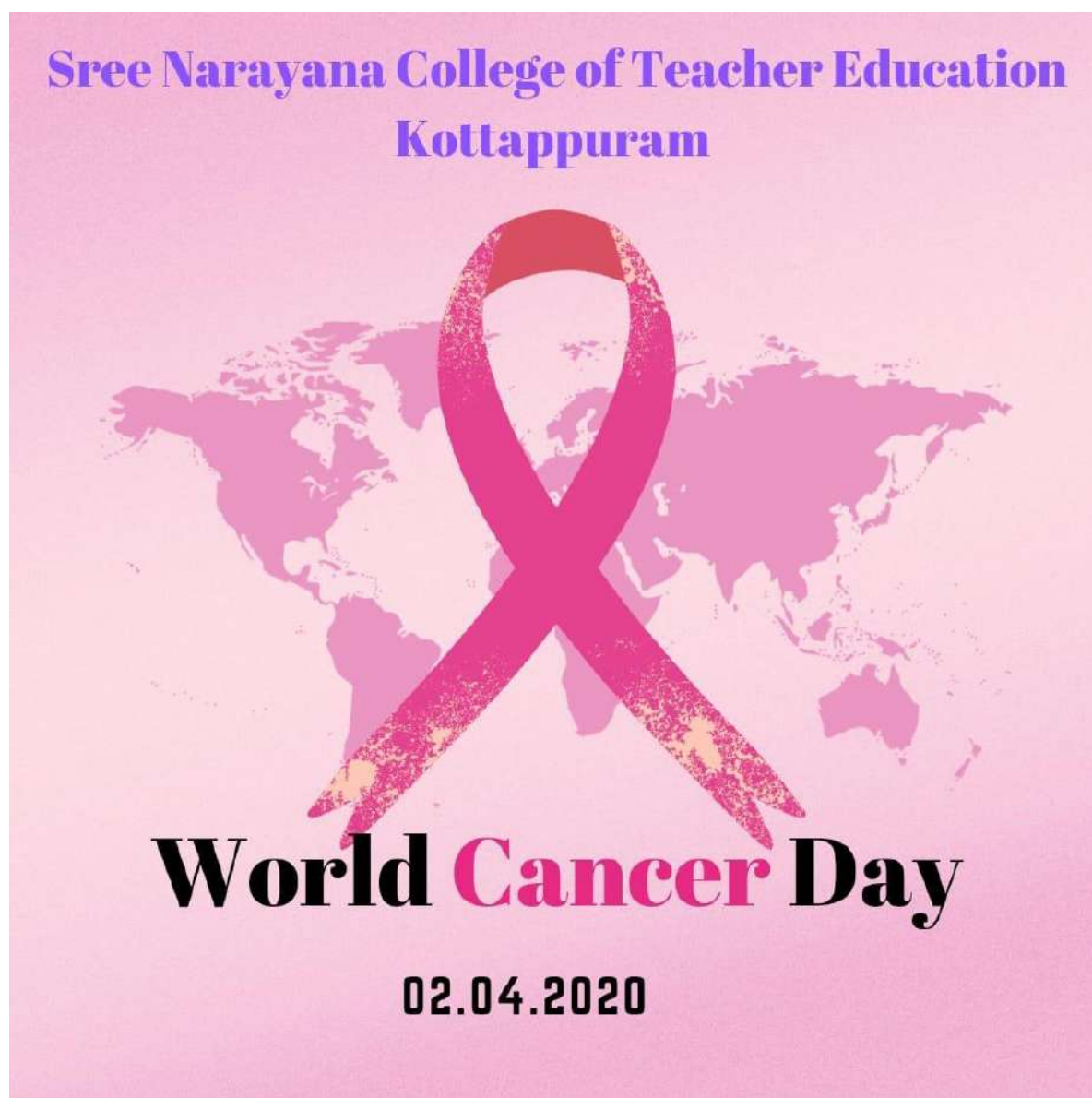
53. MARTYRS DAY

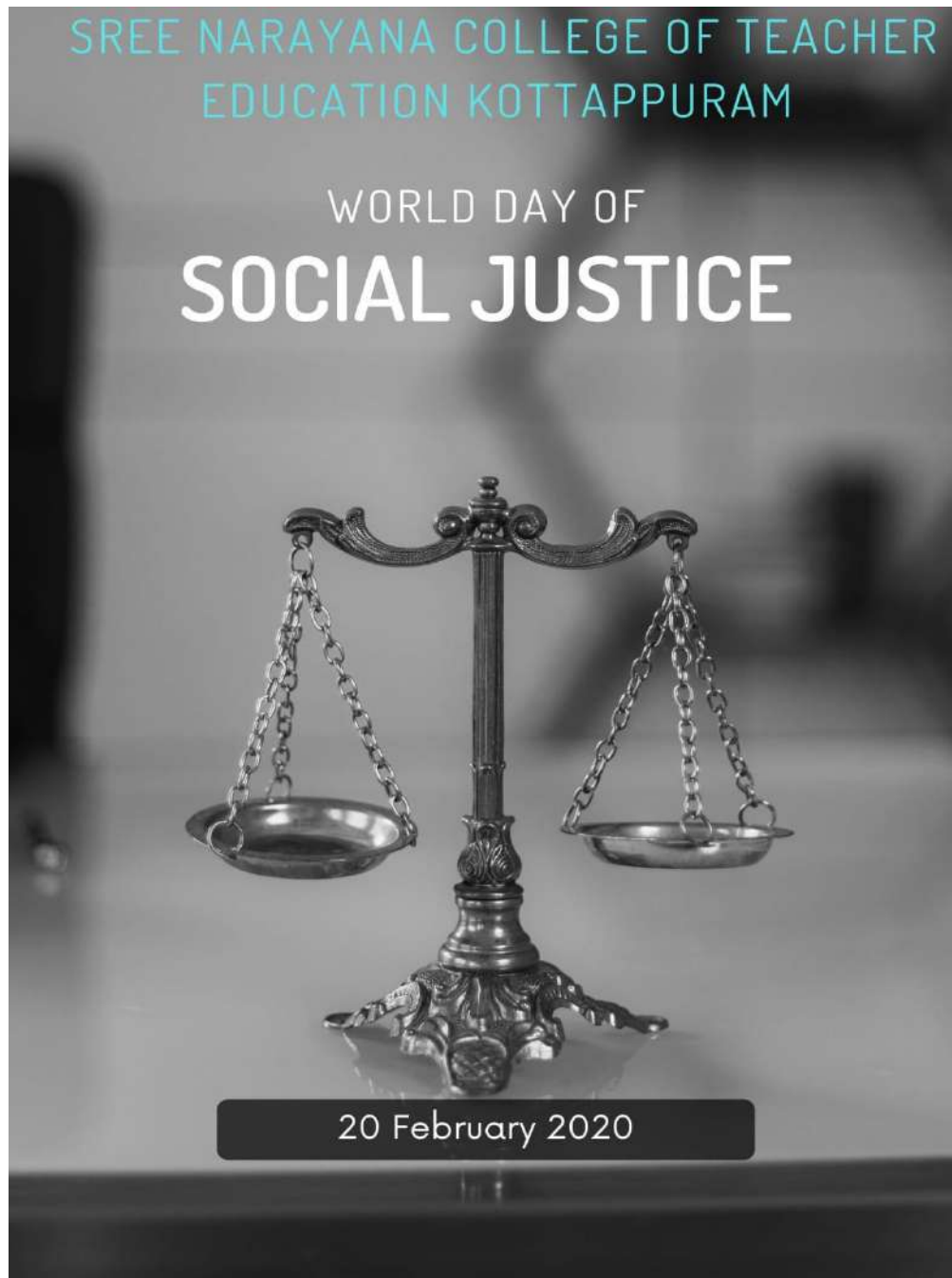

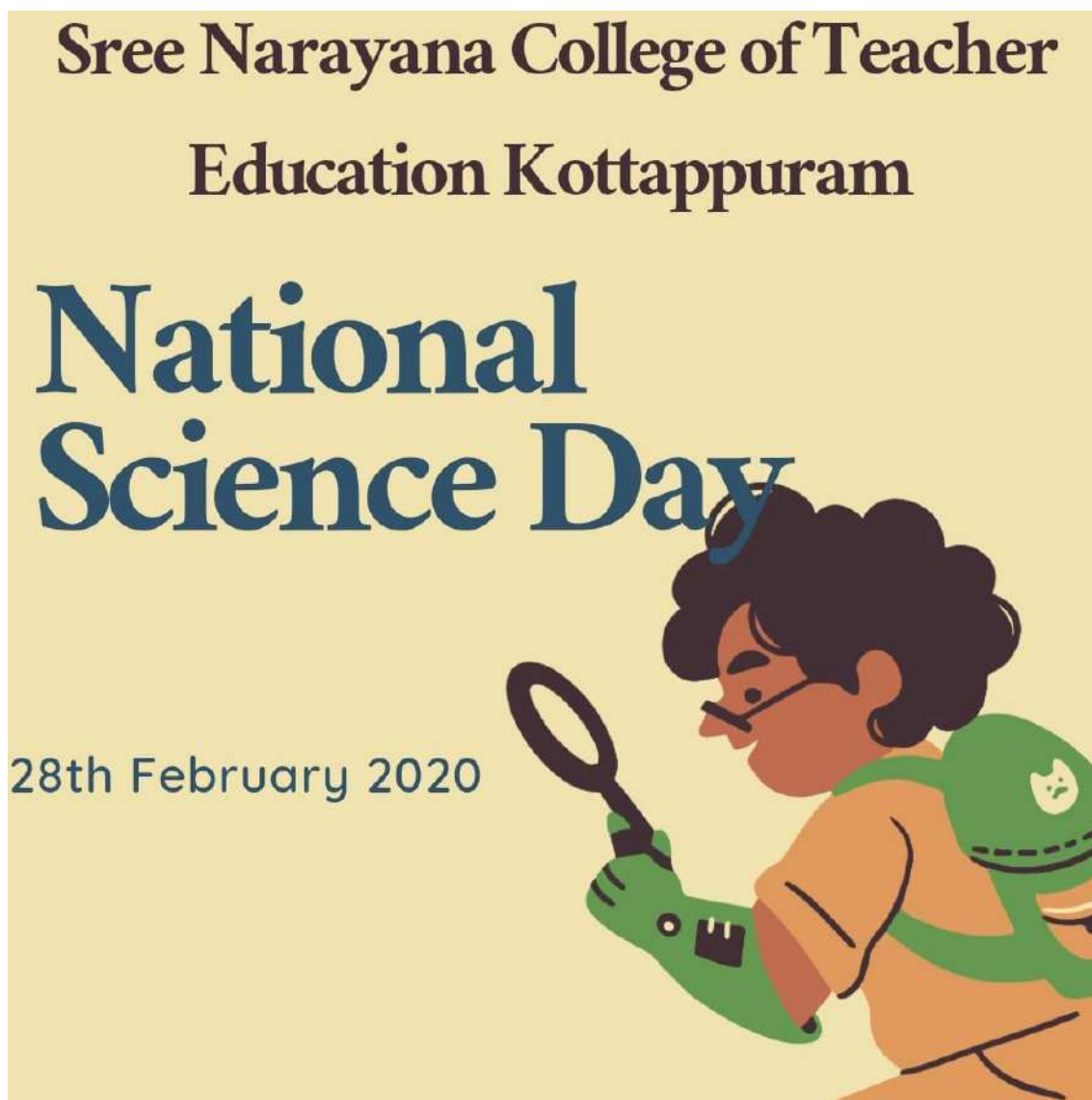
57. INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY

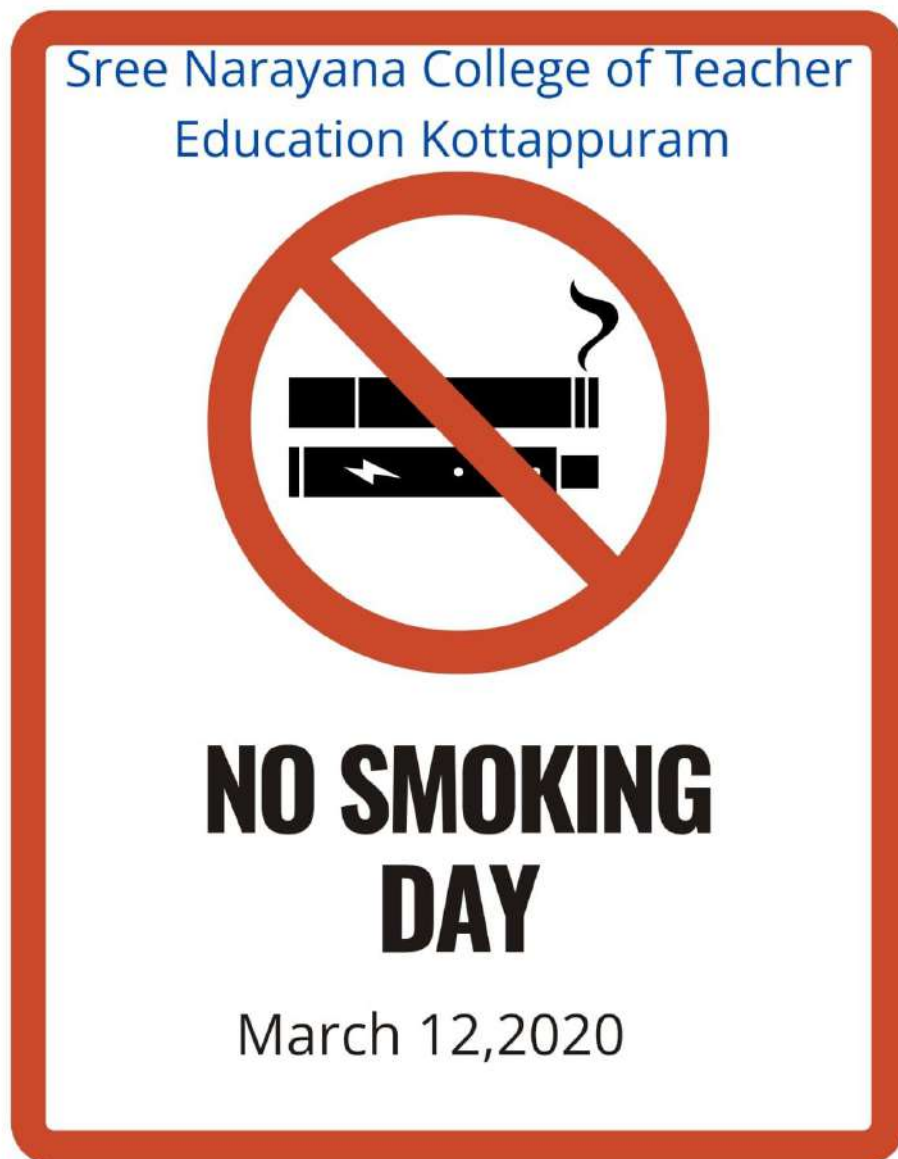
58. NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY CELEBRATION

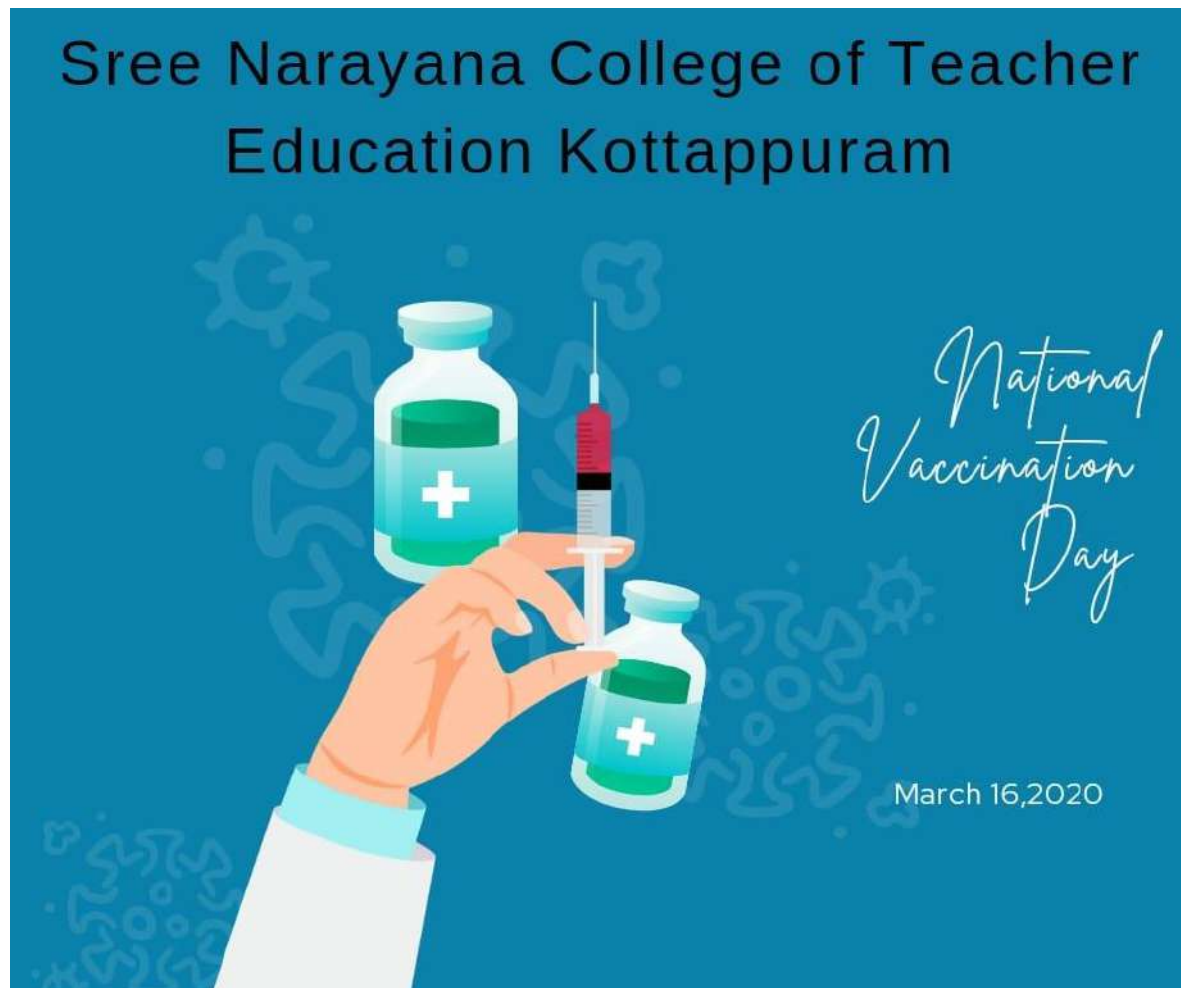
59. NO SMOKING DAY
