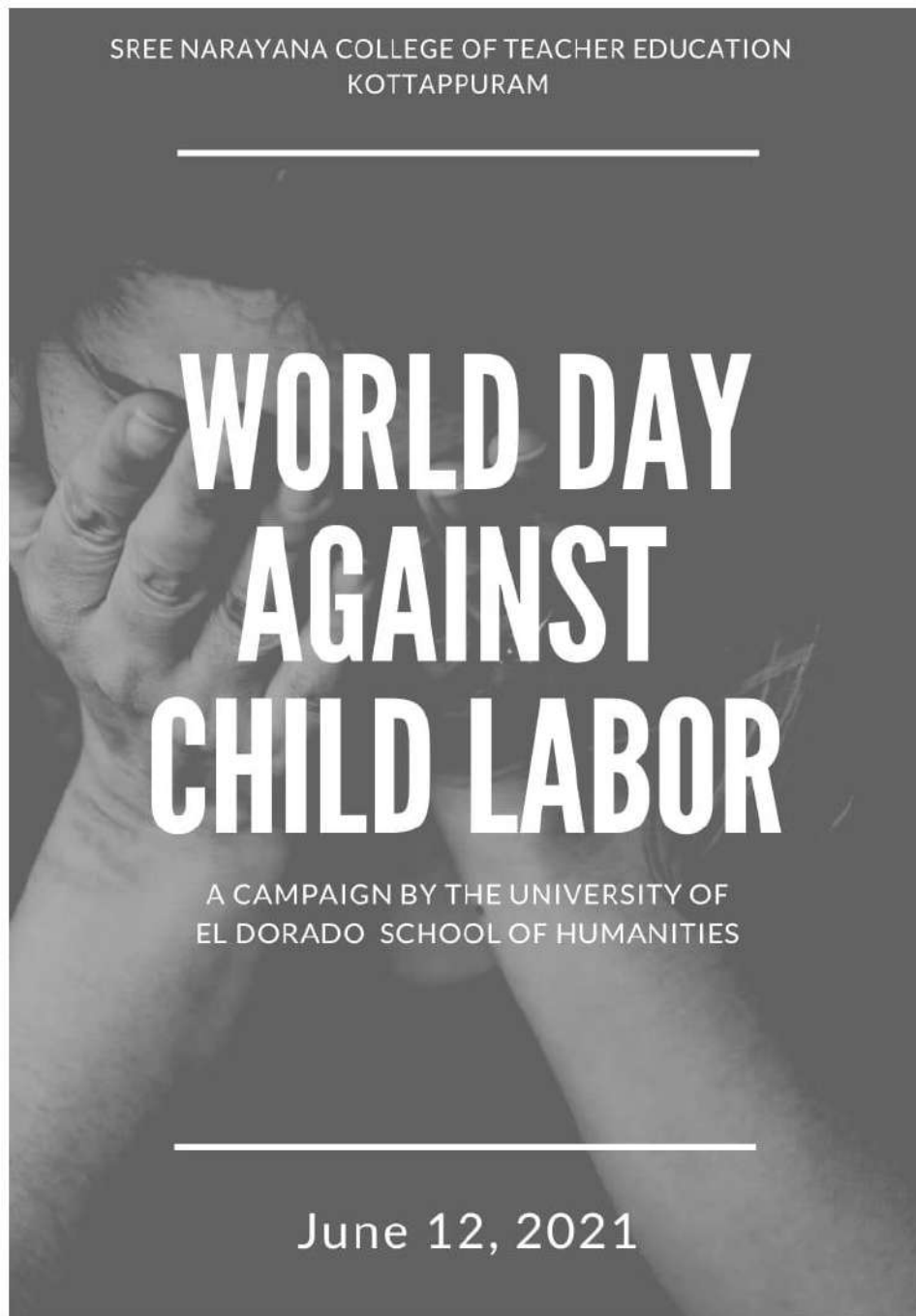
6. CAREER AND PERSONAL COUNSELING

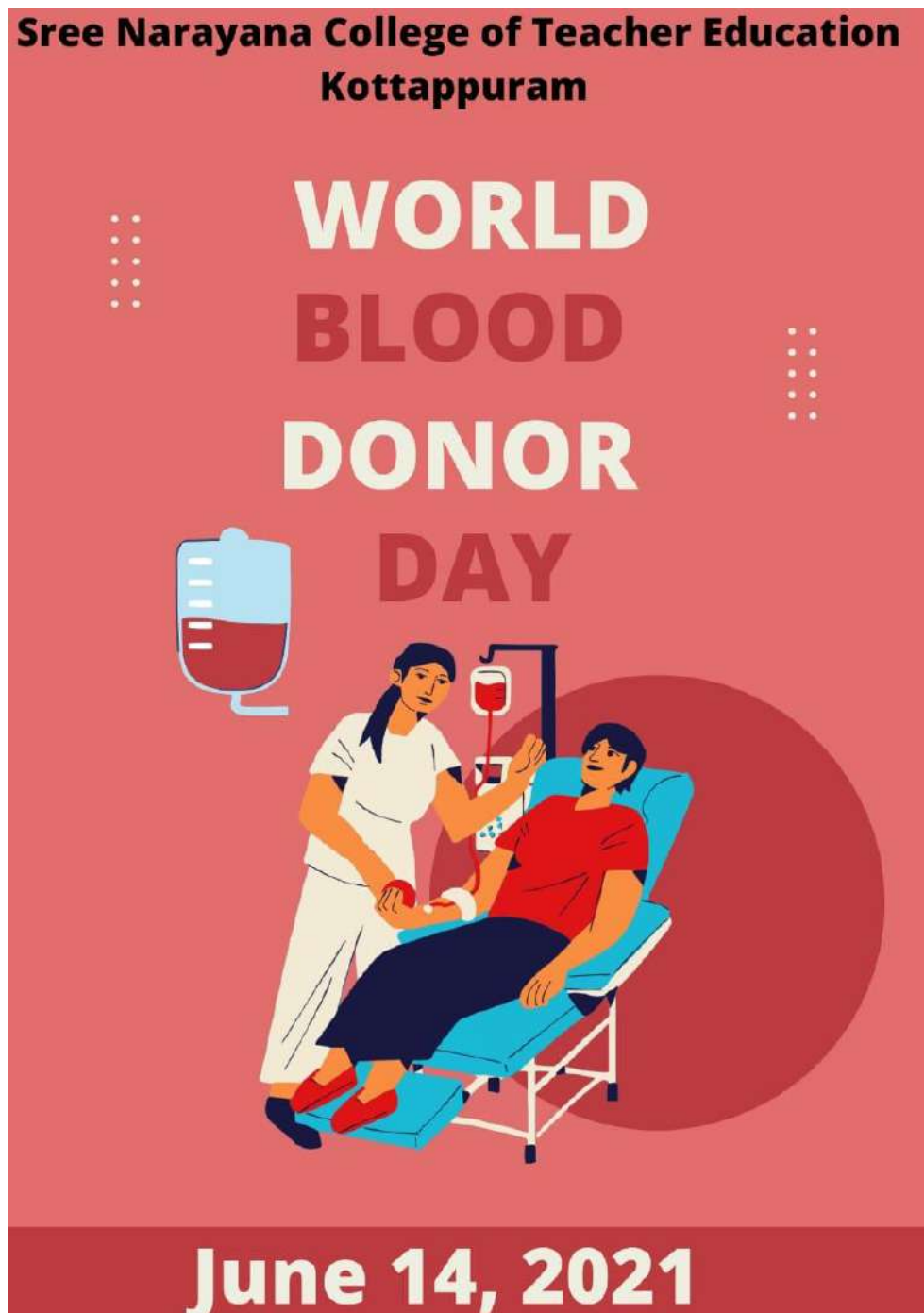
7. CHILD LABOUR DAY

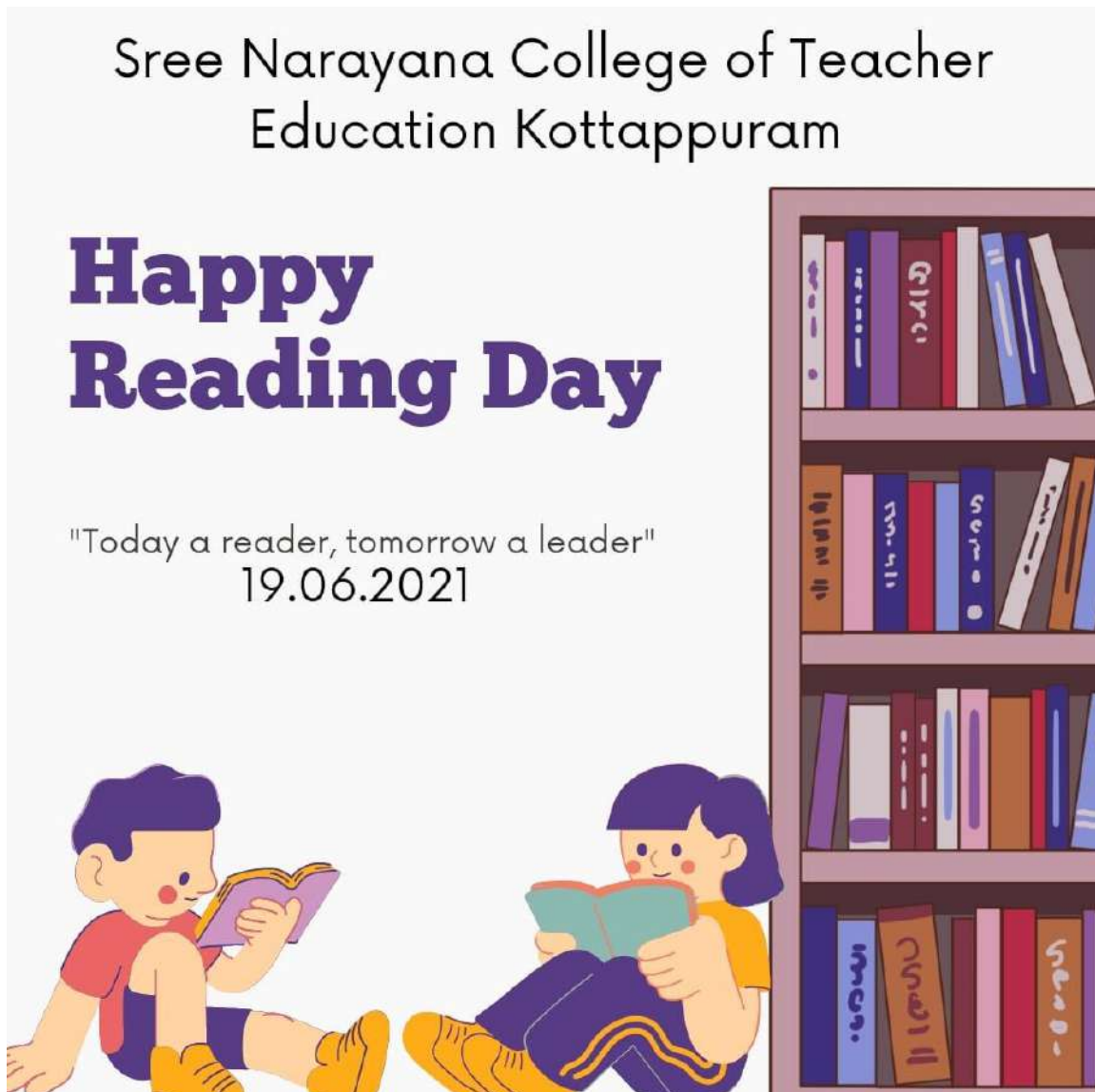
8. BLOOD DONORS DAY

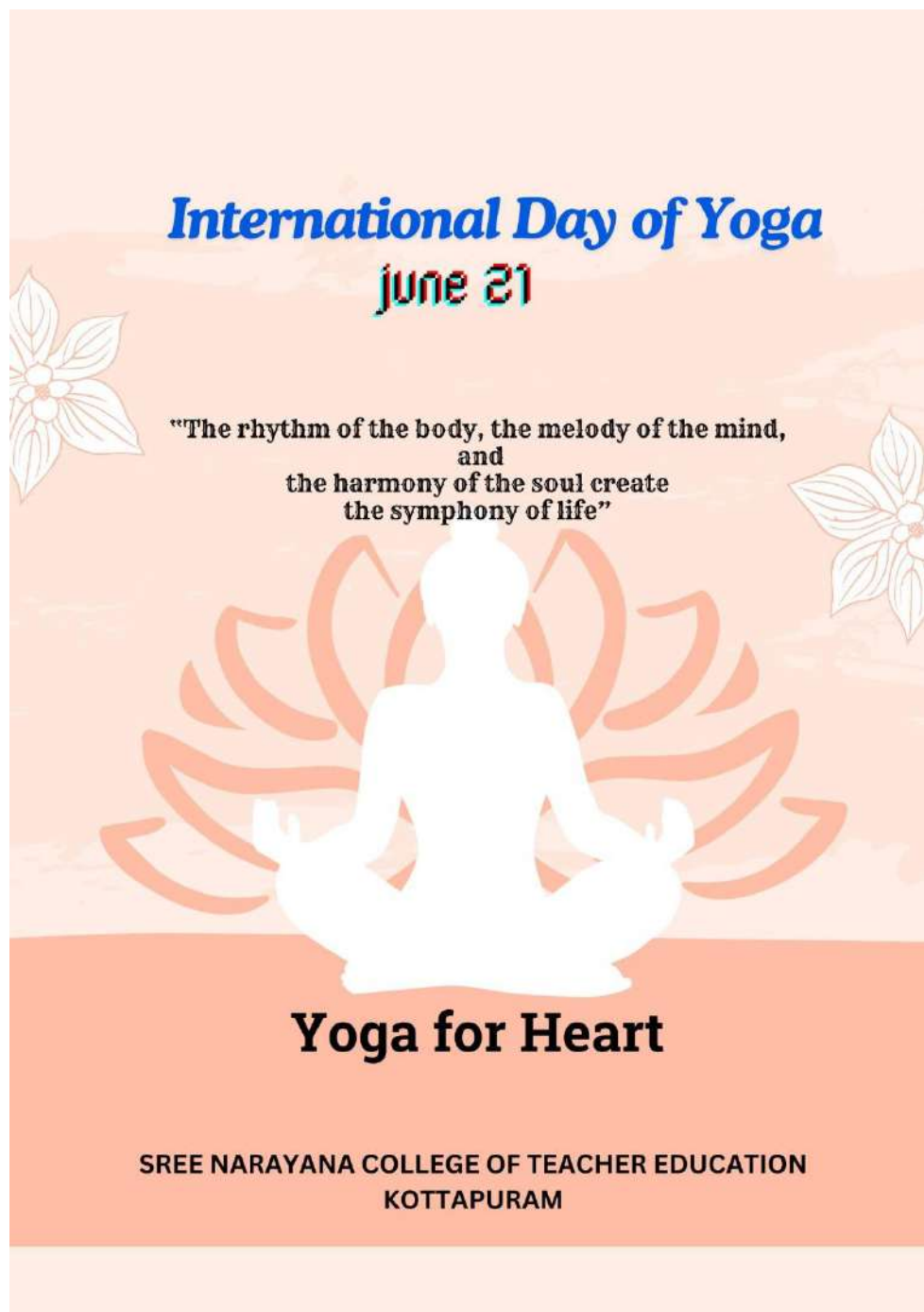
9. READING DAY

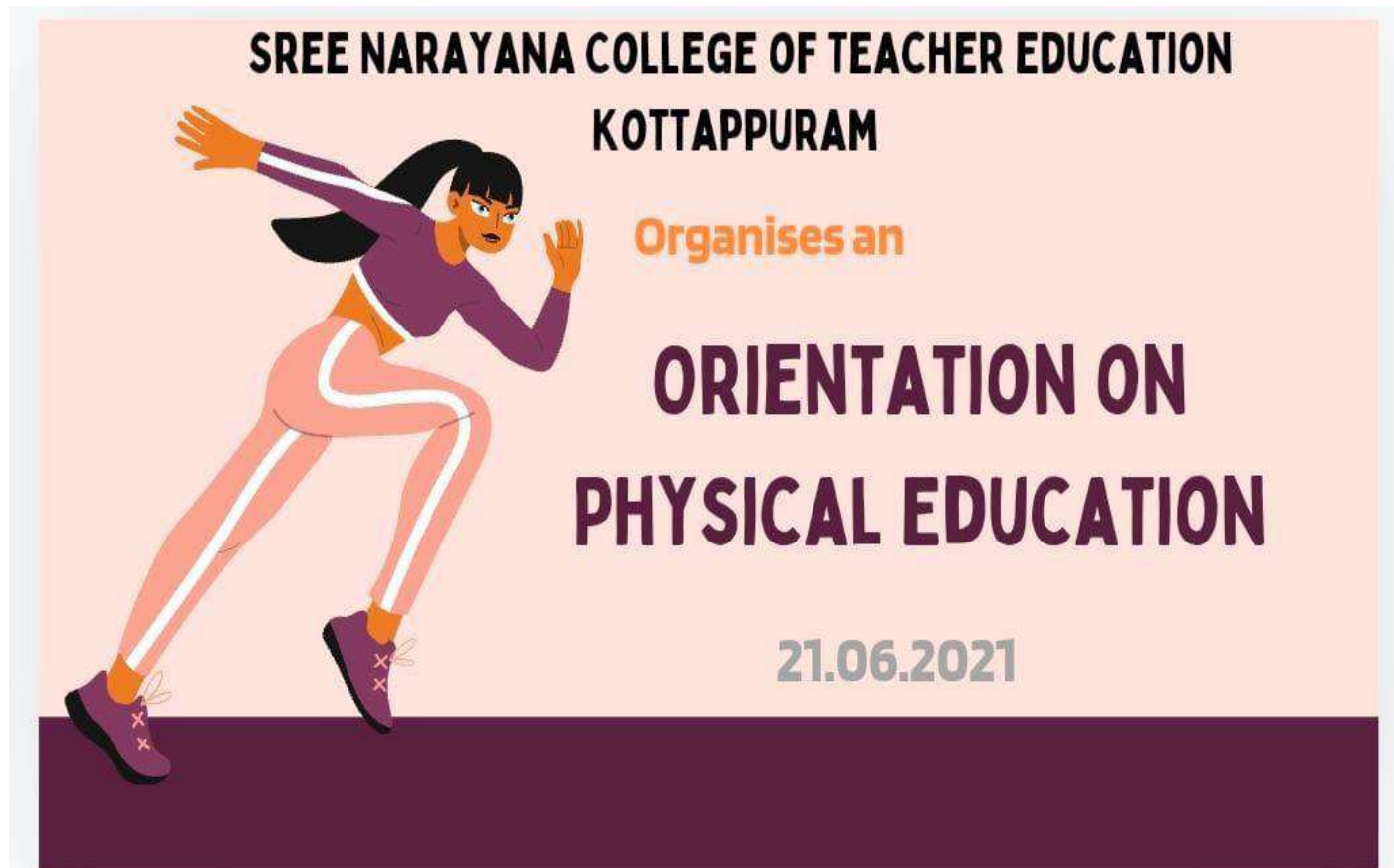
10.YOGA DAY

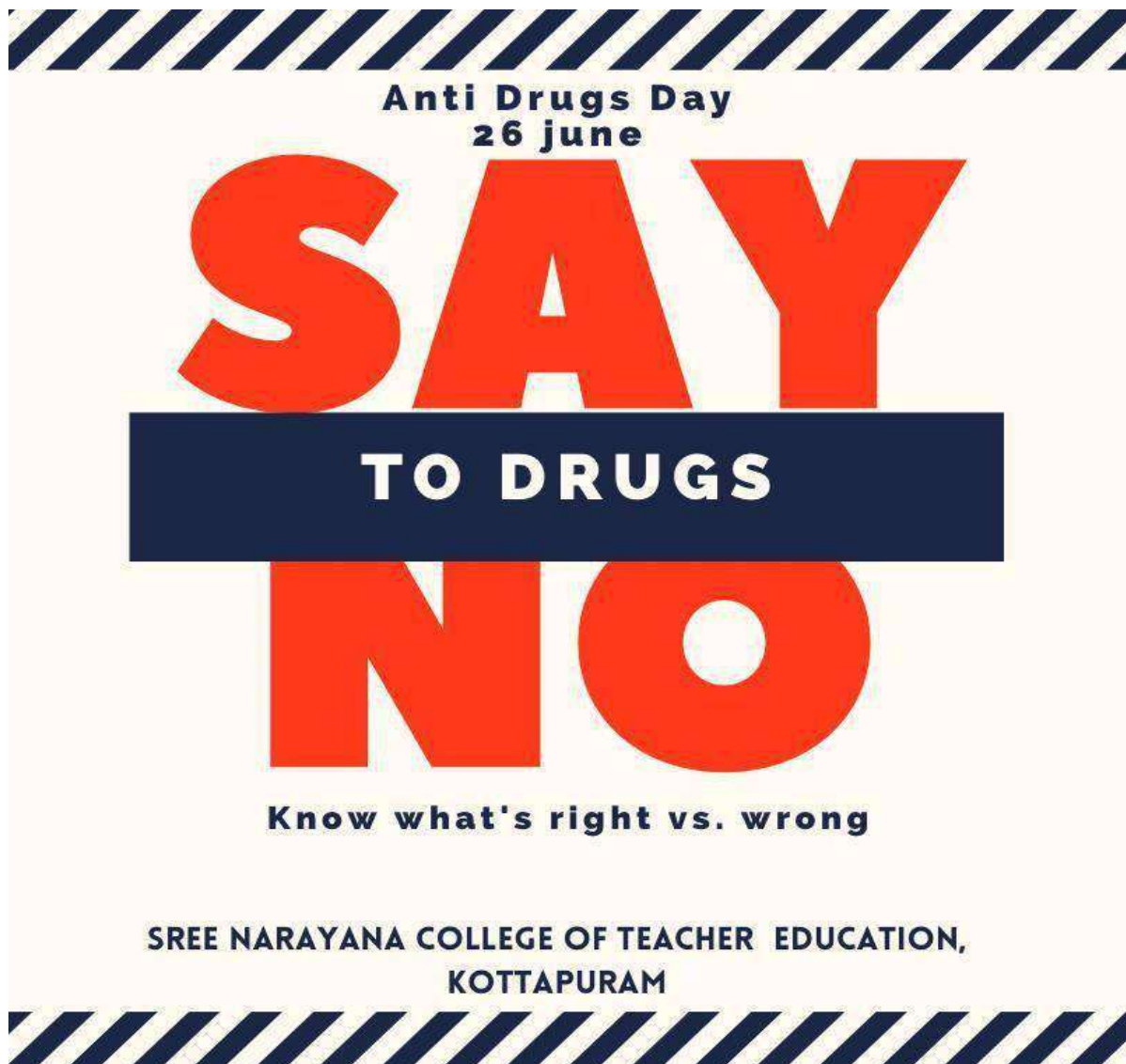
12.POSTER MAKING COMPETITION

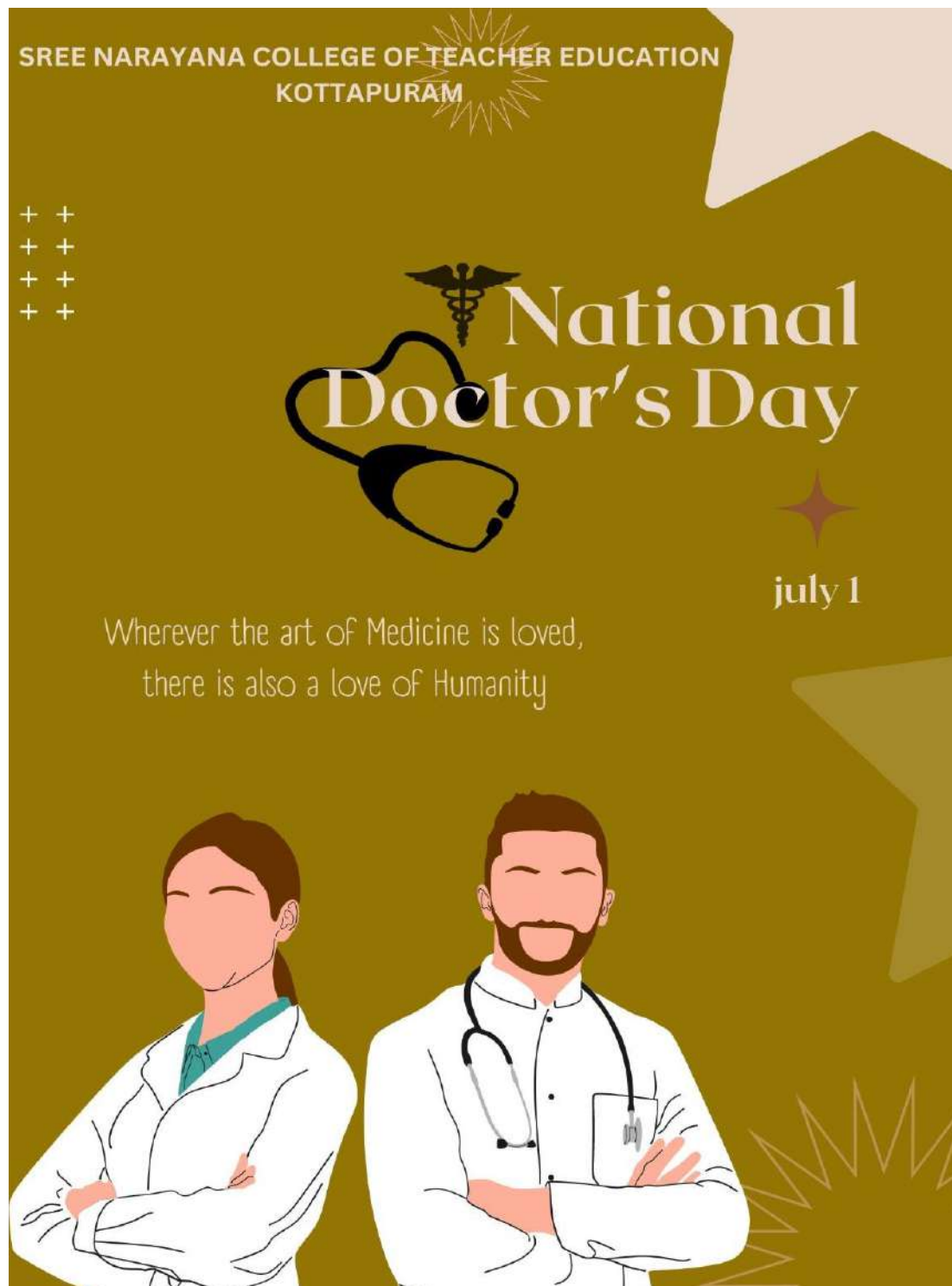
13.ANTI-DRUGS DAY

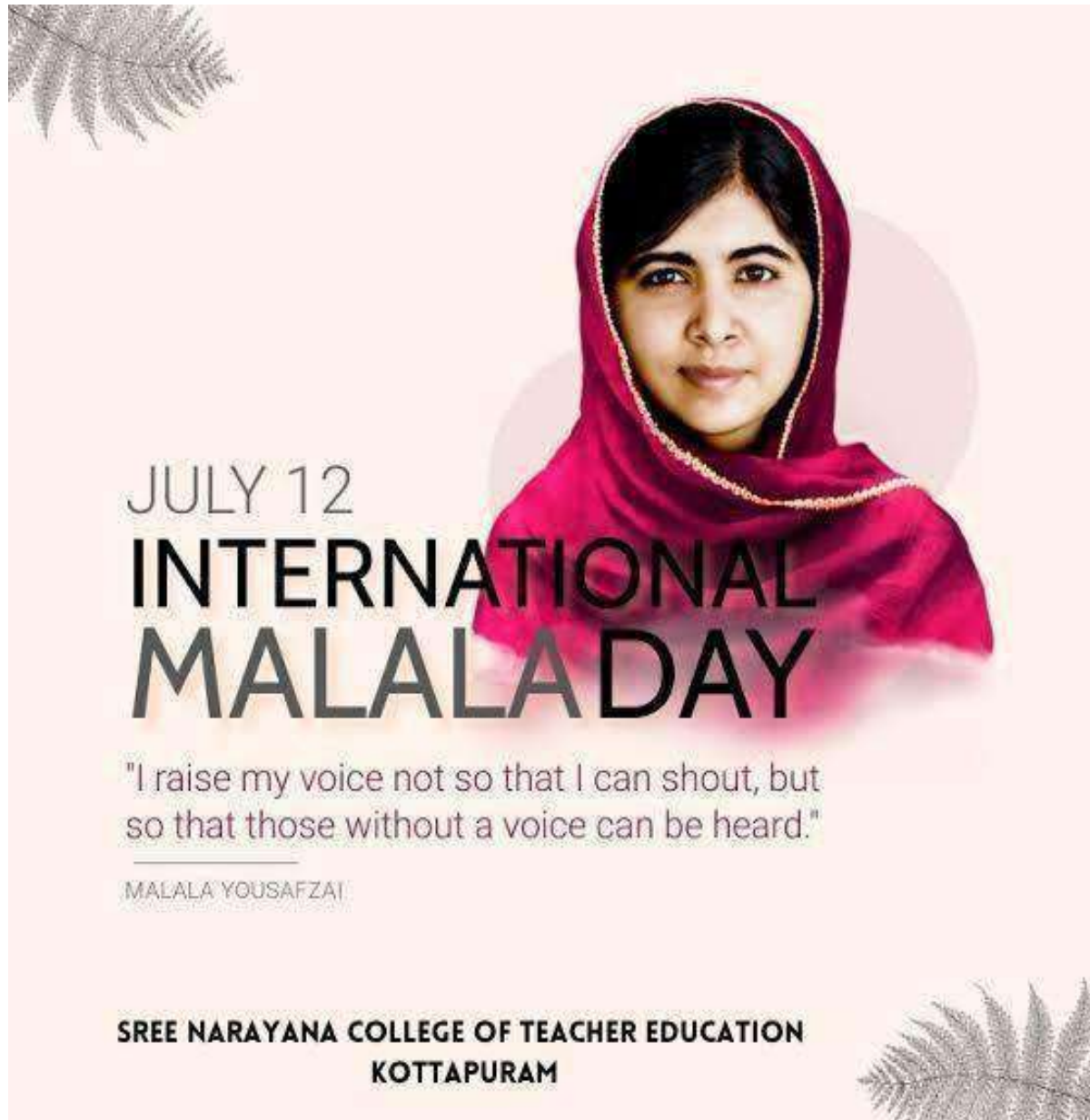
16.INTERNATIONAL PEACE AND LOVE DAY

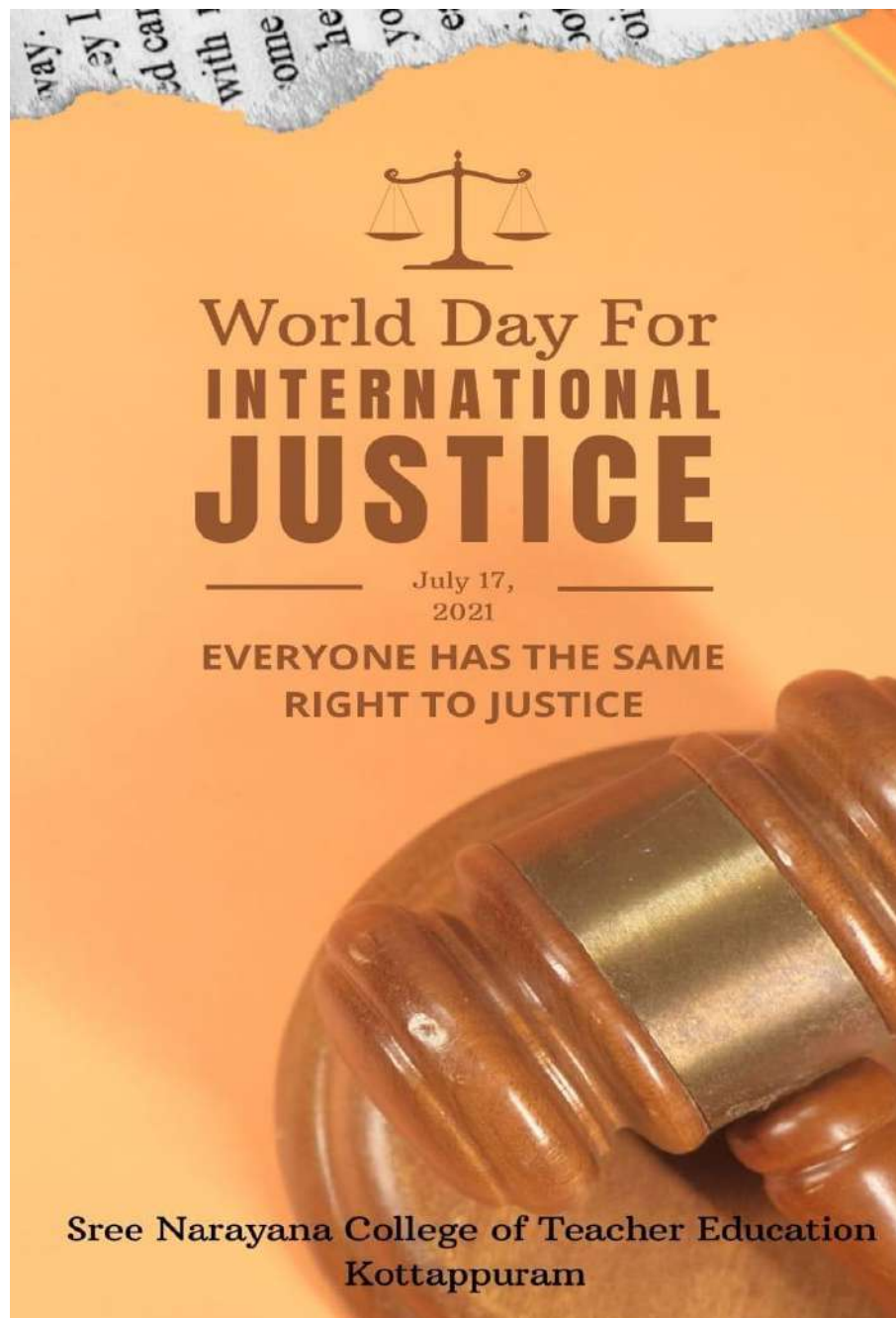
17.WORLD MALALA DAY

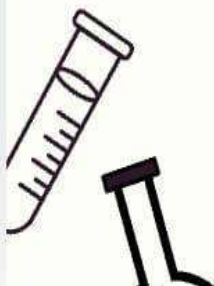
20.EXPERT CLASS ON DEVELOPMENT IN SCIENCE AND EDUCATION

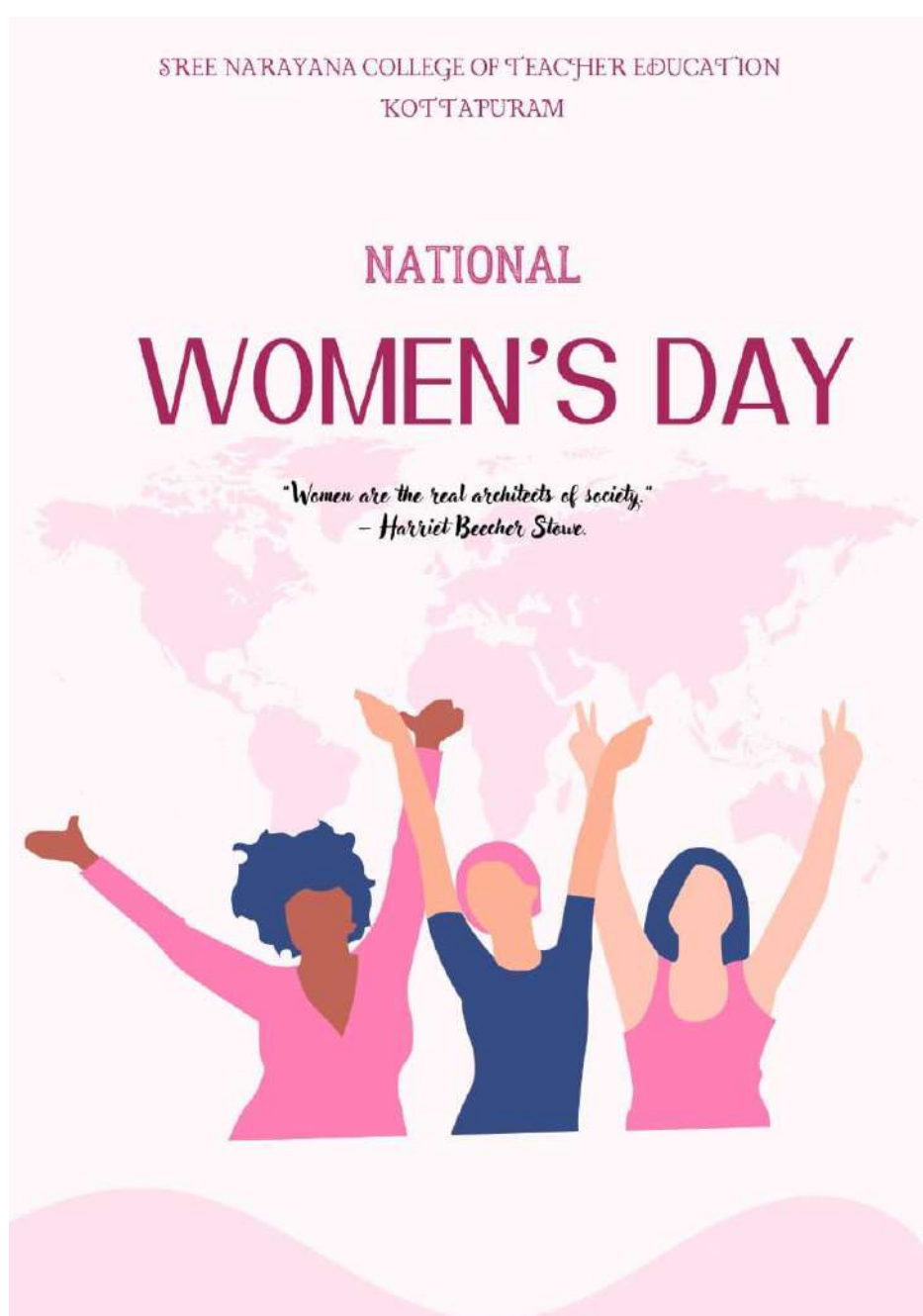
27.NAGASAKI DAY

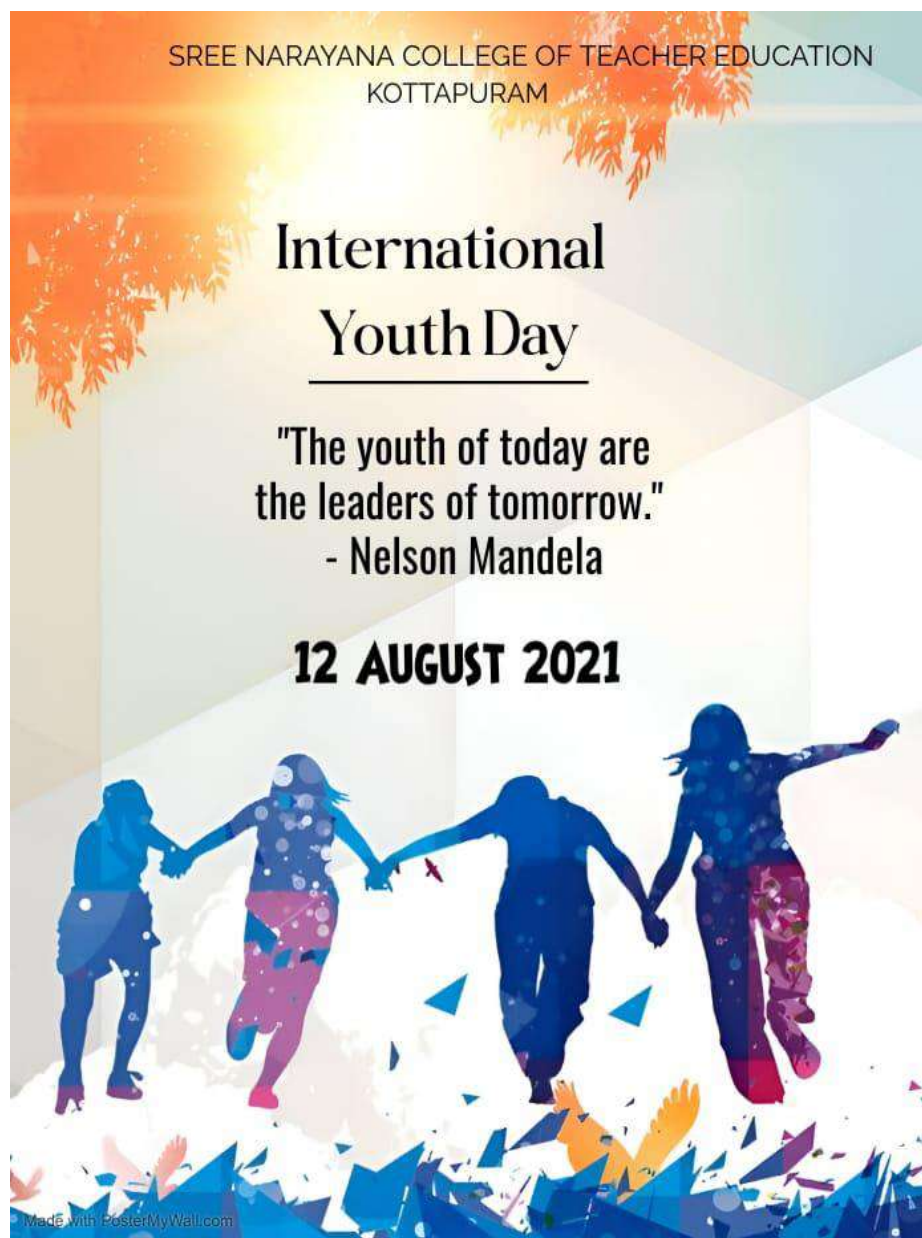
28.NATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

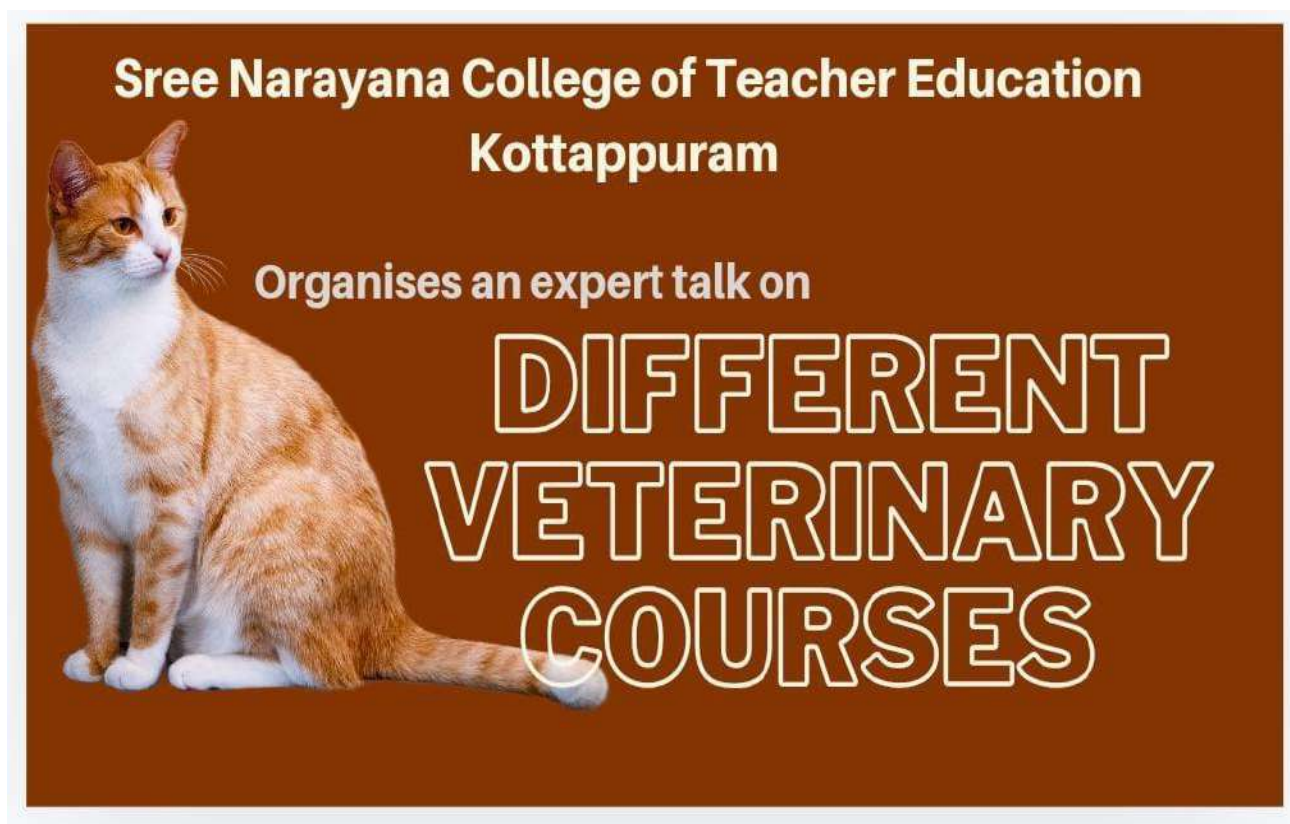
29.INTERNATIONAL YOUTH DAY

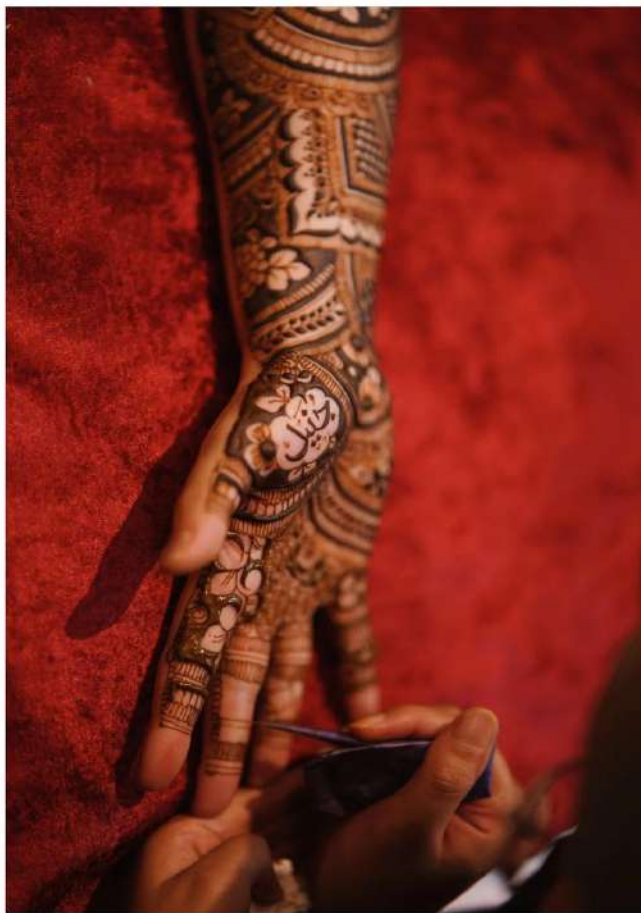
30.EXPERT TALK ON DIFFERENT VETERINARY COURSES

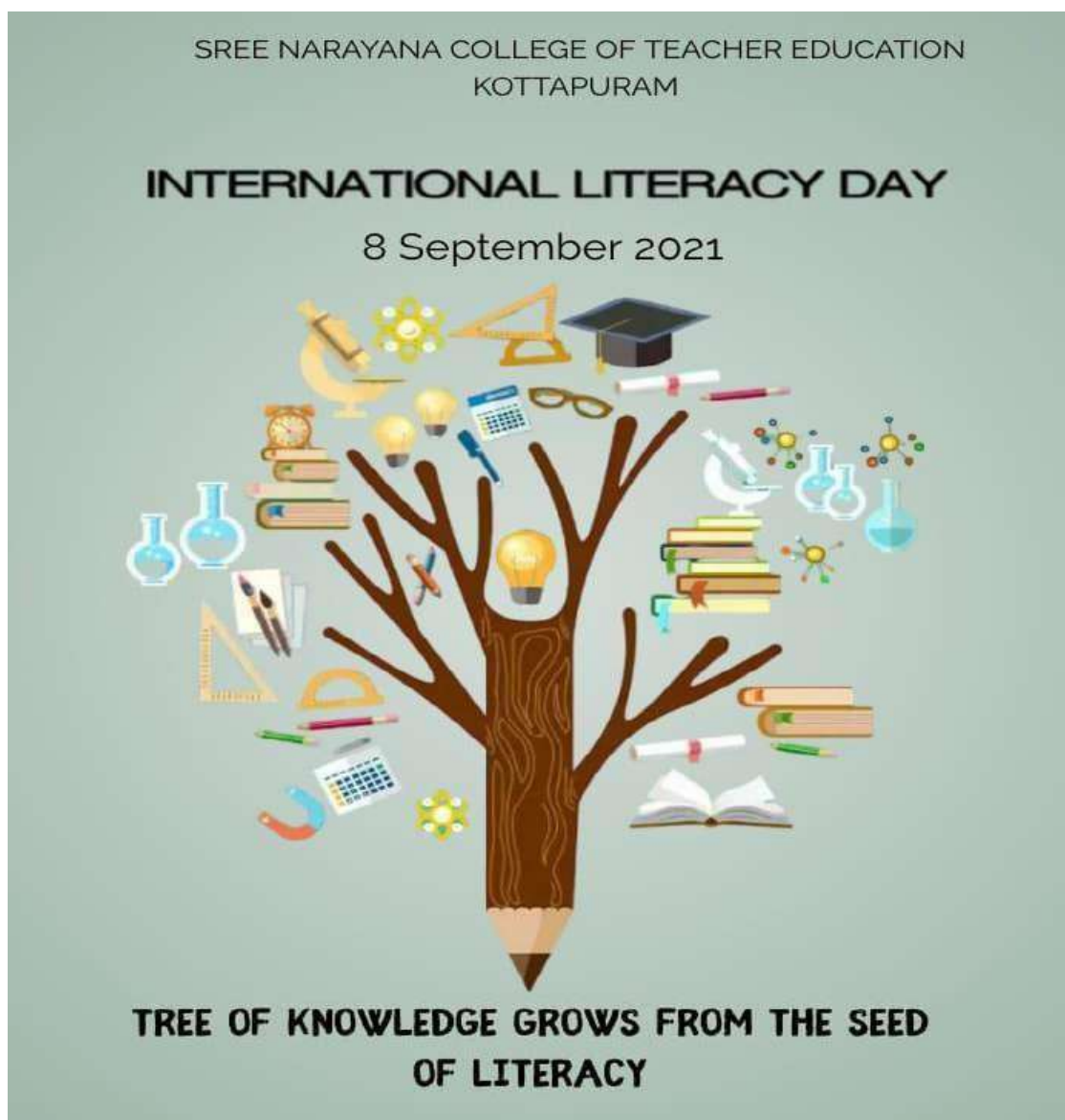

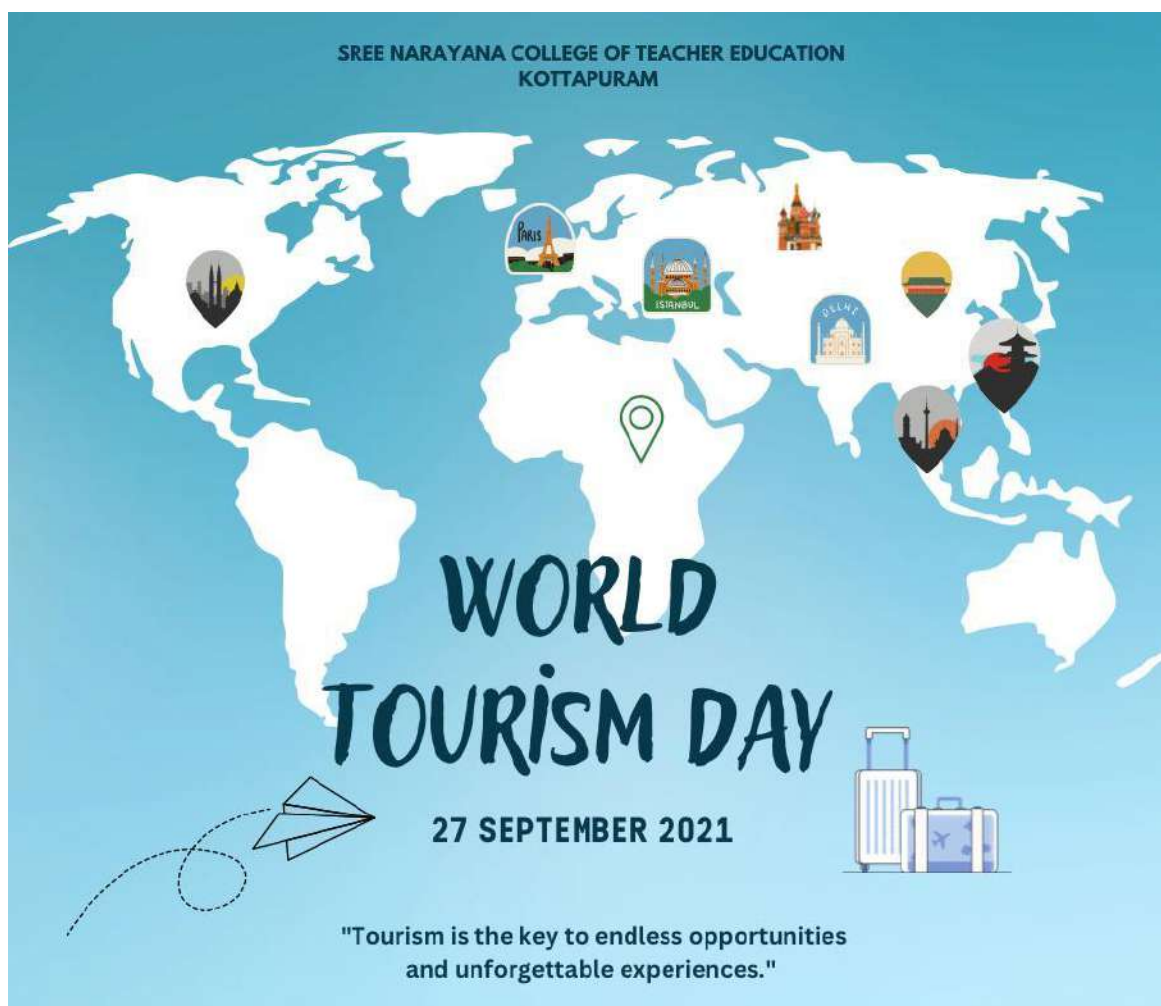

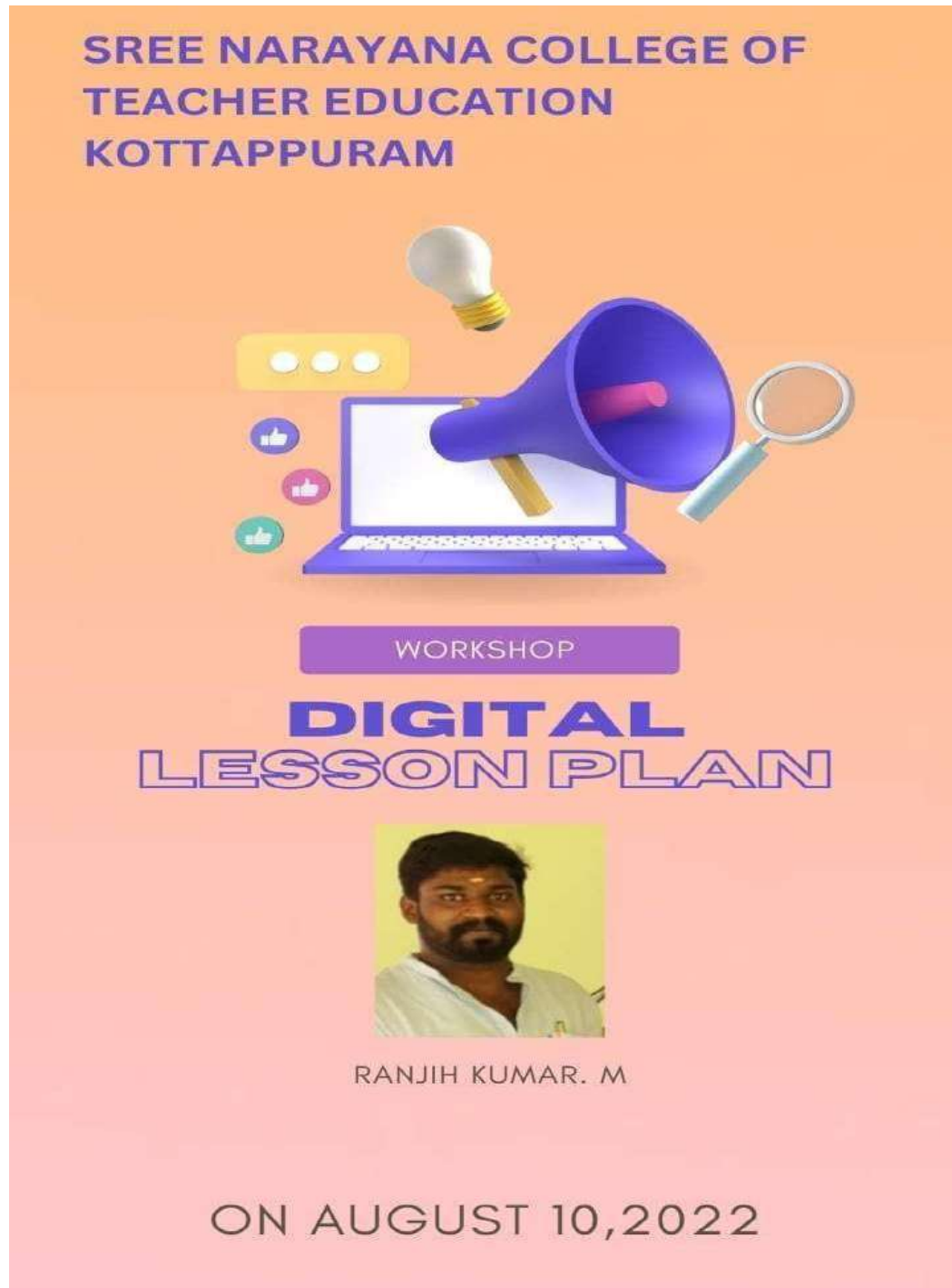
44.AIR FORCE DAY

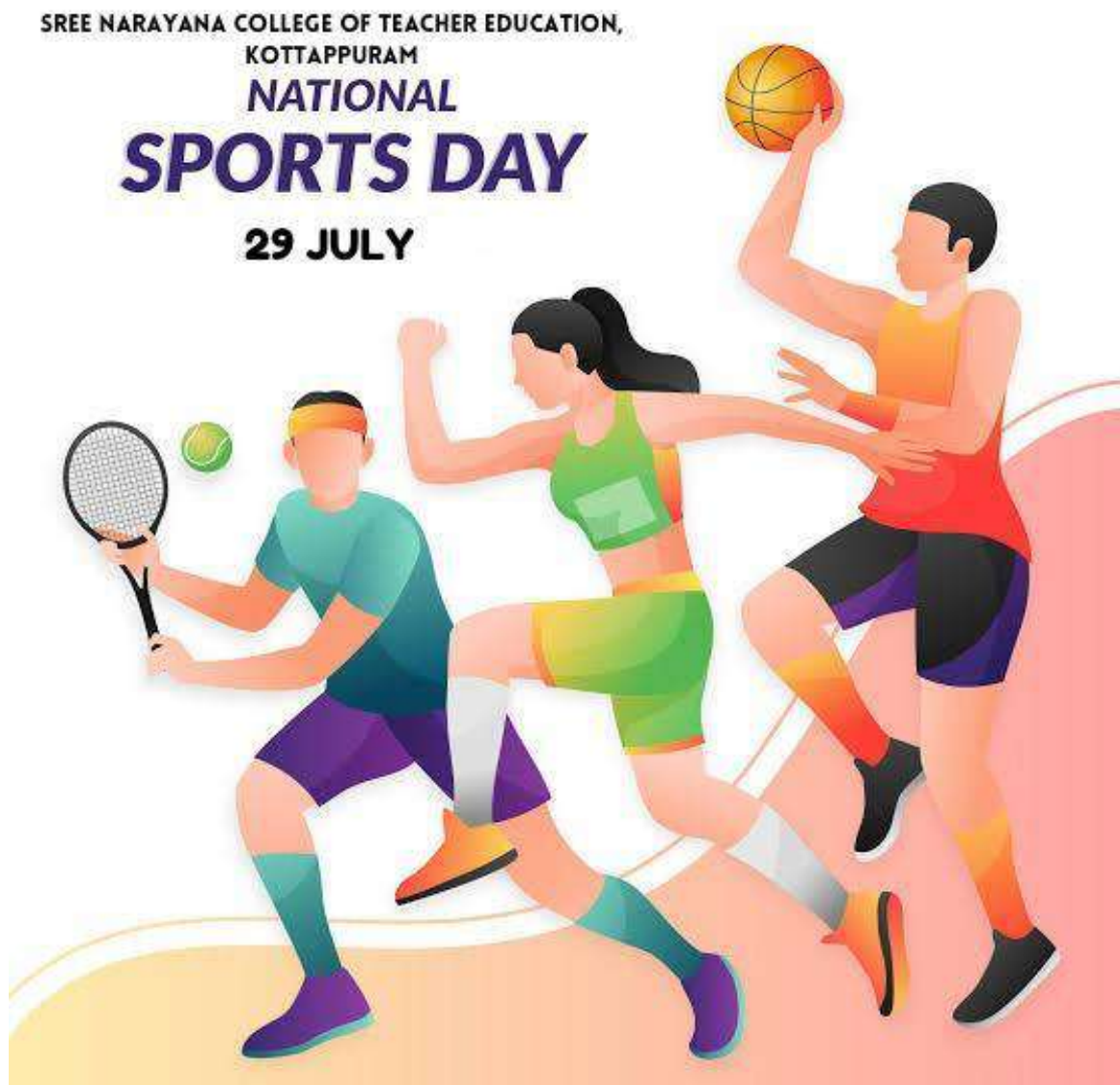
45.WORKSHOP ON DIGITAL LESSON PLAN

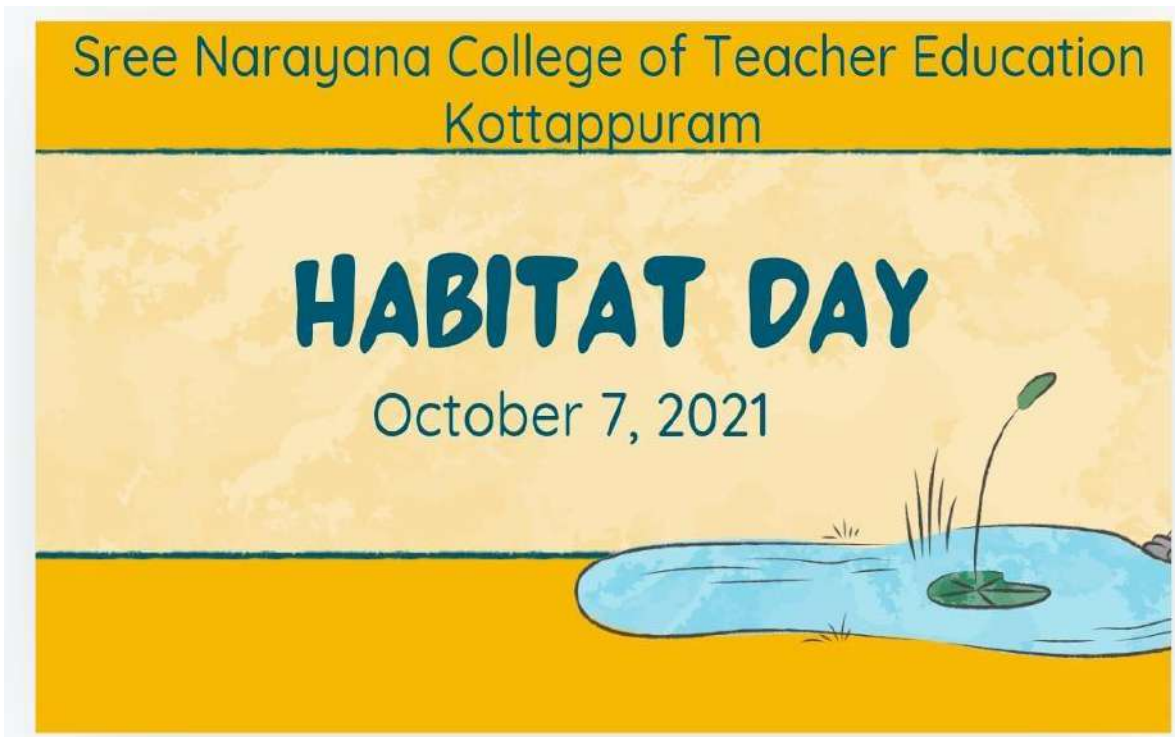
47.INDUCTION PROGRAMME
